



Immediate Response *Preventative measures*



Install a specialized committee to oversee emergency funds and vaccine deployment



Call for more transparency in the vaccine procurement; allocation criteria; and administration of vaccines



Implement secure storage and distribution systems



Strengthen civil society participation; reporting mechanism



Protect journalists and whistle-blowers

Immediate Response

Law enforcement measures



Expediently investigate reported corruption cases linked to the allocation or administration of vaccines



Conduct parallel financial investigations



Establish communication channels between enforcement and delivery agencies



Get acquainted with relevant new legislation



Develop effective internal corruption investigation and resolution processes within the organizations involved in the allocation and administration of vaccines



Long-term measures


- Conduct corruption risk assessments



Example: Transparency during the administration of vaccines

What data should be made public?

To oversee the vaccine administration process, anti-corruption authorities/citizens require access to some personal data of those vaccinated. Countries must weigh between data protection and the social interest to have access to enough information to oversee the process.

In country X, between March and April vaccines were being administered only to those aged **80 or more**. When accessing the database it reflects that several people **under 80** were vaccinated.

The database includes: UUID; risk group; age; gender; date of vaccination; doses; type of vaccine; and vaccination centre.

Is the provided data enough to call the system transparent? Does it facilitate the work of law enforcement officers?
