



PRIA's interventions are designed and constructed around 4 pillars



Natural Water Bodies Rejuvenation amid Fragmented Governance and Climate Stress

- Ajmer and Jodhpur face intensifying heat, floods, and water scarcity
- Urban water bodies, once cultural and ecological lifelines, are now encroached, polluted and disconnected from planning systems
- Who owns and maintains water in a city of overlapping institutions?

Our intervention reframes water as a shared climate and cultural asset, not a departmental problem

 - water governance through government–Civil Society–HEI–SHG collaboration
