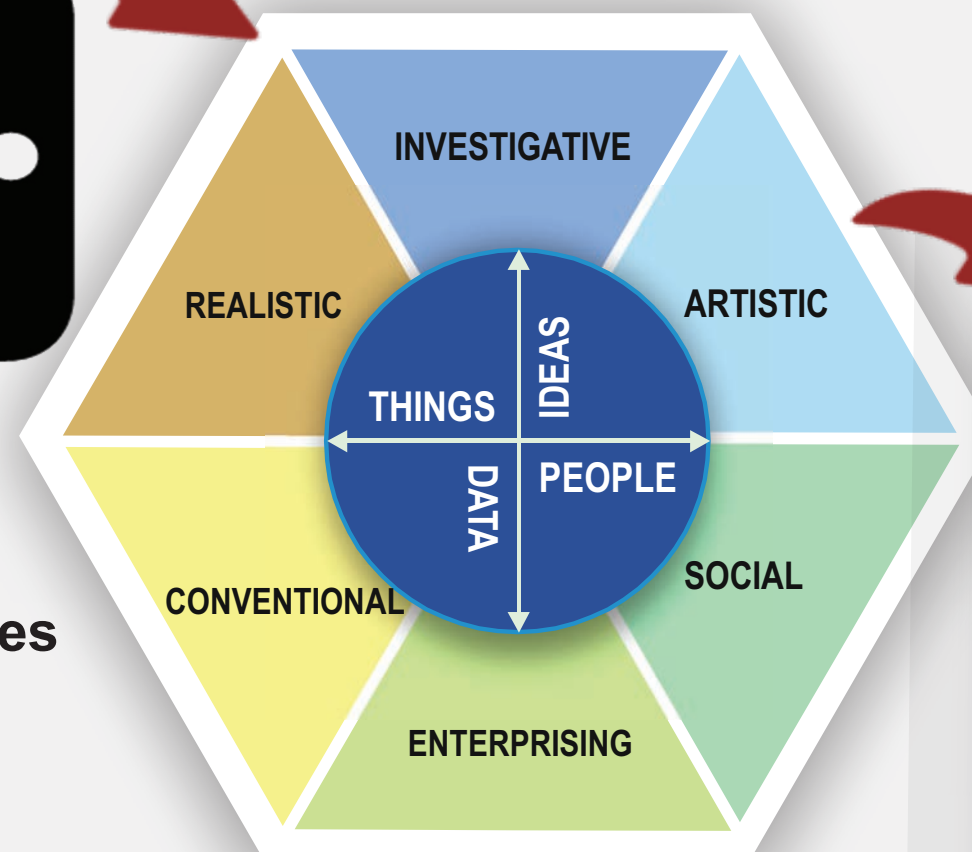

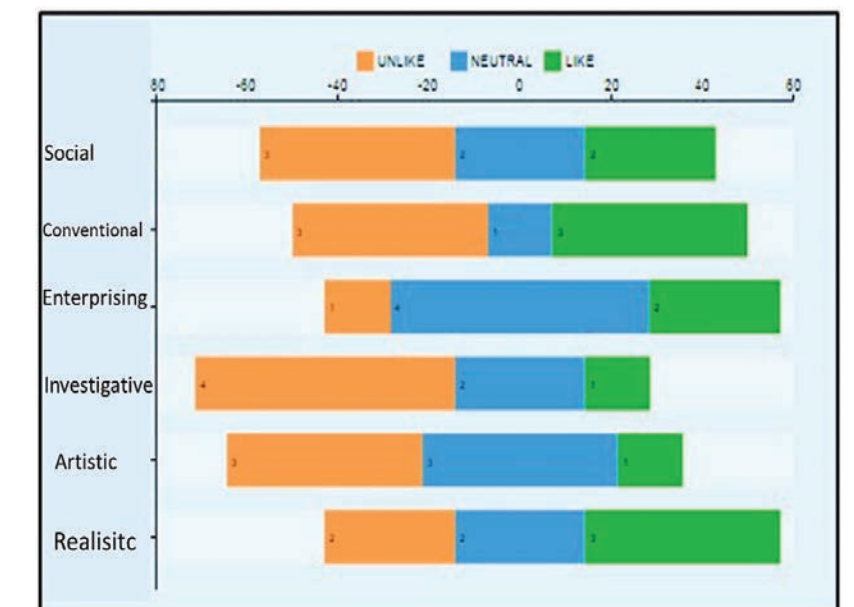

