

TA 8520 - Asia Pacific Public Electronic Procurement Network



- Implementation period - December 2013 - March 2017
- Original scope – electronic publication of eGP handbook, annual regional procurement meetings, periodic eGP survey; pilot testing of Software-as-Service model for e-government procurement
- Revised scope – addition of implementation support, including e-GP assessments; cofinancing of subregional procurement knowledge sharing events; monitoring and evaluation function.
