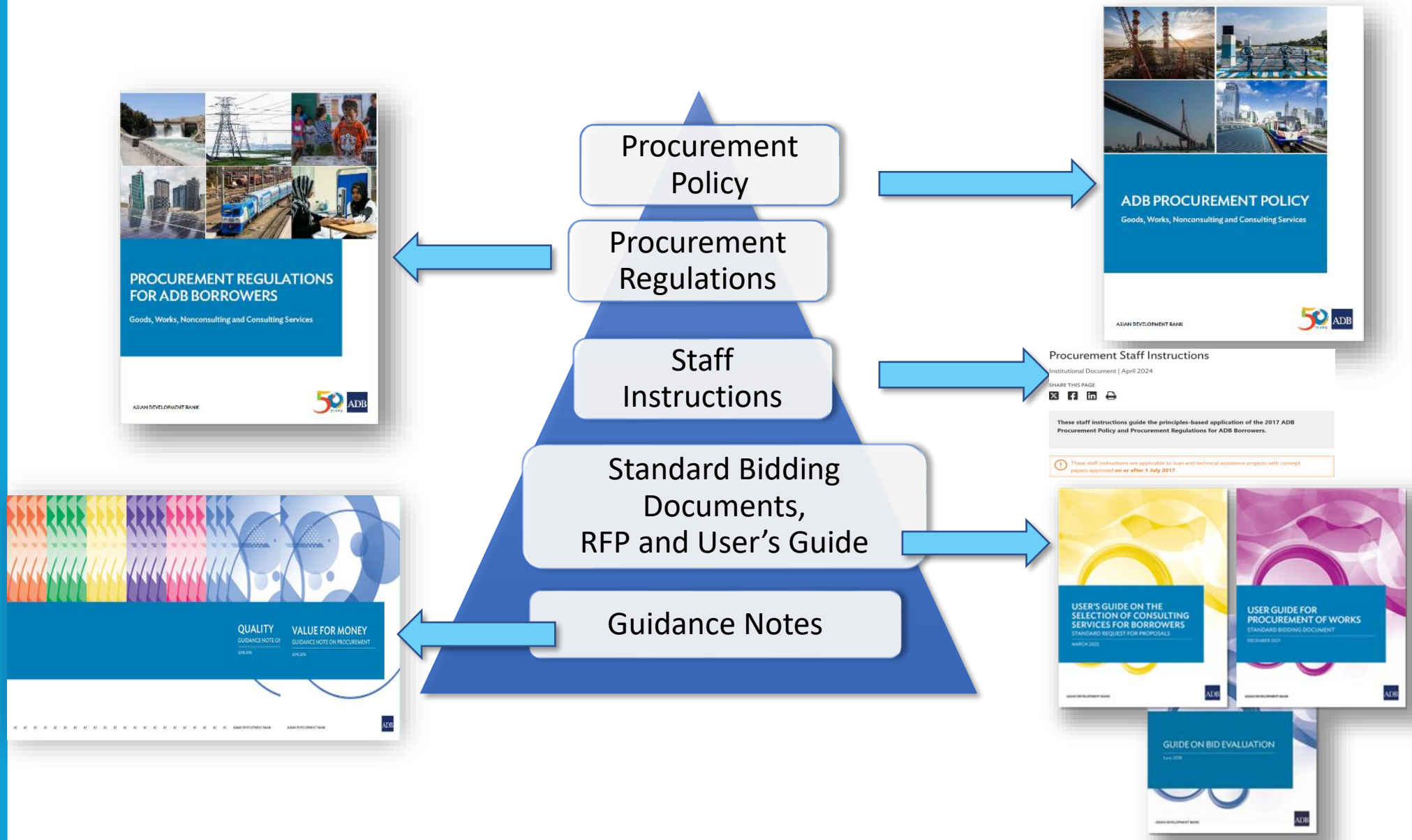

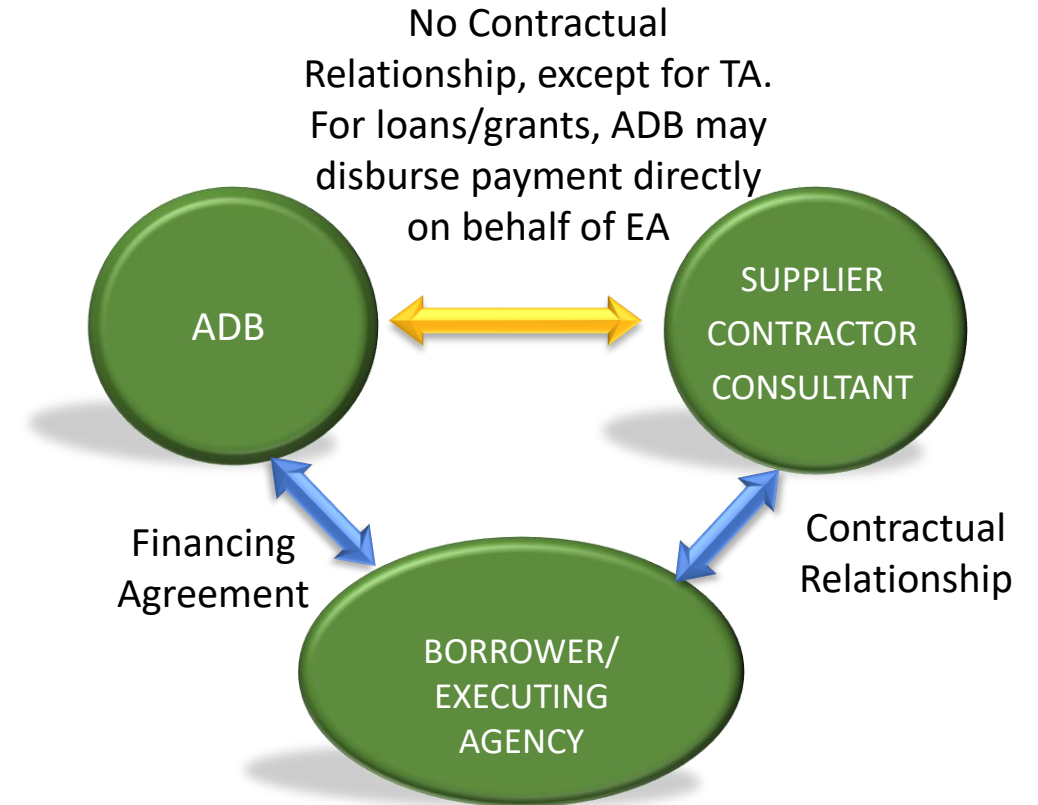


# Relationships, Roles, and Responsibilities in Procurement

The **Borrower** (Executing Agency) is responsible for procurement of goods, works and services

