





Tips for preparing EOIs



- Carefully consider whether to participate:
 - Good project references? Experience in country and region?
 - Can you cover the full scope and provide requested experts?
 - Partner(s) needed?
 - Risk analysis

Preparing EOI:

- Prepare high-quality standard answers to section "Management Competence"
- Primary focus on qualifications of lead partner, secondary focus on junior partners
- Full answers to questions; select 10 best references
- Utilise EOI attachments to provide further information
- No need to submit CVs

Tips for proposals




- Use and follow templates
- Allocate time for proposal preparation based on evaluation criteria
- Experts exceeding requirements will score better
- Involve team members with experience of previous ADB projects:
 - Safeguards (environmental, social, gender)
 - Financial management
 - Economic/financial analysis
 - Procurement
- Consider climate change impact on project
- Understand conditions of contract

Experience of implementation



- Little difference to other projects
- Highly competent team leader:
 - Always available
 - Fluent English
 - Understands contract and terms of reference
 - Understands all aspects of the project
- Local competence and representation
- Raise issues promptly contract variations take a while to process
- Keep records (including timesheets)
