Law Enforcement Responses to Corruption in Emergencies

Changes to operational practices

- OECD survey regarding challenges and responses by law enforcement during the COVID-19 pandemic
- Impact on four main categories
 - Organisational changes
 - Amended legal procedures
 - Prioritisation of law enforcement activities
 - International cooperation
- Conducting risks assessments
 - Evaluation of risks and threats arising from the emergency

Law Enforcement Responses to Corruption in Emergencies

Sources of detection

- Criminal and financial intelligence
- Inter-agency cooperation
- Investigative journalism, media and social media platforms
- Whistleblowers

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Sources of detection – Recommendations

- Conducting risk assessment
- Design a response to mitigate the identified risks
- Identify key institutions in the public and private sectors
- Enhance activities and capabilities of analytical departments

Law Enforcement Responses to Corruption in Emergencies

Investigation and prosecution

- Open-source intelligence
- Special investigative techniques
- Forensic expertise
- Pre-trial and trial proceedings
- Cooperating witnesses, witness protection and plea agreements
- Freezing, seizure and confiscation
- High-profile corruption

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Investigation and prosecution – Recommendations

- Establish specific methods and guidelines applied to OSINT and data gathering
- Identify the forensic expertise required during the investigation planning stage
- Assess the impact of an emergency on pre-trial and trial proceedings and identify mitigating measures while preserving the rule of law and the right to a fair trial

Law Enforcement Responses to Corruption in Emergencies

International cooperation

- International Financial Institutions – integrity and investigation units
- International FIU platforms
- Law enforcement cooperation platforms

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International cooperation – Recommendations

- Strengthen the use of law enforcement cooperation platforms as a mechanism to verify and confirm lines of inquiry in their investigations (prior to MLA)
- Ensure cooperation and collaboration mechanisms between FIUs and national law enforcement authorities.
