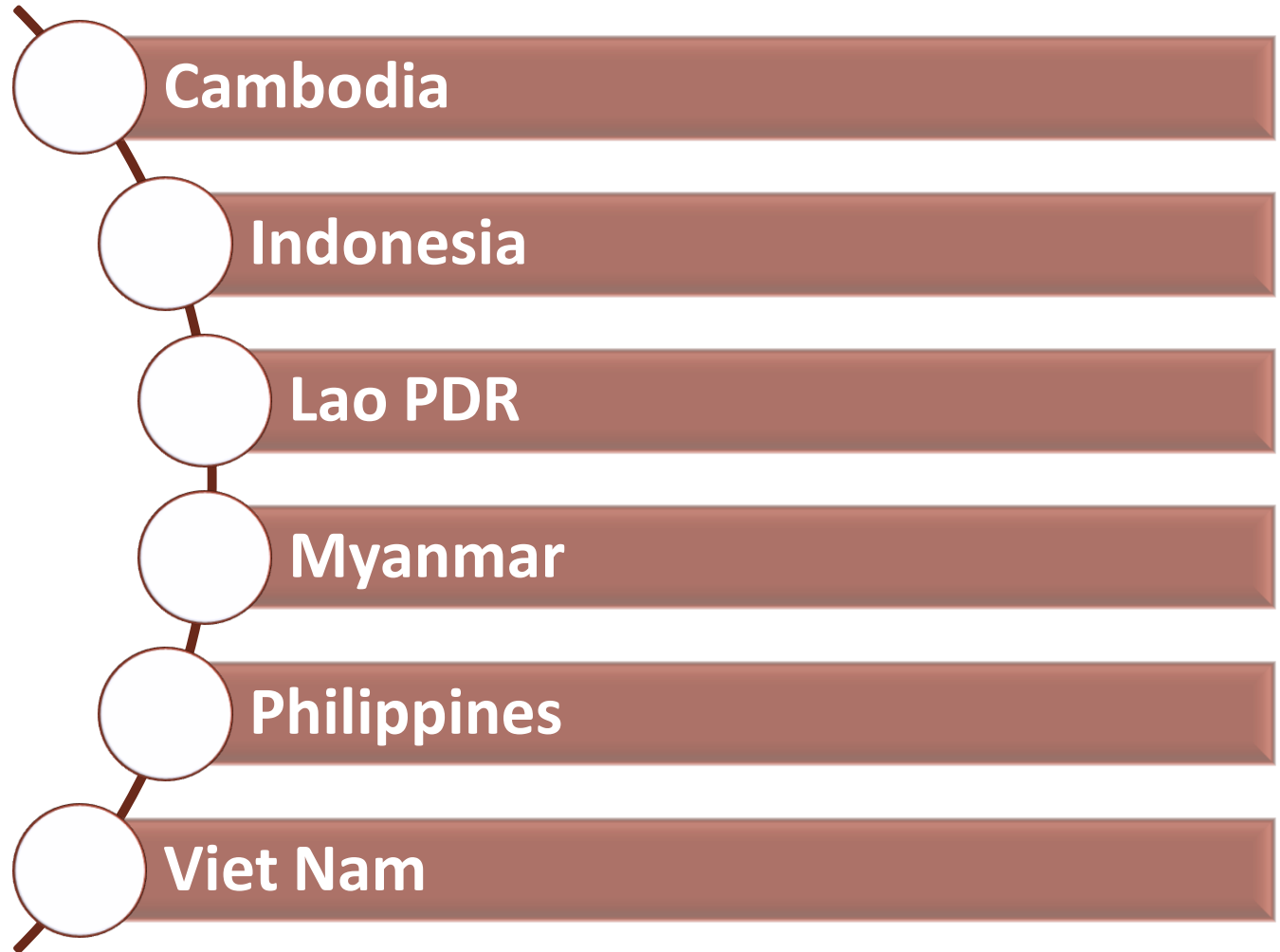

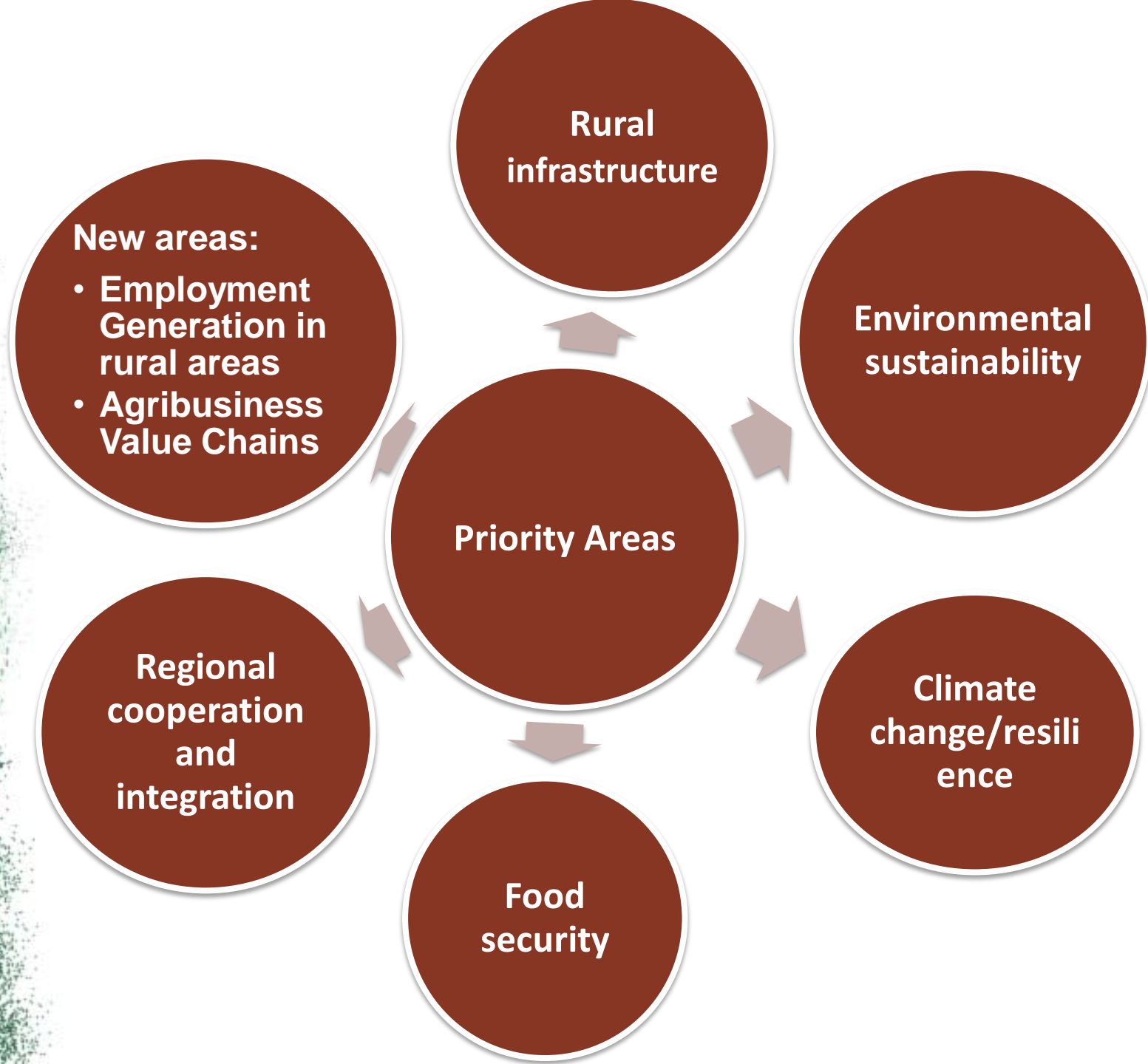
Country Coverage: Six Countries





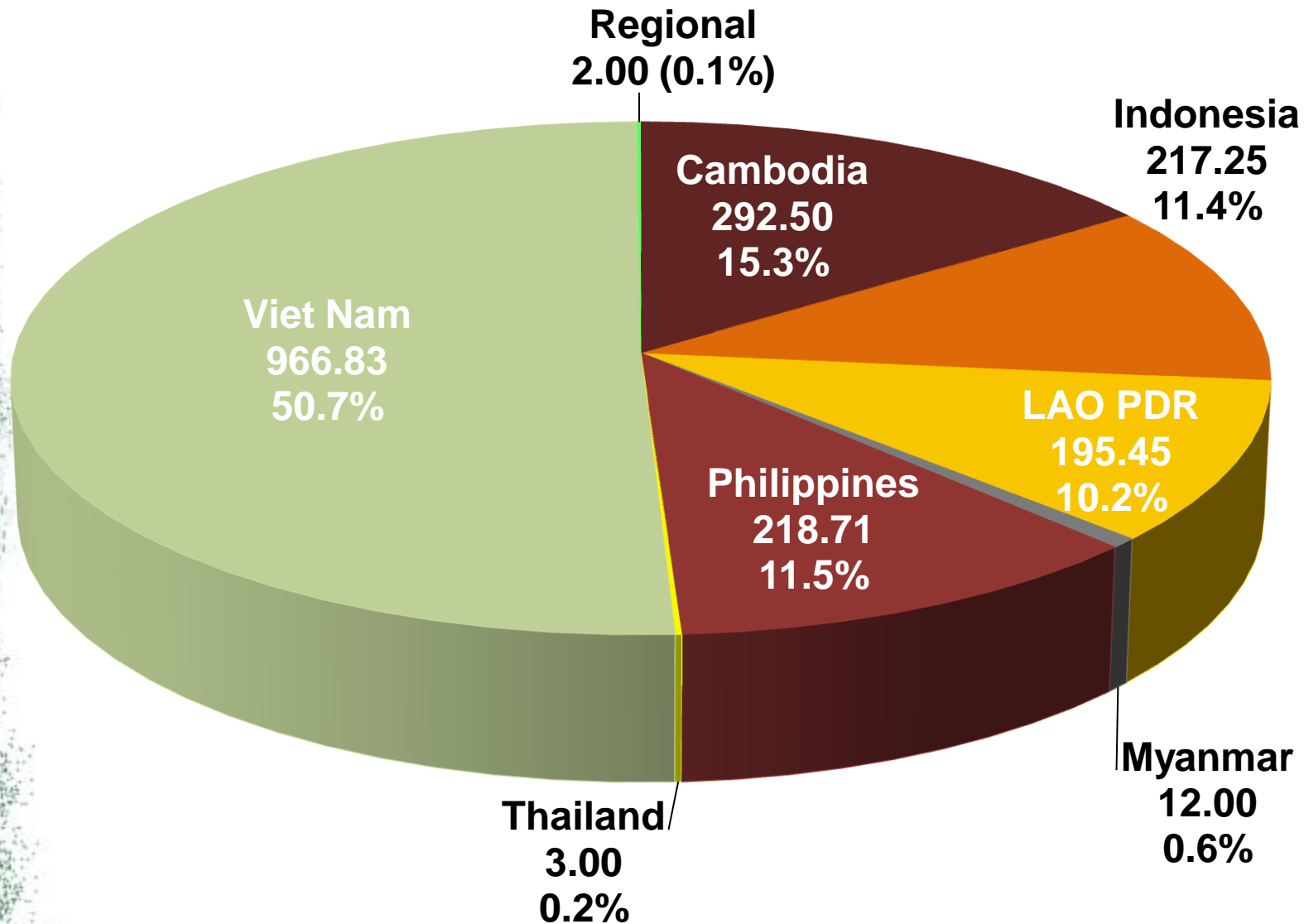
Sector Strategy

- ✓ Protect, maintain and improve productive potential and performance of **land and water resources** assets for sustained and **inclusive economic growth**



Country	Structural Policy Focus
Cambodia	Agriculture/agribusiness modernization, diversification, and commercialization coupled with climate resilience, management of biodiversity conservation, and regional cooperation and integration.
Indonesia	Enhance water, natural resources and environmental sustainability by integrating food security and climate change adaptation and mitigation concerns.
Lao PDR	Rural connectivity infrastructure, climate-friendly value chain development, and climate resilient water resources management for agriculture sector modernization, competitiveness - both in country and subregionally, coupled with conservation of forest resources.
Myanmar	Supporting agriculture/agribusiness and water/irrigation resource management for improved rural economy/incomes, agriculture modernization, commercialization and diversification.
Philippines	Sustaining land and water assets for increasing rural incomes, employment and climate resilience.
Viet Nam	Agriculture/agribusiness sector restructuring and rural development for enhanced competitiveness and climate resilience coupled with management of biodiversity conservation corridors and protected areas.
