


#### Integrity Violations in ADB-financed Projects (1998-January 2016)



#### Integrity Violations in ADB-financed Projects in Bhutan (1998-January 2016)








### **Consequences of Integrity Violations** in ADB-financed Projects

- Termination of loan or grant allocations
- Return of misused loan or grant resources back to ADB
- Changes of administrative arrangements
