# Key feature of Safetipin

## What is a safety audit

- Based on global experience of 20 years of safety audits
- 8 important parameters that define safety perception

Lighting	Openness
Transport	Visibility
Crowd	Gendered Usage
Walk Path	Security

Includes a parameter 'Feeling' in addition



#### **Features**

- Set of 3 apps
- Conduct safety audits and record other information
- Crowdsourced data
- Gives Safety Score
- More than 50,000 downloads






## **Doing Audits**












Each audit will appear as a pin on the Safetipin app

Each point gets uploaded immediately and is then available for anyone to see.

The red pins signify unsafe points, orange a bit safer and green pins would be relatively safe points.










## Streetlight Data in Delhi










## **BUS STOPS**

- Working with the Community for identifying issues, auditing and preparing a Community Action Plan.












## Impact Project: Low Income Neighborhood

## KEY INSIGHTS STREETLIGHT


Most streets and public places are not well lit. Poor maintenance of streets lights is seen as a key reason for no light in most spaces.






