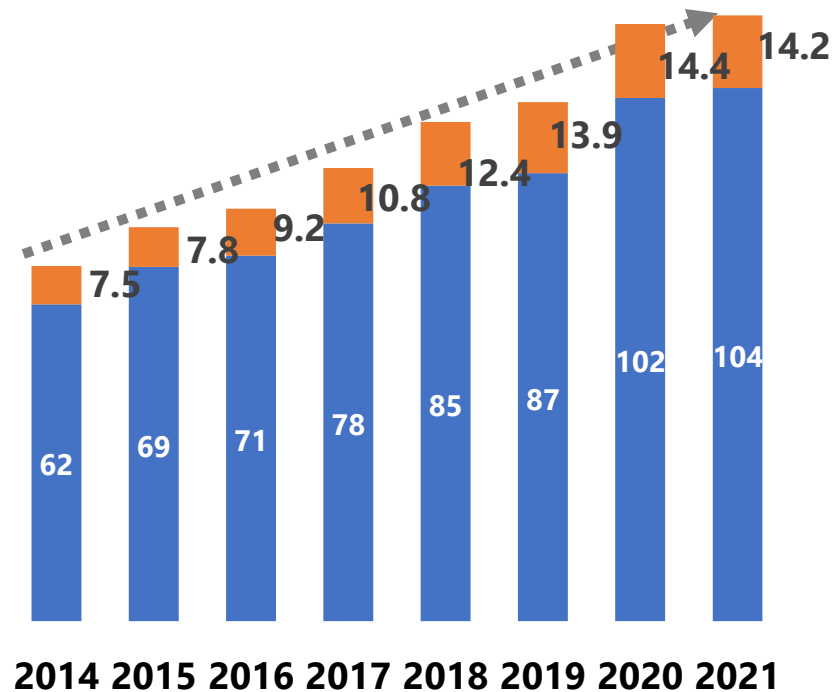

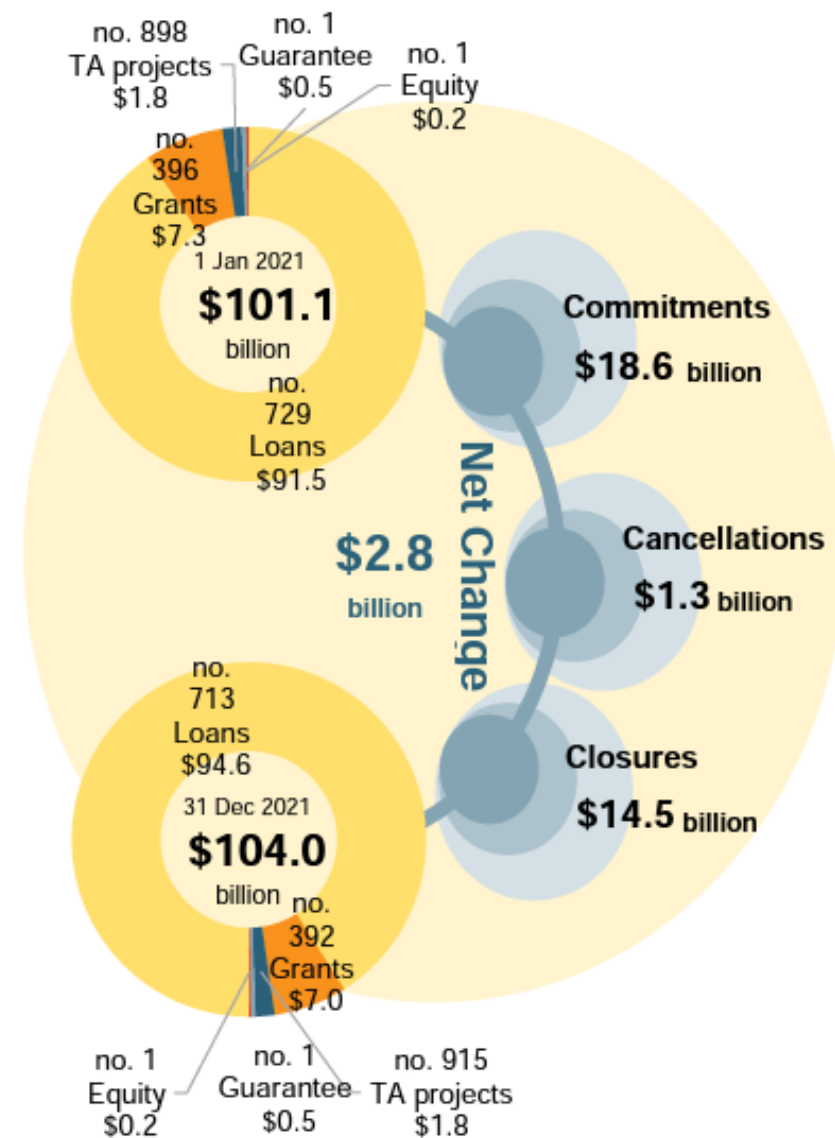