**ADB** (under TAs) or **Borrower** select and recruit Consultants

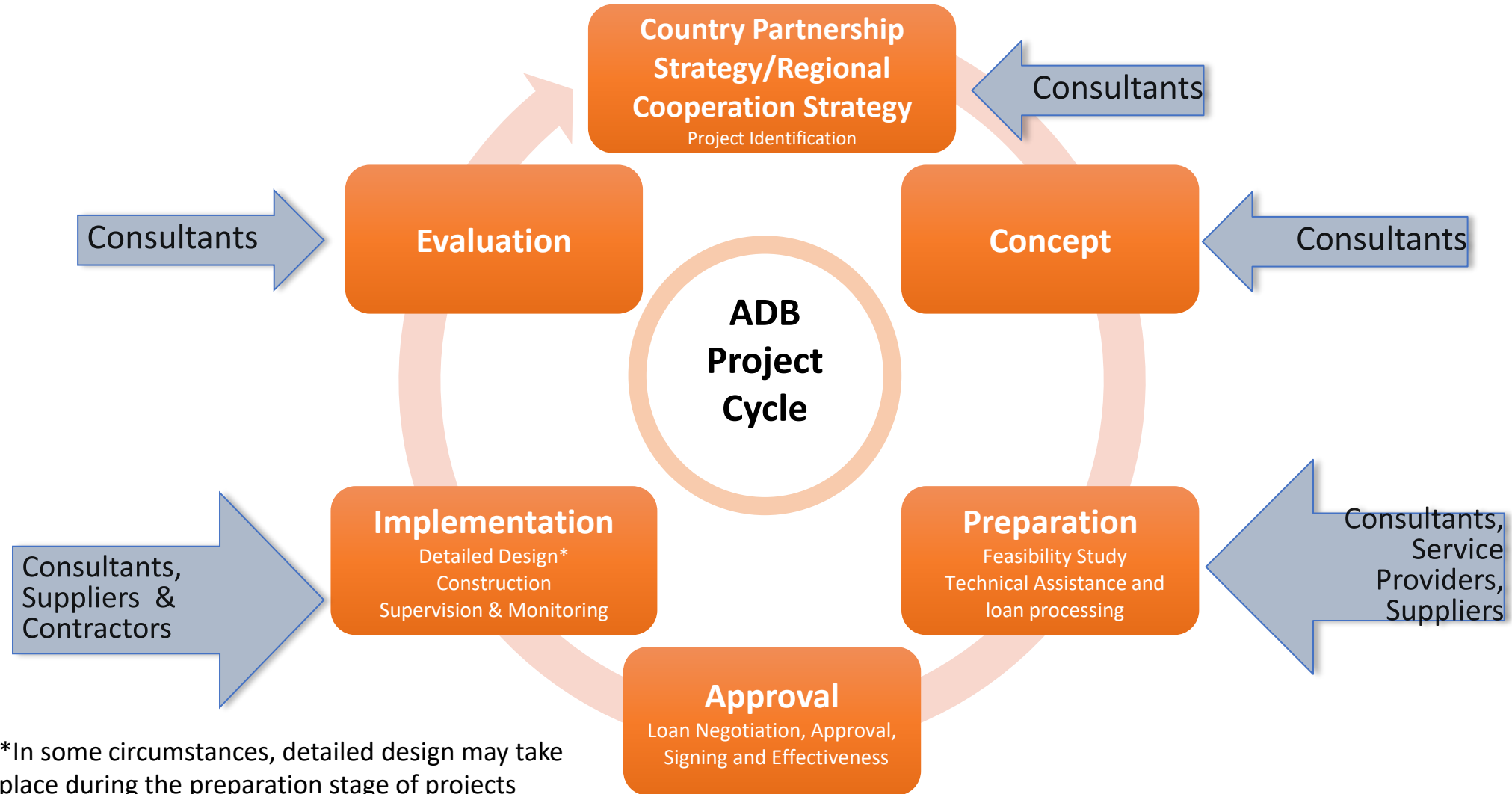
ADB reviews the procurement activities of EAs to ensure that proceeds of its financing are used in accordance with the bank's rules. This is done on either a prior review or post-review basis



**\*Two primary “streams” of procurement:**

- 1) ADB Technical Assistance (ADB = buyer)
- 2) ADB-financed projects (borrower = buyer)

