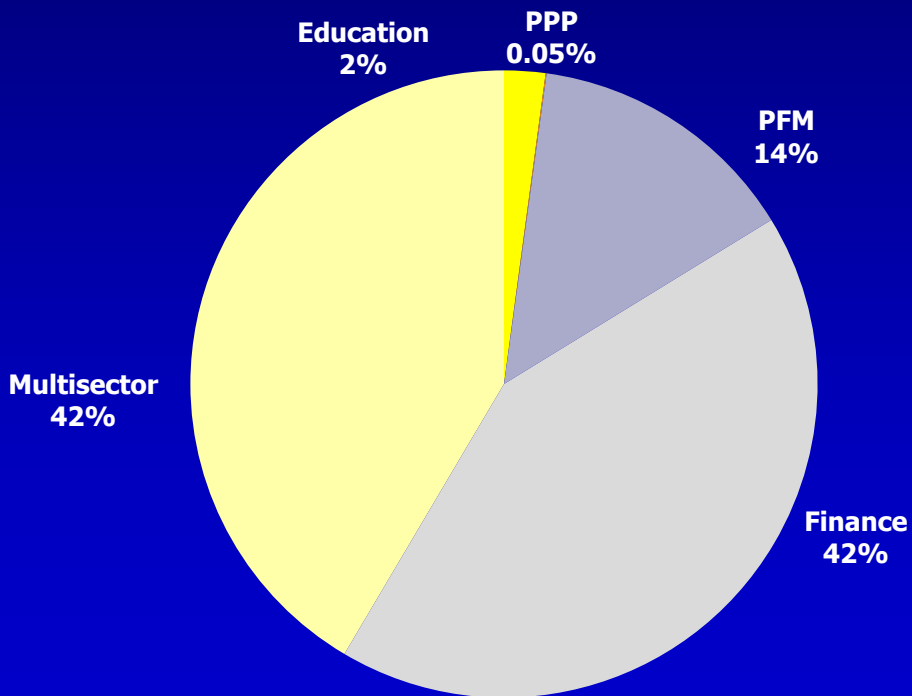

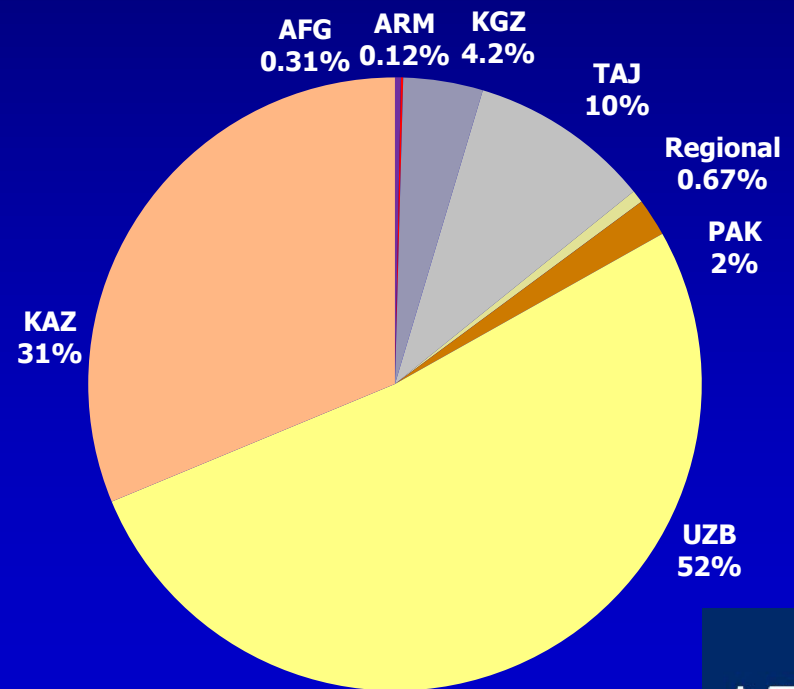

