### The Safe Crossings program (3 pillars)

Create a low-speed zone – target speed max 50 km/hr Give road safety education to vulnerable road users

Create commitment from the local community









# Reduction in number of people killed of 75%

**Before interventions:** 

110 serious crashes, 12 deaths, and 240 injured people per year(3 pilot locations combined)

| Effect of Intervention Program | REDUCTION<br>(%) |
|--------------------------------|------------------|
| Number of crashes              | 62%              |
| Number of people injured       | 68%              |
| Number of people killed        | 75%              |

# 3 suggestions for policy makers:

- 1. Make improvement of road safety for vulnerable road users a priority in government policy
- 2. Identify the locations ("black spots") with a high number of crashes involving vulnerable road users and develop an accurate road crash database system
- 3. Provide government support and funding to pilot our integrated speed management program in Bangladesh and new countries.
