

Challenges

Mongolia

- Lack of clarity around roles and responsibilities between local and national agencies.
- Delays in preparatory actions (e.g., land and utility planning).
- Limited local capacity for urban transport project preparation and implementation.
- Difficulties in responding quickly enough to DMCs requests due to their complexity.

PRC

- Alignment of project designs with approved master plans.
- Complex approval processes across government levels.
- Institutional changes and scope adjustments affecting project preparation.
- Weak EA capacity (preparation and implementation) in some provinces and need for hands-on support.
