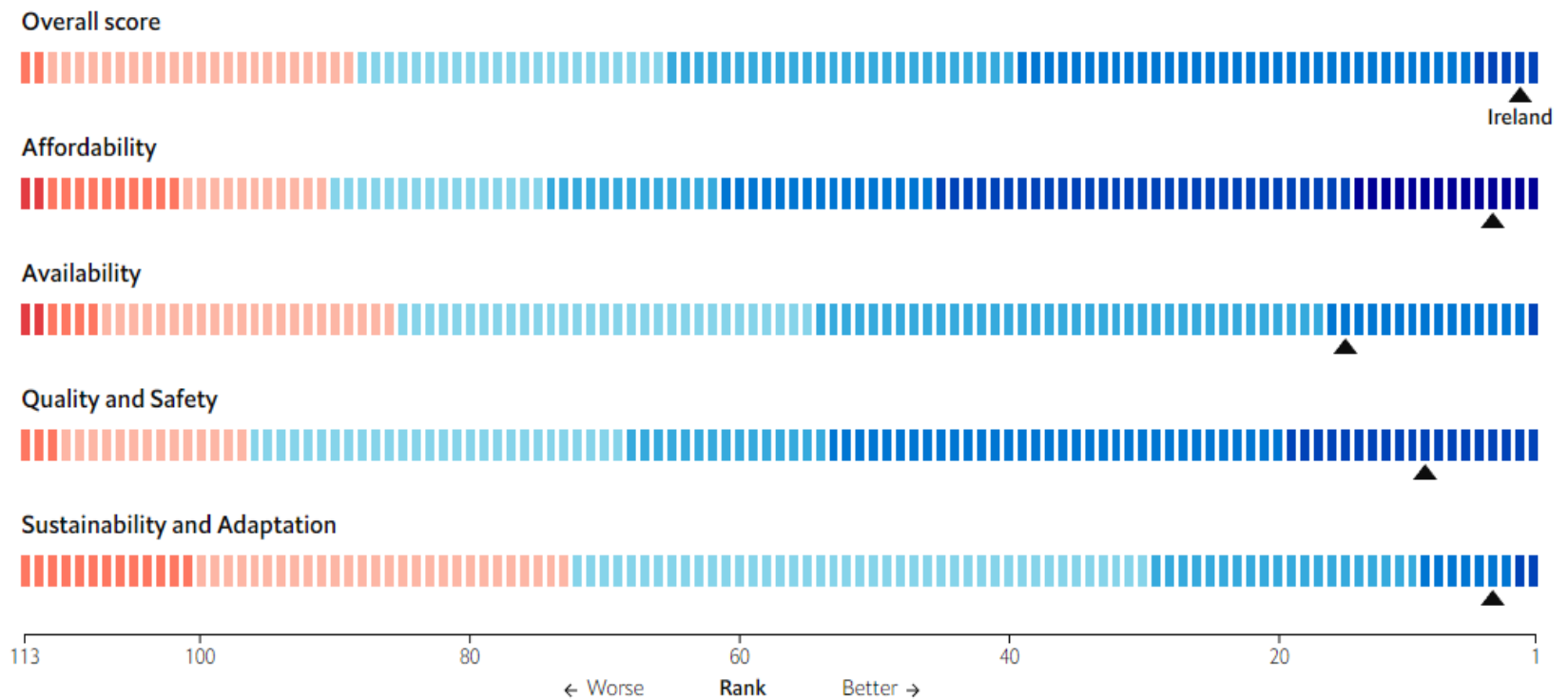

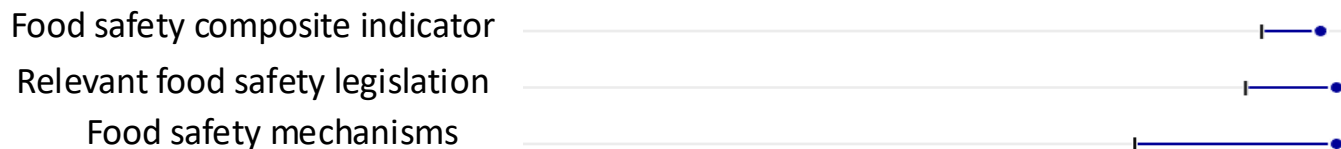

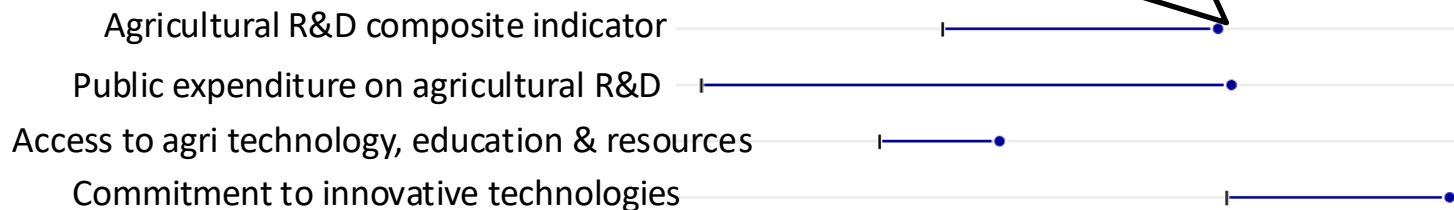