By Sub-sector

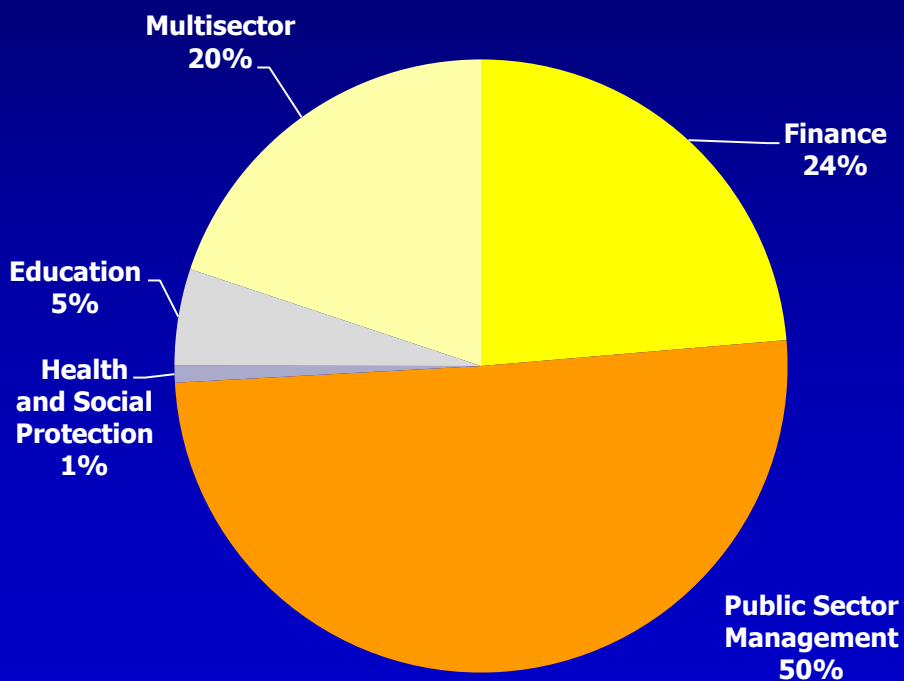

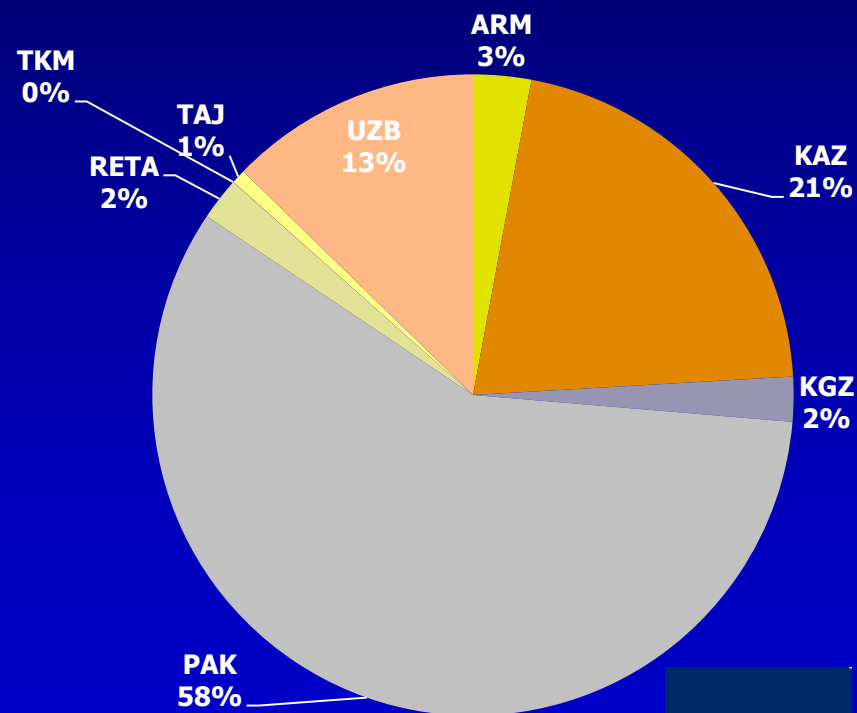