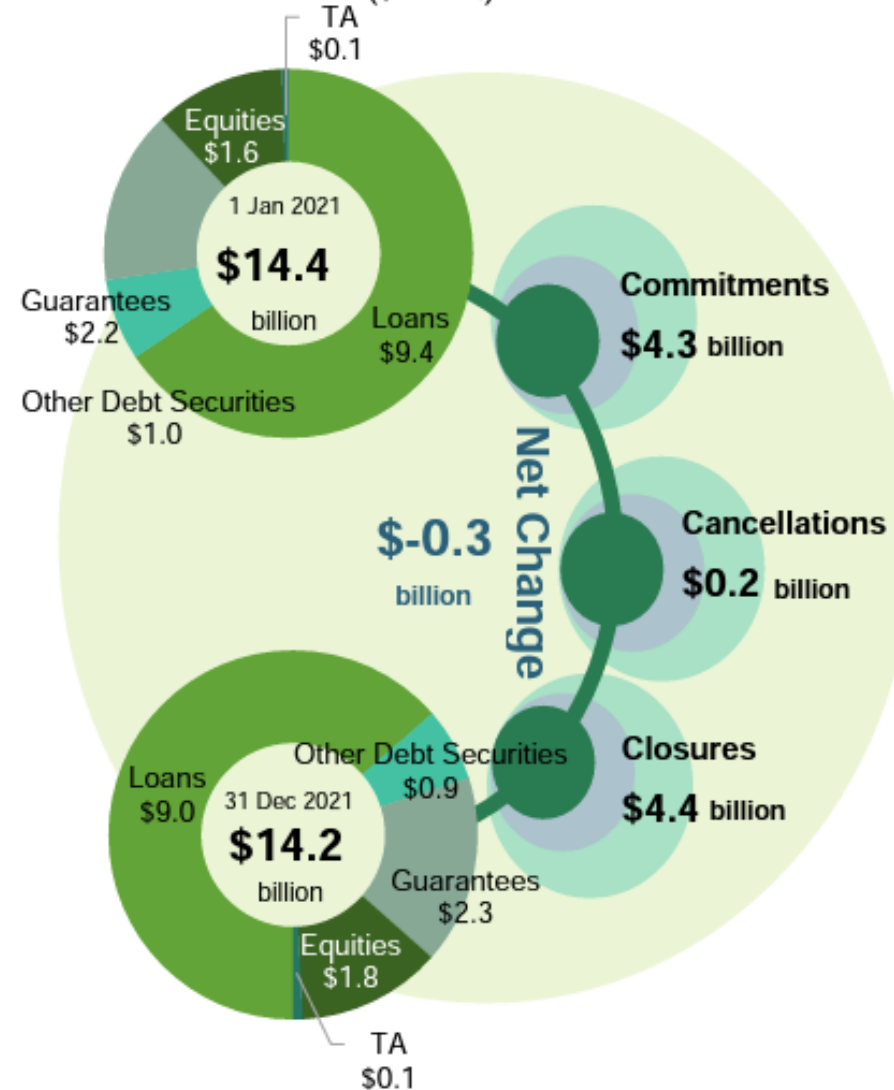
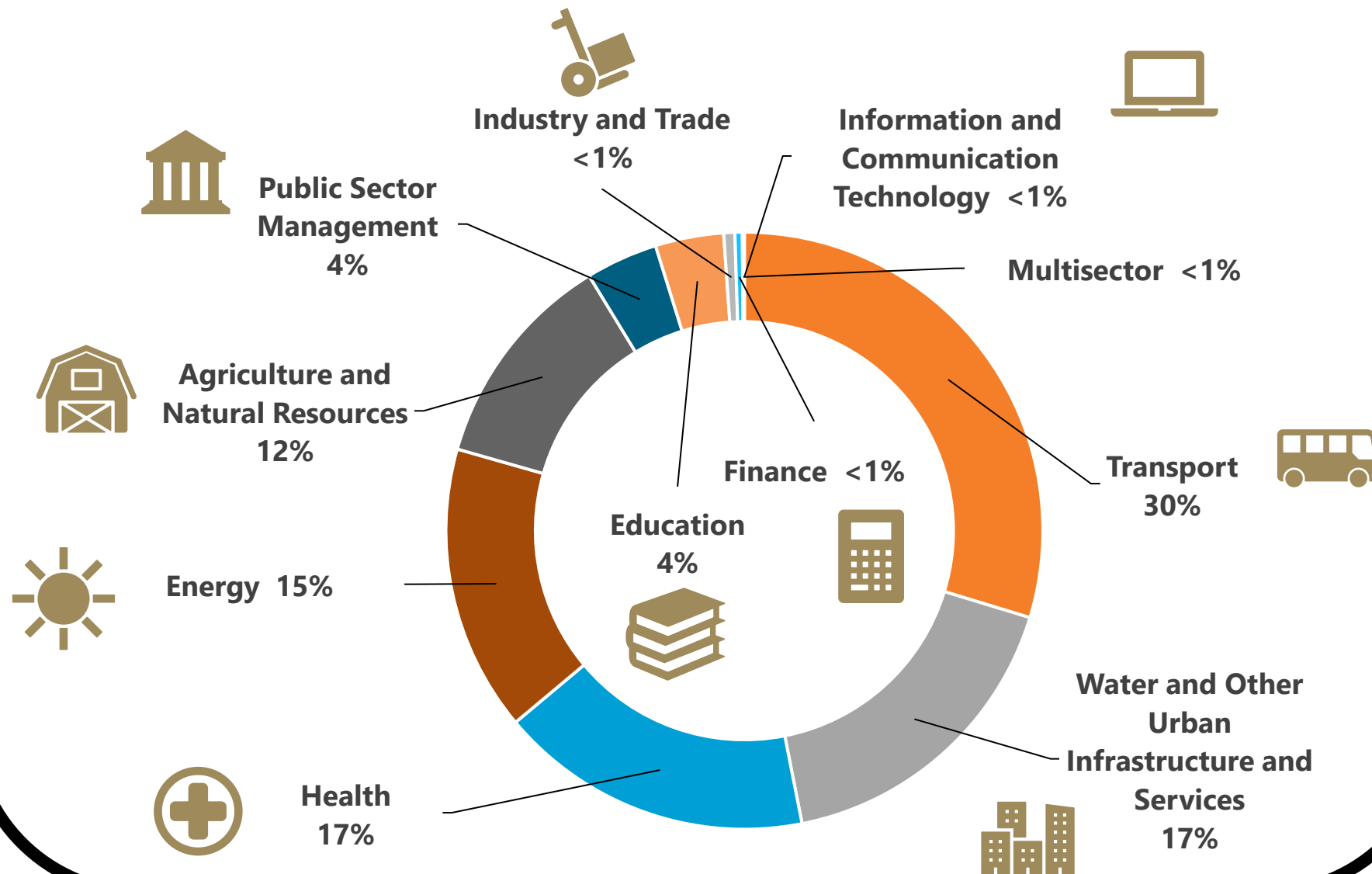