based on Holland's Code**



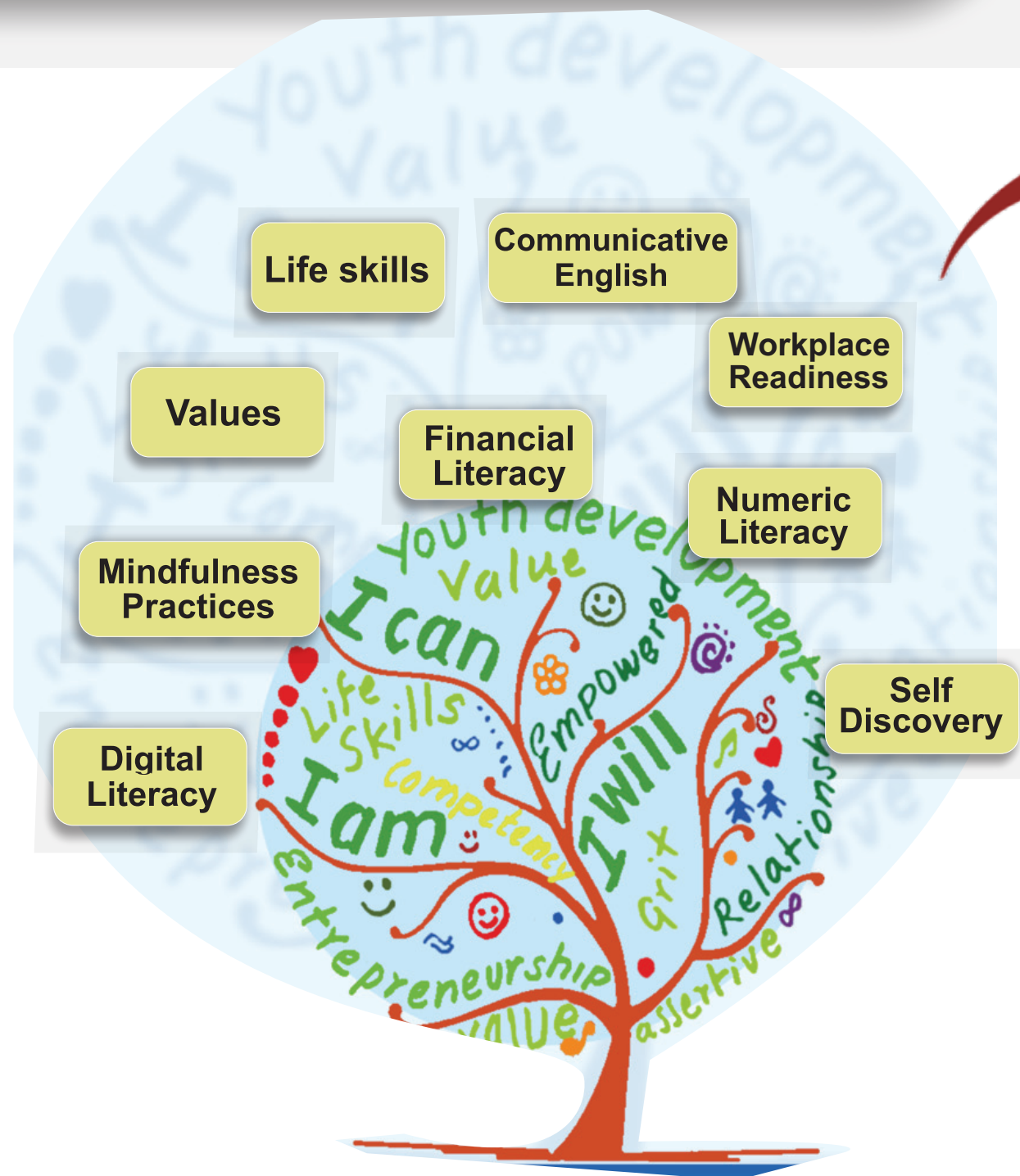

