MALACAÑANG PALACE

THIS WAS THE FORMER SITE OF SUMMER RESIDENCE PURCHASED IN 1802 FROM LUIS ROCHA BY COLONEL MIGUEL JOSE FORMENTO, WHOSE TESTAMENTARY EXECUTORS SOLD IT TO THE SPANISH GOVERNMENT IN 1825. DECREES OF 1847, THIS PROPERTY WAS SET ASIDE AS THE SUMMER RESIDENCE OF THE GOVERNOR GENERAL. THE PALACE IN INTRAMUROS HAVING BEEN DESTROYED BY THE EARTHQUAKE OF JUNE 3. 1863, THE GOVERNOR GENERAL MOVED TO THIS PLACE. THEN KNOWN AS THE "POSESION MALACANAN:' THIS BUILDING RECONSTRUCTED, NEW LOTS WERE PURCHASED, OLD GROUNDS RAISED, REGRADED AND PARKED DURING AMERICAN AND FILIPINO ADMINISTRATIONS. EXTENSIVE IMPROVE-MENTS WERE MADE IN 1929-1932 UNDER GOVERNOR GENERAL DWIGHT F. DAVIS AND IN 1935-1940 UNDER PRESIDENT MANUEL L. QUEZON, THE FIRST FILIPINO CHIEF EXECUTIVE TO OCCUPY THIS PALACE.



- Casa Roces is a full-service restaurant and café located in the genteel district of San Miguel, Manila, right across the most prestigious address in the country: Malacañan Palace.
 - Drawing inspiration from the Roces family's long line of freedom-fighters, pioneer journalists and artists, the quaint ancestral home has been reborn into a stylish restaurant best described as classic-meets-contemporary

Arlegui Mansion



- Laperal Mansion or the Arlegui Guest House. Located along Arlegui St.
- In World War II broke out, it served at one point as the residence of the speaker of the National Assembly (legislature) established by the Japan-sponsored Second Philippine Republic who happens to be Benigno Aquino Sr., the grandfather of current Philippine president Benigno Aquino III.






History comes alive as you enter Intramuros through Puerta de Isabel II, a walking distance of about 20 meters from Plaza Mexico Ferry Station. Intramuros, which means "within the walls", confined the Old City of Manila. Inside these walls are old churches, schools, museums, fortifications and other heritage structures.

Also inside this walled city are three museums, namely, Casa



within the vicinity are Fort Santiago, Hotel Inramuros, Palacio del Governador, Aduana Ruins, Ayuntamiento Ruins and Baluarte de San Diego.

After the long walk and reminiscing of the past, you can shop for souvenirs at the Silahis Arts and Crafts or Manansan Souvenir Shop and dine at Barbara's Restaurant or Illustrado's Fine Dining Restaurant.

What you will see on board...

On the north bank of Pasig River, you will see the Muelle dela Industria and Muelle del Banco Linear Parks followed by two heritage structures - the SMS and El Hogar building while on the south bank, you'll find the Muelle de Rio Linear Park. And just before you approach the next station you'll pass underneath the Jones Bridge.


