Workshop purpose:

This workshop will aim to:

- build an understanding of Indonesian government priorities on strengthening reef resilience and sustainable management of coral reef ecosystems;
- outline the intended approach for assessing risk transfer / reef insurance opportunities within key sites in Indonesia; and
- collaboratively agree on two high opportunity sites for Indonesia to take forward into full assessment.

The meeting will start with opening remarks from MMAF and MoEF on of the current situation with regards to coral reef risk and resilience in Indonesia and the project expectations. ADB will follow with a short overview of the project background, after which the Landell Mills consortium team will provide a short summary of the project approach and deliverables. More specifically the consortium team will present the initial assessment based on a series of prioritisation criteria of the seven candidate sites in Indonesia. This will be followed by a discussion towards seeking agreement on the two sites that will be taken forward for further analysis.
