- About 540 km of rural roads rehabilitated
- Road safety output= \$1.25 million
- through consulting services

- ➤ Increasing road crash deaths yearly: 15 per 100,000 persons in 2015
- Country's 80% rural population
- > 82% crashes: motorcycles
- > 90% crashes: due to user behavior
- ➤ Major causes: drunk driving; not wearing helmet
