


Local and Regional Governments participation in the preparation of VNRs 2016-2021


Reports of LRGs to the HLPF 2017-2021



Gradual increase in the participation of LGs in the preparation of VNRs: from 32% in 2016 to 43% in 2020. Average in Asia Pacific (2016-2021): 33%







No LRG consultation





Note: In Nigeria, Ethiopia and India (3 federal states), LRG participation has only taken place at the state level and not at the local government unit (municipal) level.

In Brazil, local government consultation took place in 2017 (under the previous government). Brazil has not reported since then.

Participation of local governments in the national coordination mechanisms for the implementation of the SDGs 2016-2021




Between 2016 and 2020, the participation of local governments in national coordination mechanisms was 30% on average, but falls to 21% in 2021, although also with strong regional contrasts

More advanced in Europe (55%), followed by Latin America (26%), Africa (24%) and Asia Pacific (20%)



Bottom-up SDG monitoring and reporting efforts: accelerating SDG implementation, improving multilevel governance








The COVID-19 emergency: increased challenges and urgency for effective multilevel governance

Average loss of income (2020)