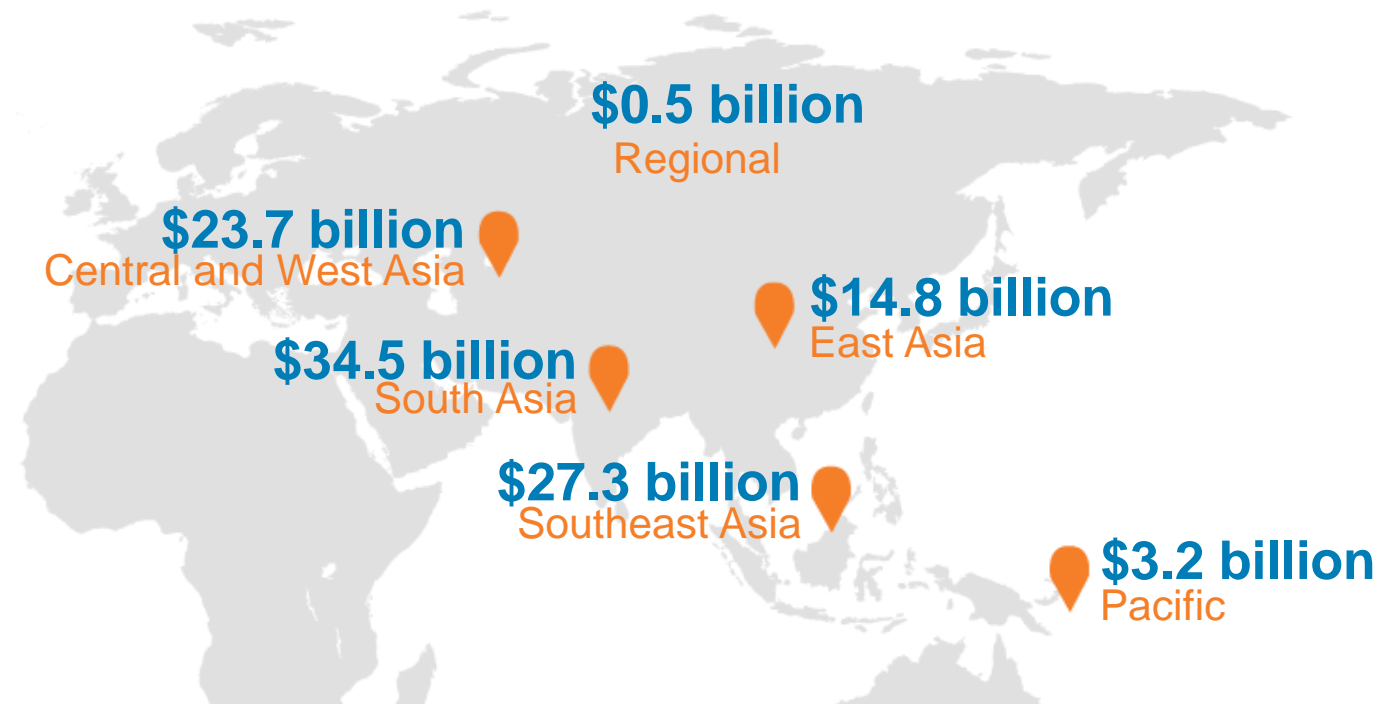
Figure 71: Nonsovereign