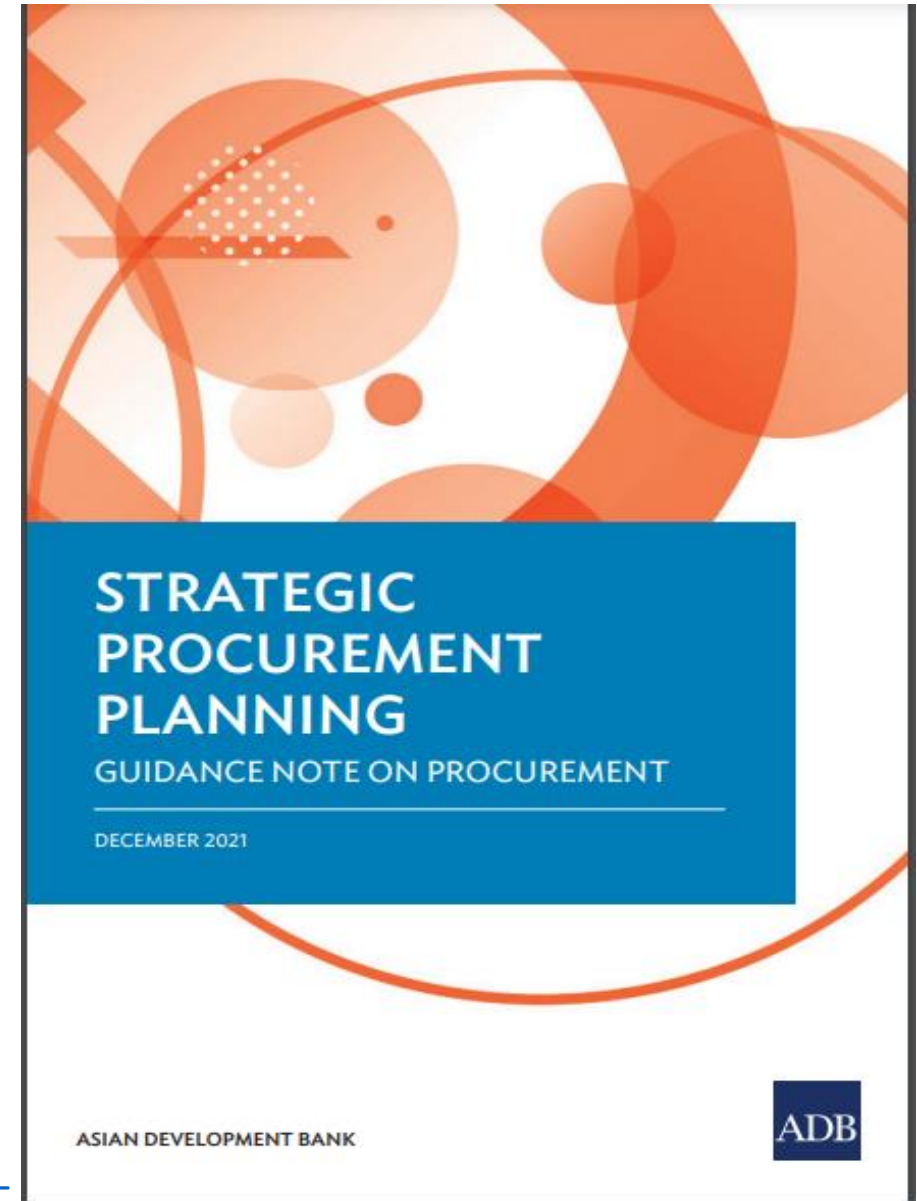

## LOWEST EVALUATED SUBSTANTIALLY RESPONSIVE BID

Under LESRB procedures, Employer to specify clear-cut, pass-fail requirements;

**Eligibility** ( Nationality, COI, ADB eligibility (sanctions), SOEs, UN eligibility)

**Historical non-performance** (History of non-performing contracts and suspension