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Context


Kiribati

- Population: 119,449 (2020)
- 33 atolls, 21 inhabited
- Dispersed over 3.5 million km2 of ocean
- Exports: Fish, Copra, Coconut, Seaweed
- Poverty rate among the highest in the Pacific
- Gender inequality

South Tarawa

- Population: 70,000 on 16km²
- Elevation <3m
- Average width 450m
- Current reliance on groundwater lenses
 CC-induced SLR → overtopping → inundation → yield ↓
- Extreme land constraints
- High population density
- HH use imported and subsidized kerosene and wood for boiling water
- Public Utilities Board supplies water, electricity, and sewerage services









Kiribati

• ADB Financing \$61.8m

• **Cofinancing** \$41.6m (GCF: \$28.6m, WB: \$13.0m)

• **Approval date** August 2019

• **Project Objective** Increase access to safe and climate-resilient

water supplies in South Tarawa

Civil packages requiring international partners

Quantity of packages 3

• Brief scope of works (i) 2 No. desalination plants

(ii) 2.5MW solar PV facility

(iii) Water distribution system rehabilitation

and operation:

a) 180km of mains and 12,100 conns

b) O&M of South Tarawa water supply (5 yrs)

Geographic location: South Tarawa.







Kiribati

• Expected amount range Packages ranging from \$7m to \$30m

• Advertisement period Q3/2021 to Q2/2022

Procurement method (i) Desalination plants – design, build operate

(ii) 2.5MW solar PV facility – design, build

(iii) Water distribution mains

a) Civil works – supply, install

b) O&M – services contract