Shares Irish State expertise and knowledge in agri-food through funded projects

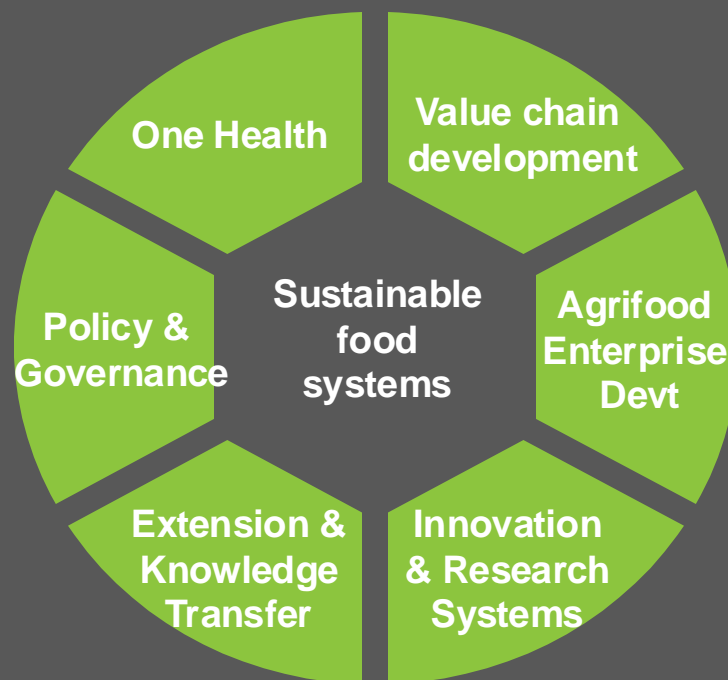

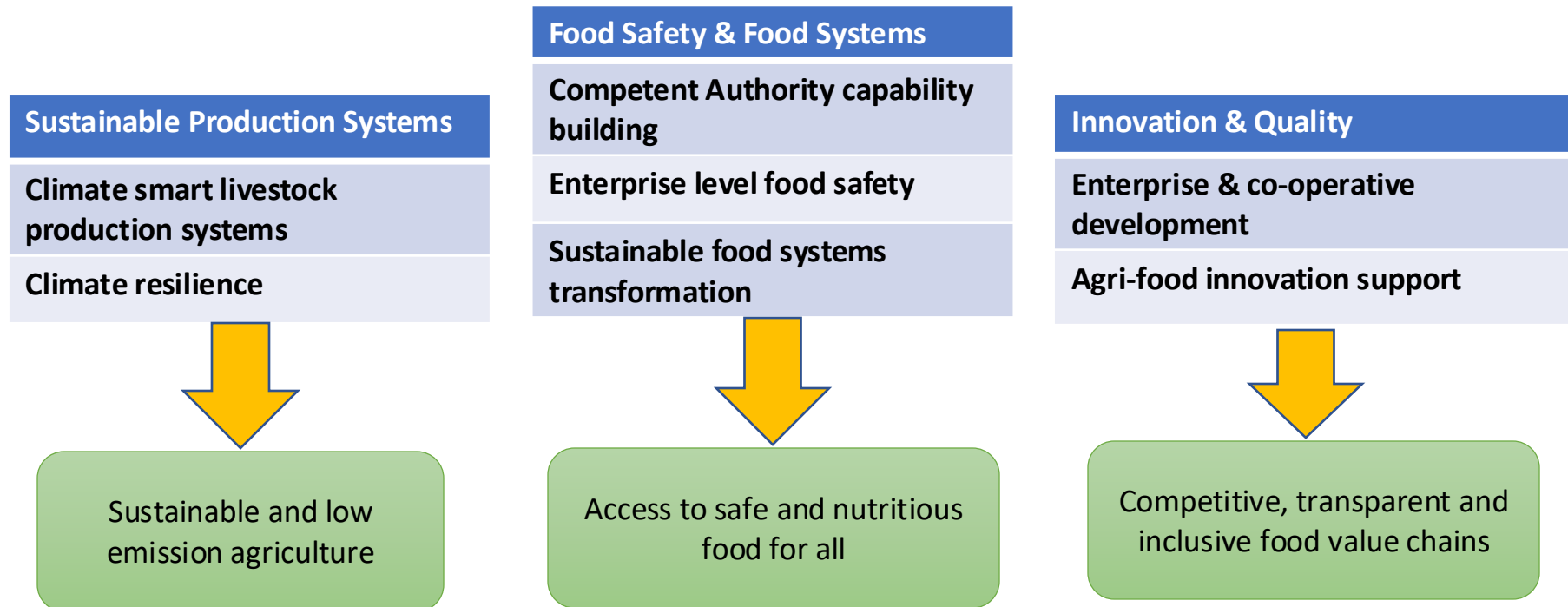
