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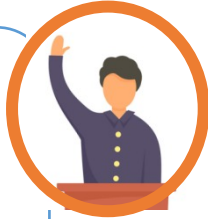




# SDGs IMPLEMENTATIONS: WHAT SHOULD BE DONE?

SDGs is an ambitious agenda and can only be achieved through systematic approach and collaboration among stakeholders

- SDGs Implementation → as a **Movement at any level**
- **Commitment for all Stakeholders** (Government and Non-state actors)



## POLITICAL WILL

### STRONG LEGAL BASIS

- **Presidential Decree No. 59/2017** as basis for SDGs Implementation: **SDGs National Action Plan, Regional Action Plan, and Road Map**
- **Mainstreaming** SDGs in planning documents (RPJMN/RPJMD) → **Basis to determine priorities and budget allocation**



### GOOD STRATEGY

- **Participative process** during the preparation, implementation, and money
- **Clear and measurable** goals and indicators → data resources and accuracy
- **Blended source of funding** → Government and private sectors, Domestic and international Funds
- **Implementation responsibilities** → Sector Ministries in charge related sectors
- **Monitoring and Evaluation** → transparent and accountable
- **Communication strategy** → right and effective

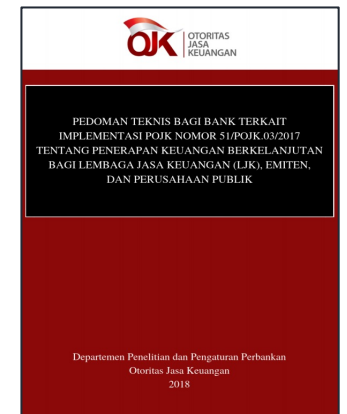
- SDGs Action Plan is a 5 (five) year work plan document consist of action plans from **government and non-government** (philanthropy and business actors, CSOs and media, academia) that directly or indirectly support the achievement of national and sub-national development targets.
- **Level of SDGs Action Plans as mandated by Presidential Regulation 59/2017:**
  1. **SDGs Action Plans at National Level.** The Central Government has issued National Action Plan Document
  2. **SDGs Action Plans at Sub-National Level.** Sub-National Action Plan document is issued by the Provincial Government that includes **provincial and district/municipal action plans.**

