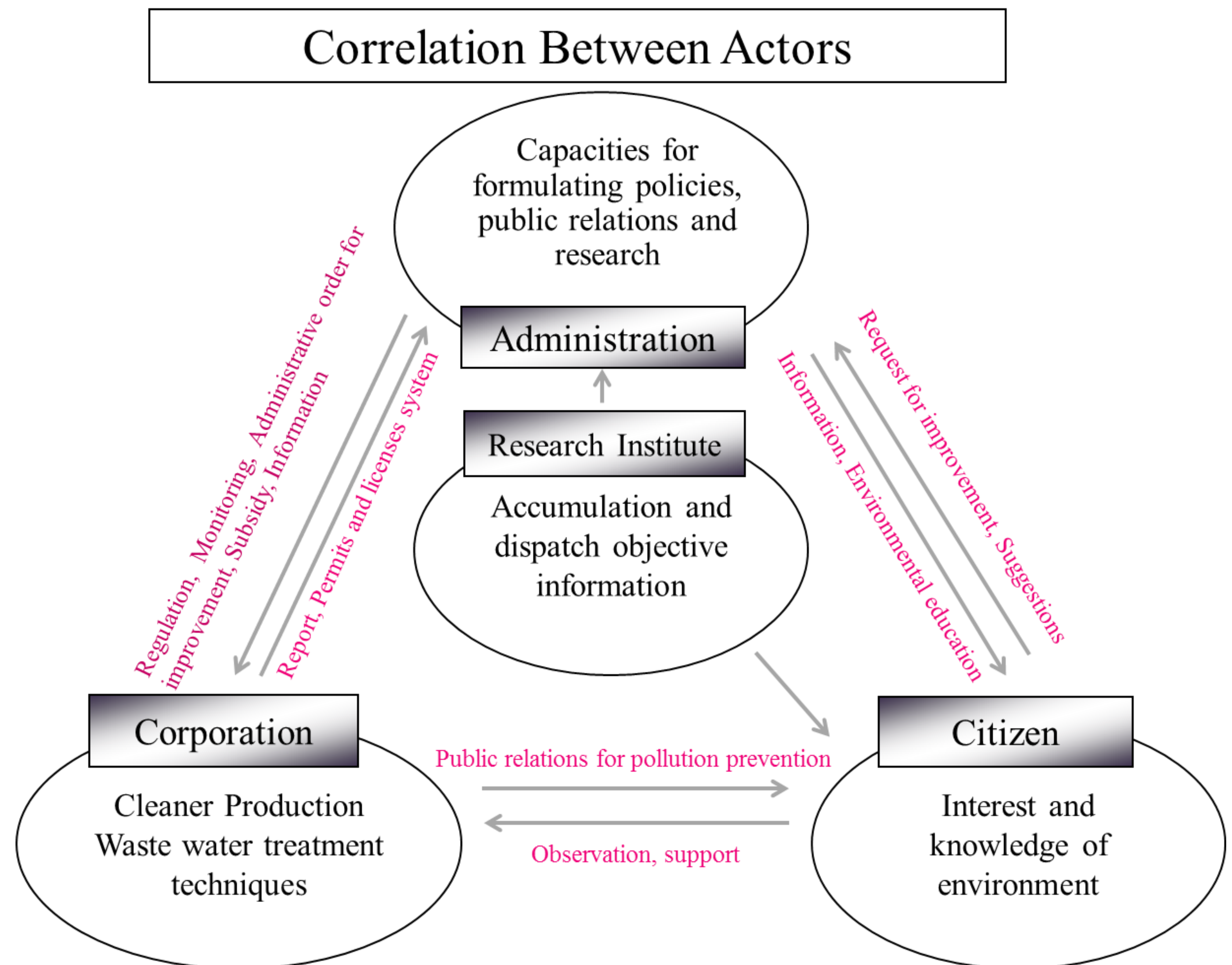

Abstract:

JICA aims to develop the capacity of the society as a whole to cope with water environmental management by enhancing the capacity of each of the “four parties” in the recipient country, the government, businesses, citizens and universities or research institute and encouraging “four parties” to cooperate effectively.

