- Divided into three roles: substance, lobby, and campaign.

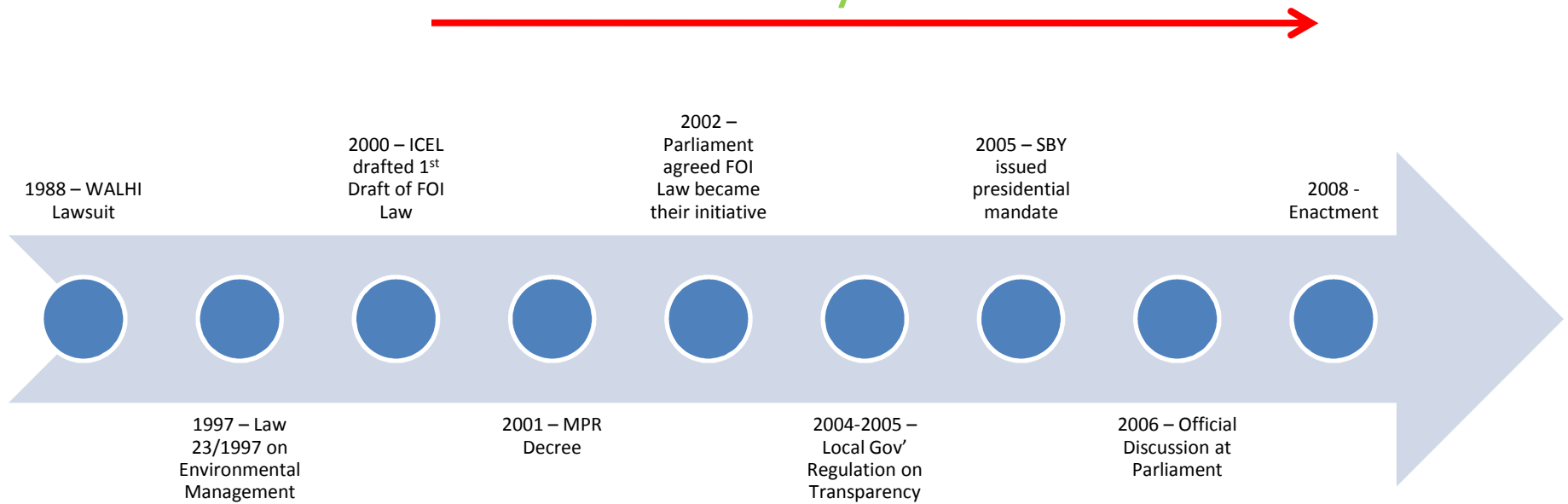


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History Stages

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Substantial Challenges?

- From FOI Law itself:
 - The independence of Information Commission;
 - Reason for a request (contradict with international standards).
- From other law and regulation:
 - Law on Information and Electronic Transaction;
 - Law on State Secrets;
 - Law on Mass Organizations.



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Implementation Challenges?

- Only 48,36% (341 of 705) public bodies that has PPID. This is not include the development of SOP of public information services, and list of public information;
- Number of 48,36% contrast to public information services;
- The “independence” of Information Commission does not independent.