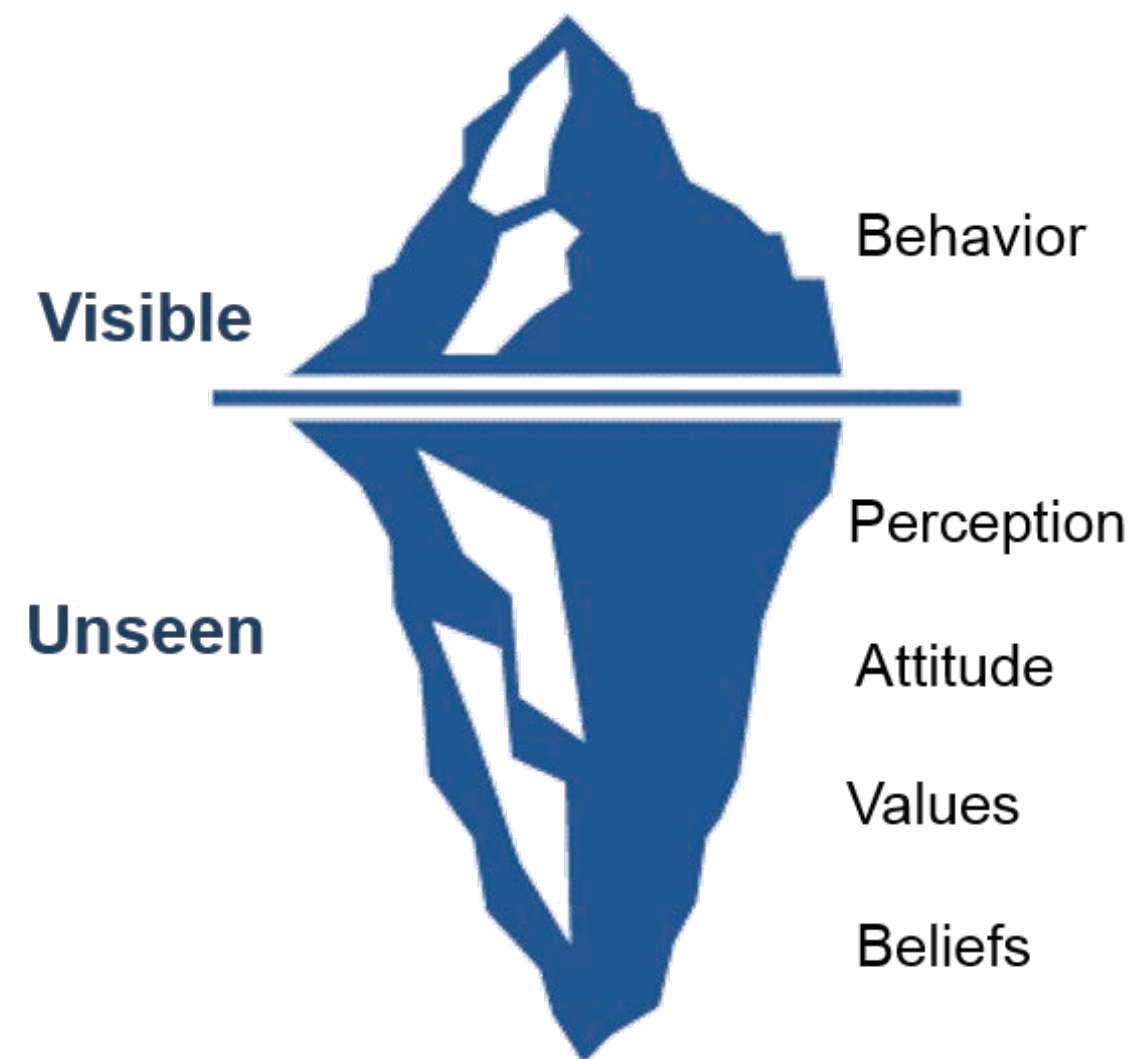