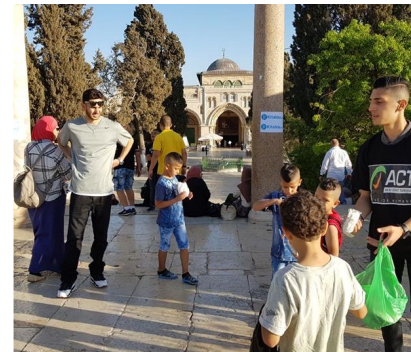

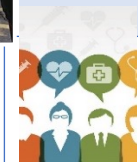

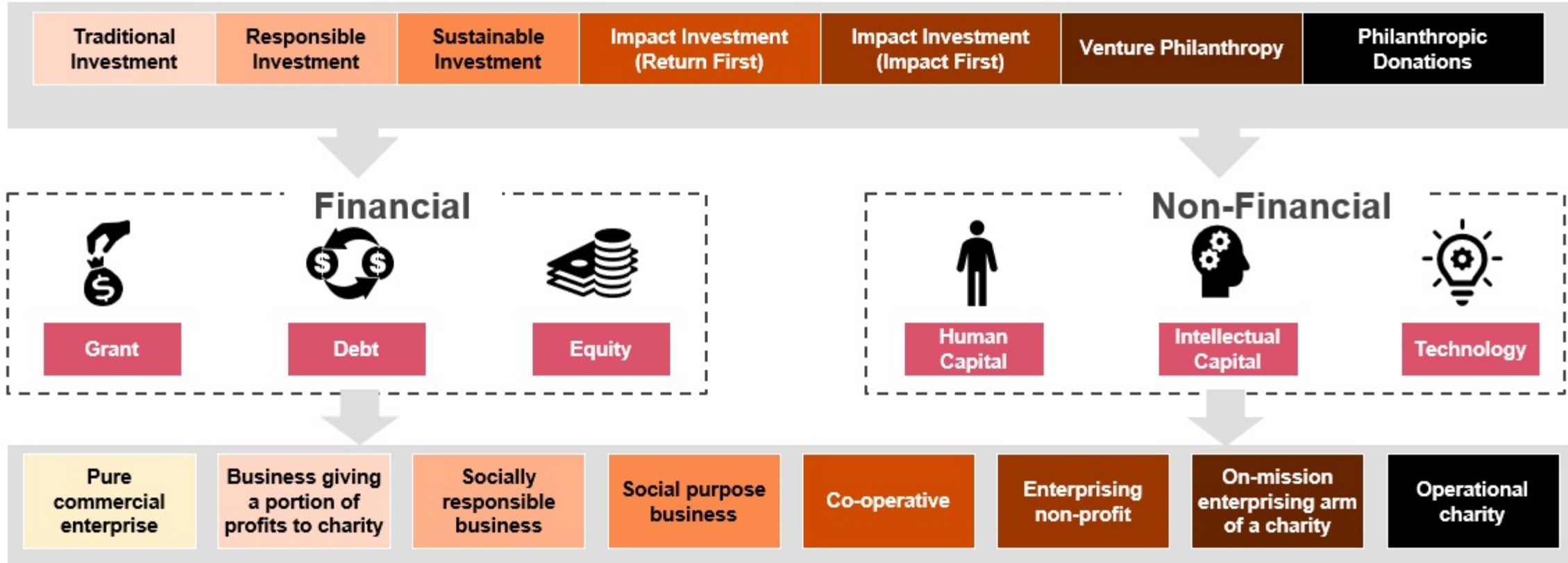

16 trainings and 27 R&D for renewable energy

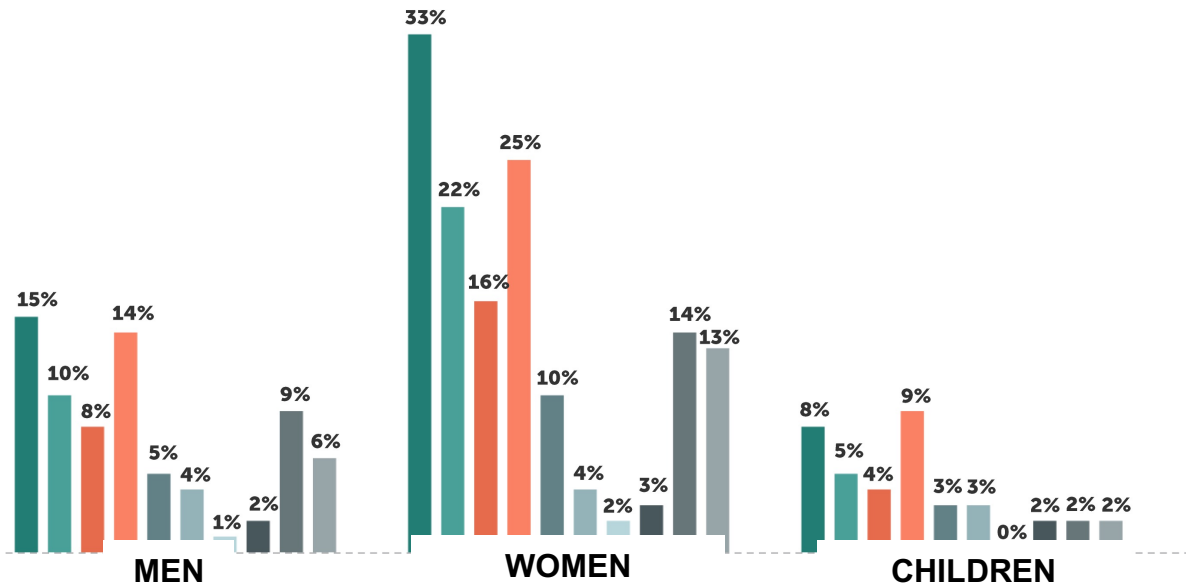

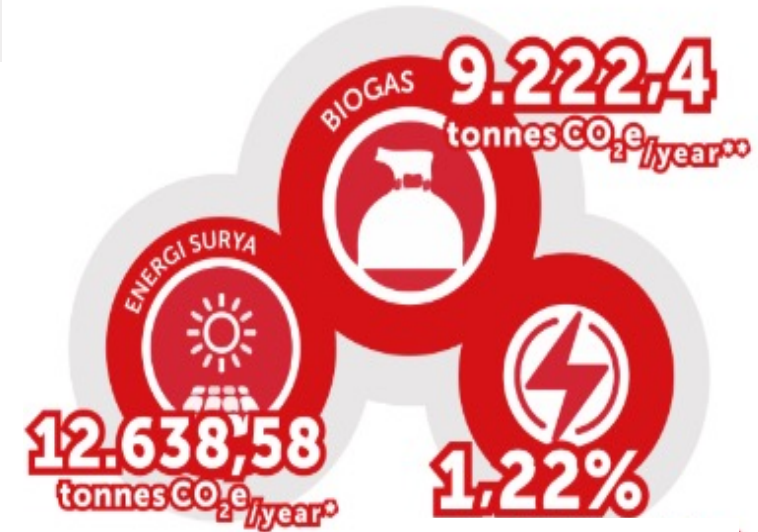