Portfolio at a Glance

Active sovereign portfolio by region

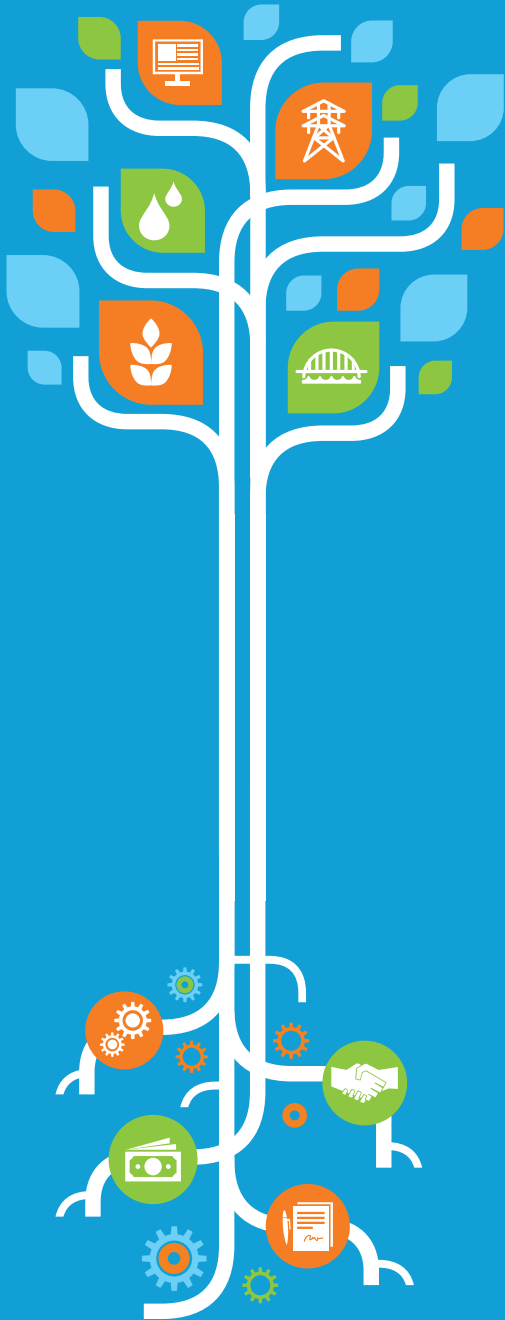

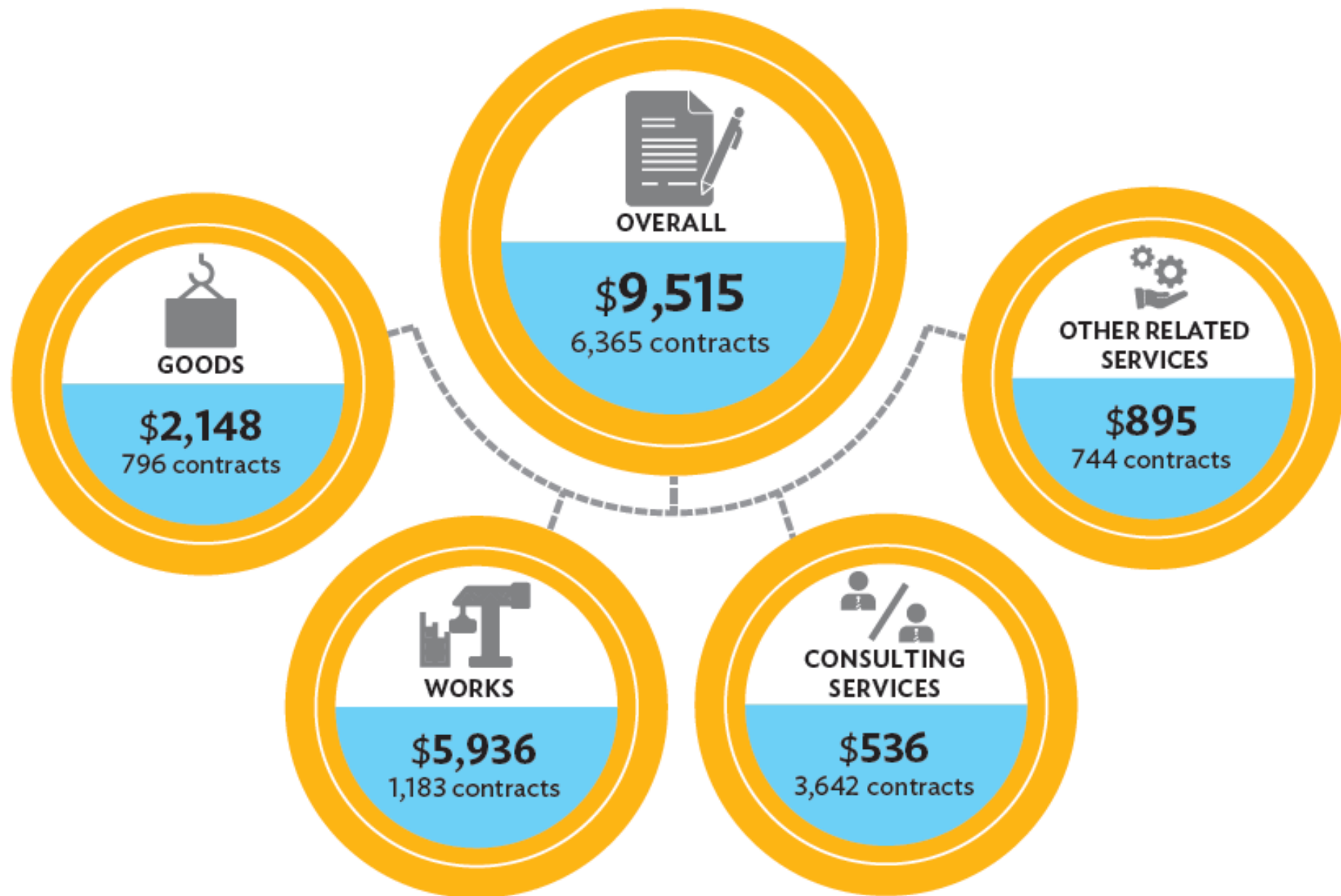