based on execution of bid securing declaration, pending litigation and arbitration, declaration of past performance on EHS)

**Financial Situation** ( Historical financial performance, AACT, Financial resources)

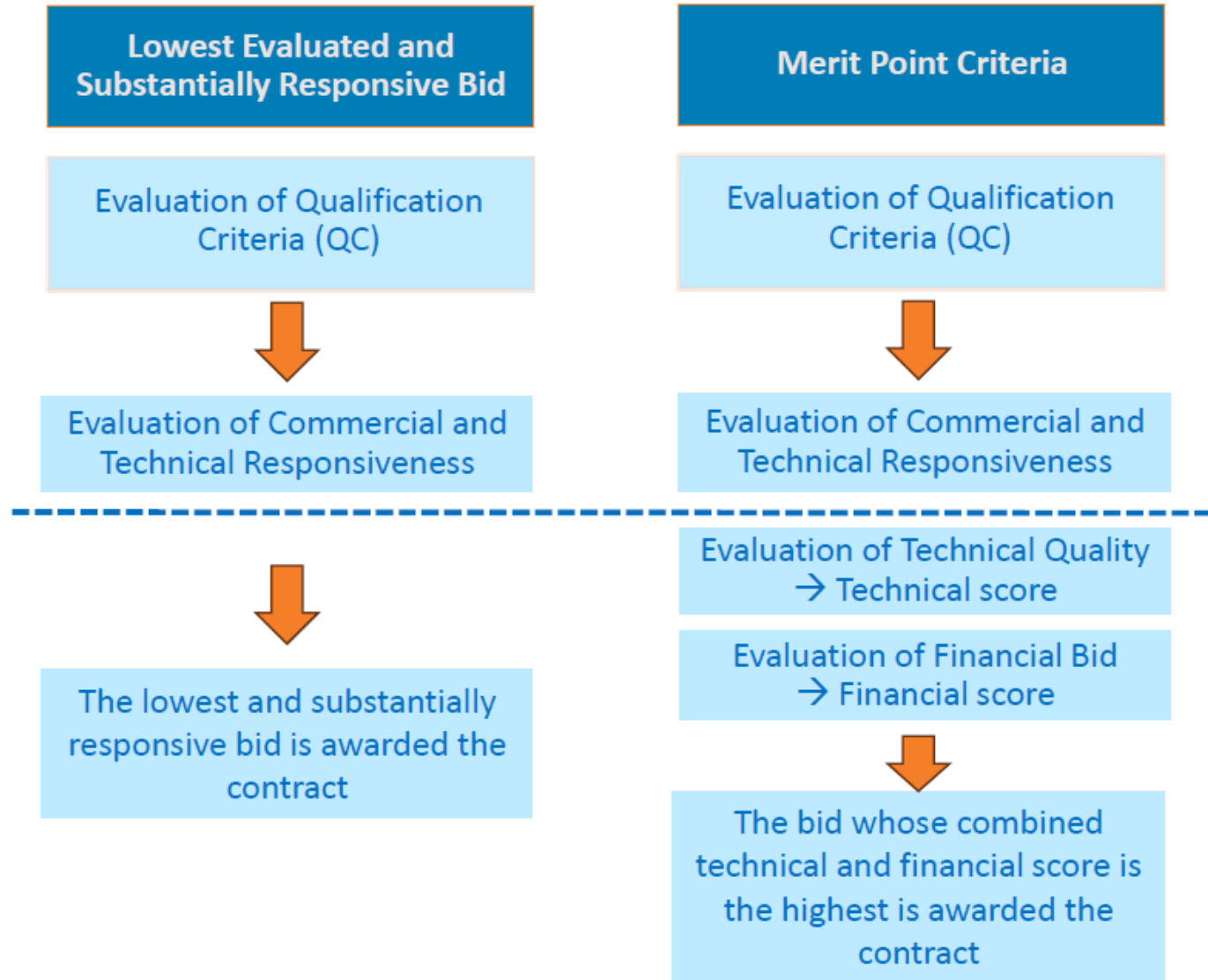
**Construction Experience** ( past contracts similar size and nature and key activities)

