

Global agreements

March 2022: UNEP’s Resolution “End Plastic Pollution: Towards an internationally legally binding instrument”

Negotiate an international legally binding agreement by 2024 to:

Address the full lifecycle of plastics,

Address the design of reusable and recyclable products and materials,

Foster technology transfer and knowledge sharing.

May 2019: Plastics added to the Basel convention which regulates movement of hazardous materials between countries.

To combat the export of contaminated and mixed plastics, usually from higher income to lower income countries