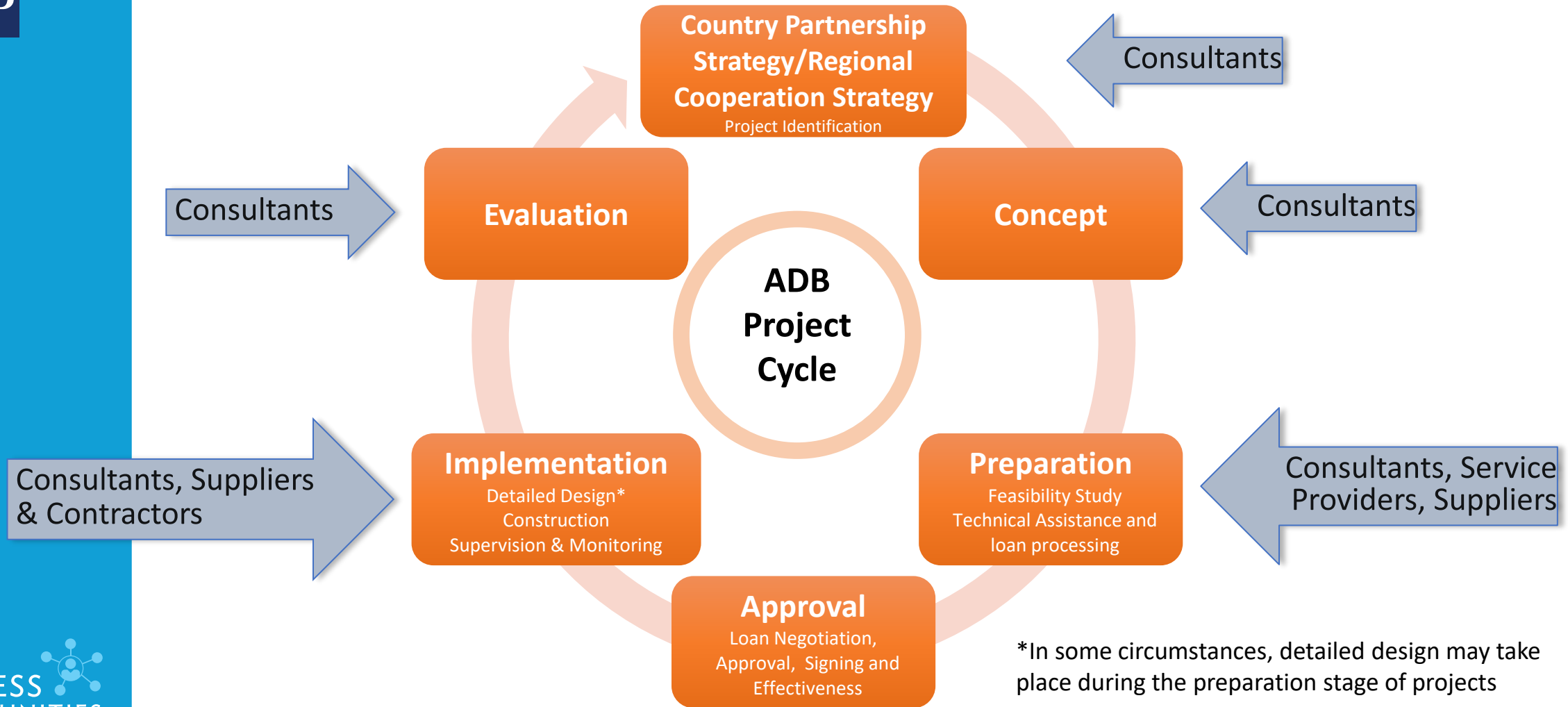
Types of business opportunities