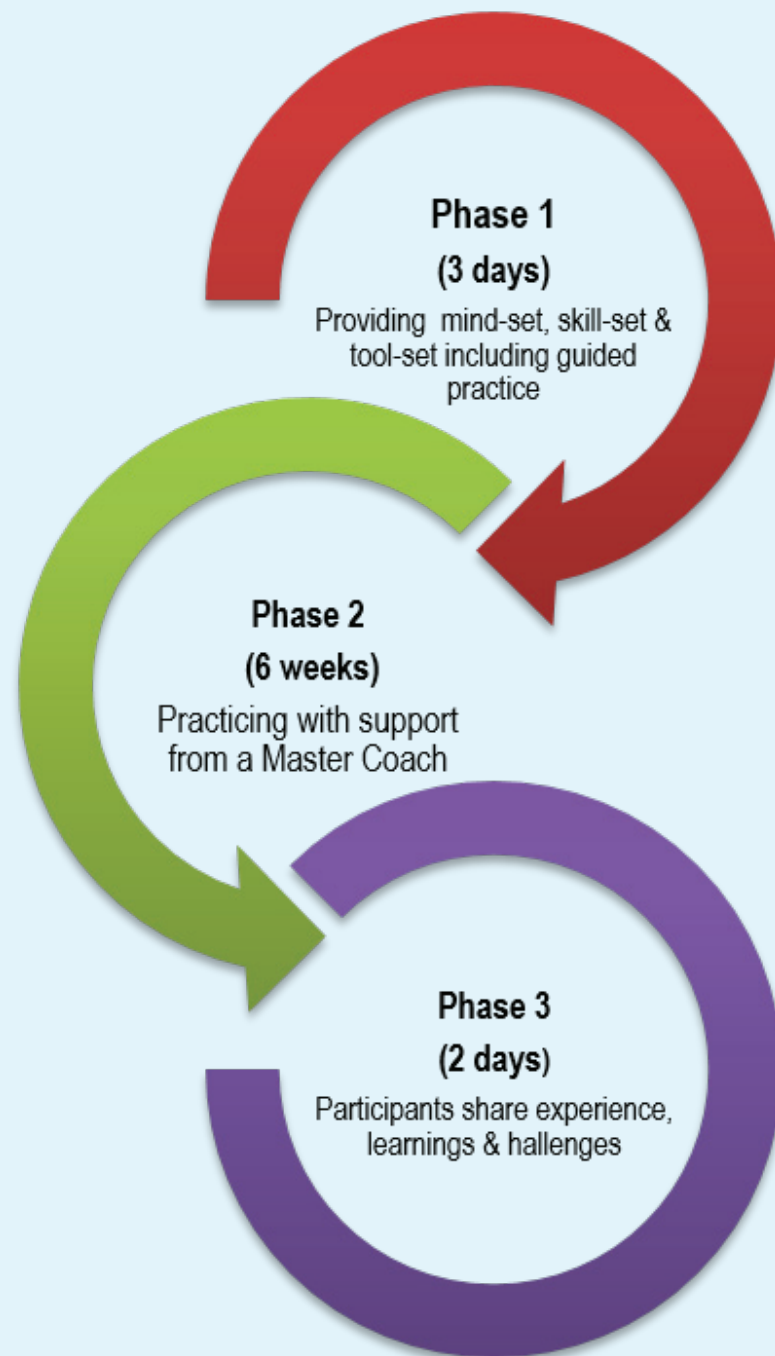


Iceberg Model