**Evaluation Criteria:** adequacy of the technical proposal, completion time, quantifiable nonconformities and omissions, life cycle costing etc. among few others, as appropriate)

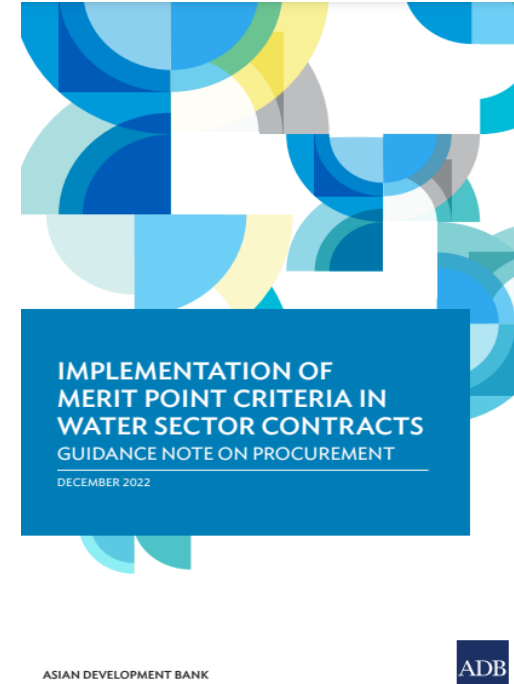
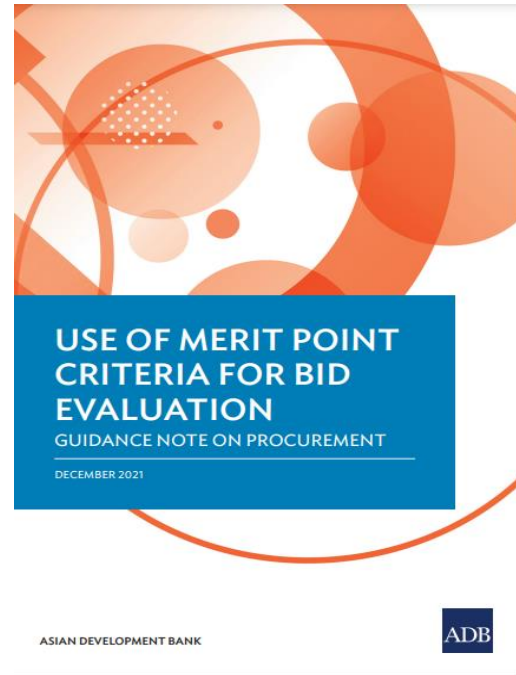
# WHY USE MERIT POINT CRITERIA

- Use of MPC support evaluation of bids by considering both quality and cost. Price alone may not sufficiently represent VFM.
- It facilitate evaluation of bids/proposals by considering non-price attributes including quality, technical and substantiality aspects.
- Better equipped with managing relevant risks such as (environmental, social, supply chain, quality, etc. among others)
- Support in selection of contractors who can deliver the best by allowing them to propose innovation/creativity in project delivery.