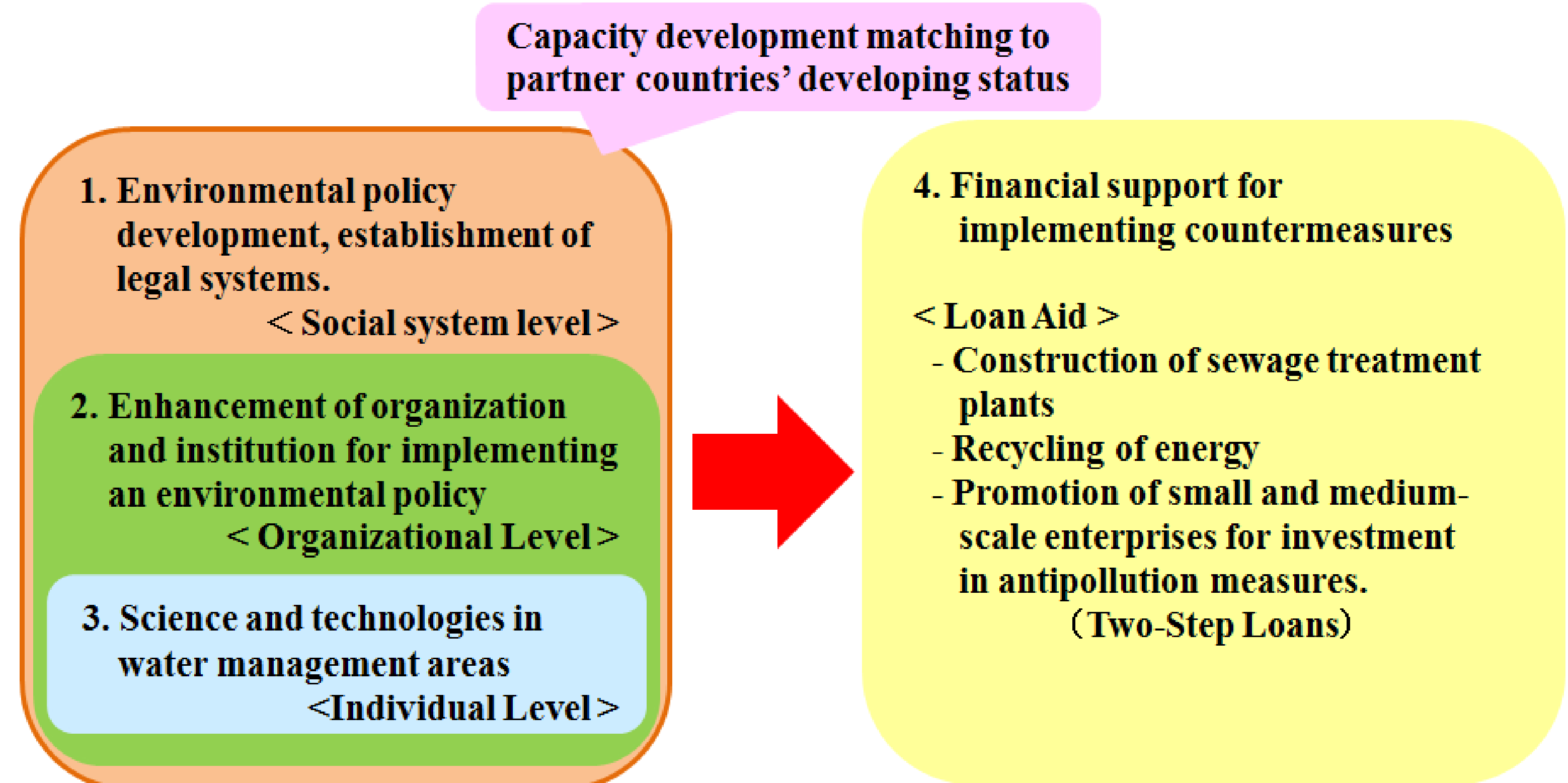
In response to needs of Asian Developing countries which has been tackling water environmental problems in urban areas, JICA has supported to improve water environmental management, emphasizing on the following four points.

- (1) Support for formulating water environment policies and developing legal systems
- (2) Support for enhancing organizations and institution to ensure effectiveness of countermeasures
- (3) Support for developing environmental science and technology for water environmental management
- (4) Financial Support for implementation of countermeasures



<Priority Cooperation Areas>

Cooperation in the following 4 priority areas are carried out based on the capacity development of government organizations by considering water pollutions, regional and water environment.
