Limited ICT systems and digital divide







Natural Capital Lab:

Marketplace Platform:

This is an e-commerce platform, which monitors progress of natural capital projects and ensures that their milestones and targets are met.

Co-invests in projects prepared by the Lab through blended-finance model.


