### Type of ADB Project Processing

- Technical Assistance (TA), including Project Preparatory TA (PPTA), Policy and Advisory TA (PATA), Capacity Development TA (CDTA), Research and Development TA (RDTA), and Regional TA (REG TA).
- Loans (Project, Program, Sector Development Program)
- Grant-financed Projects (Project, Program, Sector Development Program)



#### Most Common Procurement and Recruitment Methods Used by SAFM

- Procurement methods: International Competitive Bidding (ICB), National Competitive Bidding (NCB), Shopping, and Direct Contracting
- Selection methods for recruiting consulting firms: Quality-and Cost-Based Selection (QCBS), Quality-Based Selection (QBS), Consultants' Qualification Selection (CQS), Single Source Selection (SSS)
- Selection methods for recruiting individual consultants: qualifications-based.
