Operational Context

GoPNG National Procurement Act 2018 as amended does not preclude or prevent the use of Framework Agreements (a particular type of contractual arrangement) Already being used in PNG on a small scale Suitable for goods, works, non-consulting services Suitable for consulting services (firms & individuals) UNOPS Web Buy Plus (202 categories, 2089 products)

Features of Framework Agreements

Can be used by 1 agency, a group of agencies, whole of government

Terms and conditions predefined

Call-off (offer, acceptance, consideration, intention, capacity)

Can be established based on pre-agreed pricing, competition, or price revision
