






Basic Hygiene Services


SERVICE LEVEL	DEFINITION

NO FACILITY	No handwashing facility at home


Status on safe drinking water varies by countries

Rural and urban access to water supply







Pacific populations covered by Utilities


12 PICTs have more than 50% of their populations served by utilities







Access to handwashing facility at home




WASH in schools - Hygiene promotion

- 4. Clean hands are within reach but need more and sustained effort for all settings (home, communities, workplaces, schools, health centers)