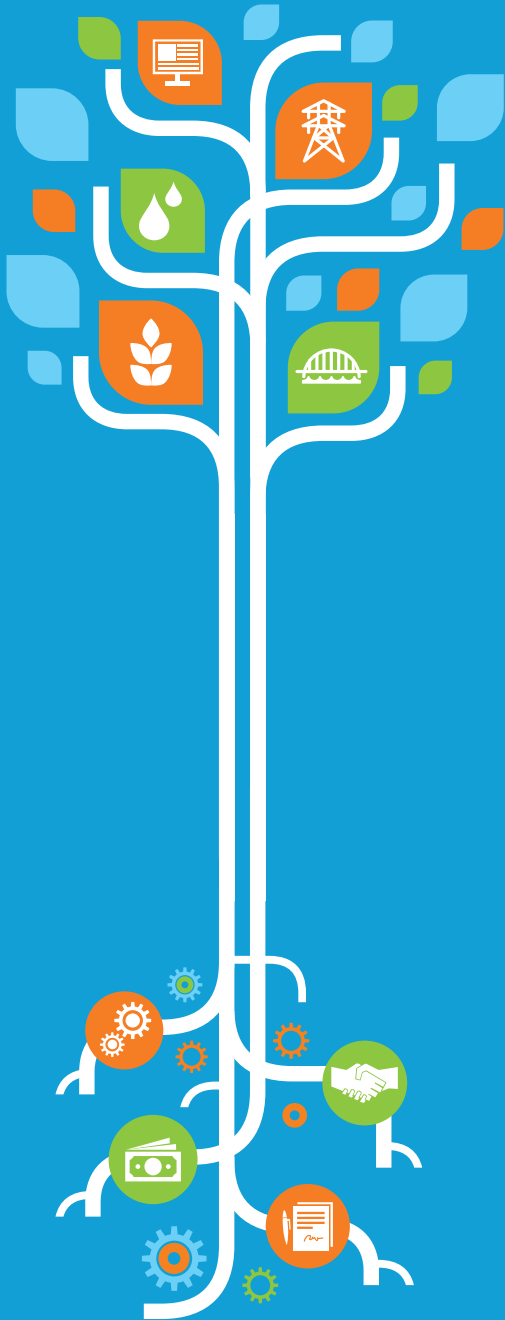
Operational Procurement by Region, US\$ million