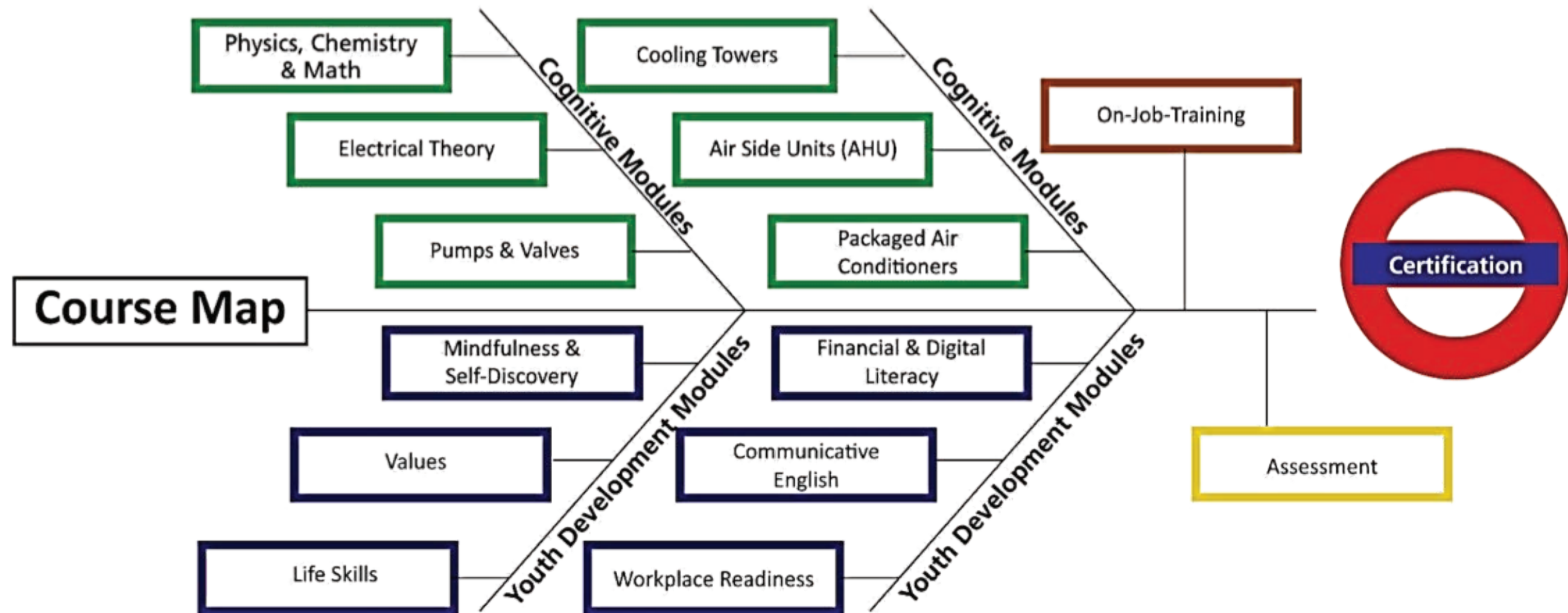

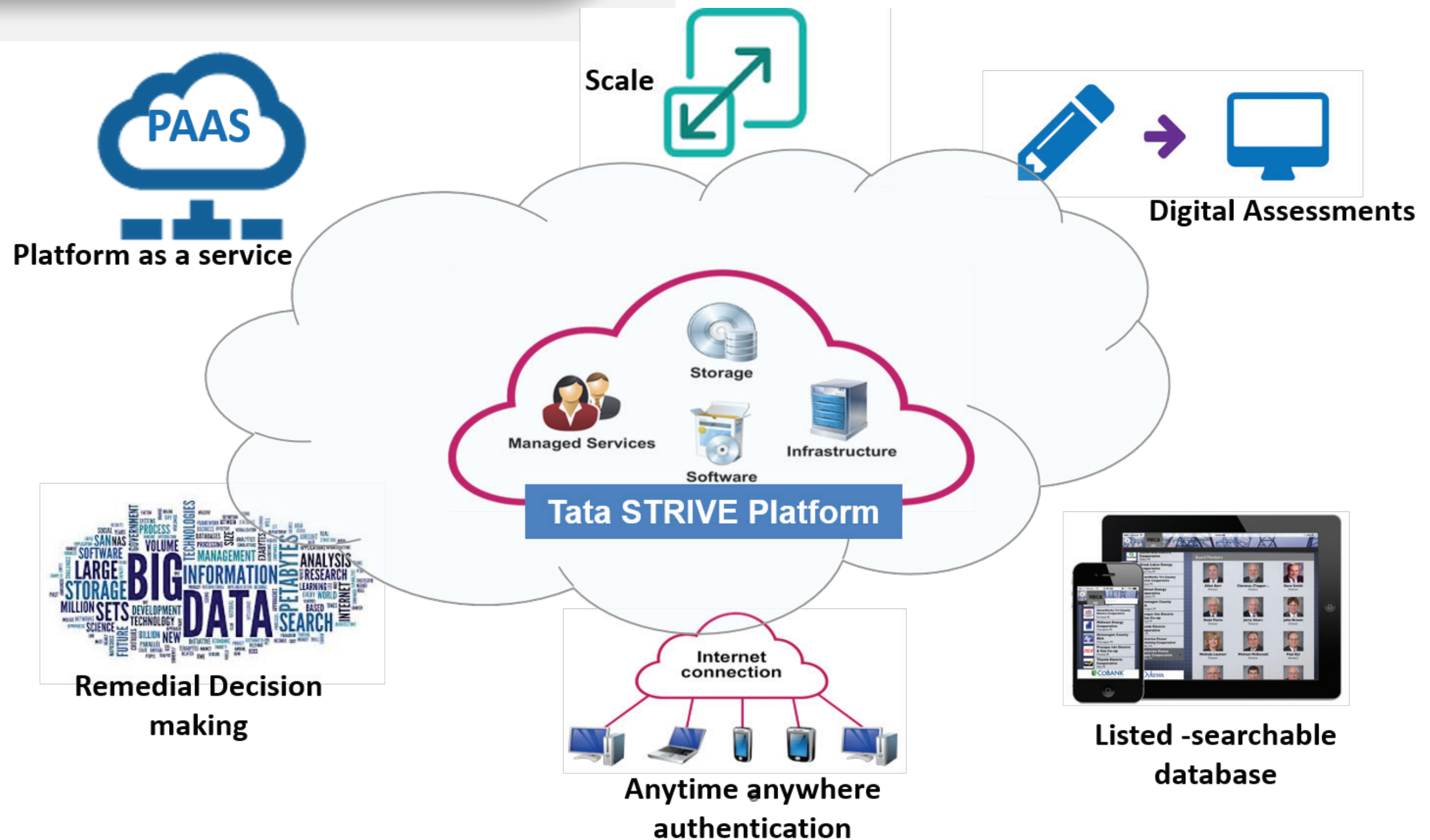
