RIGHT TO PRIVACY and RIGHT TO INFORMATION

Right to information (RTI) laws provide a fundamental right for any person to <u>access</u> <u>information</u> held by government bodies. At the same time, right to privacy laws grant individuals a fundamental right to <u>control</u> <u>the collection of, access to, and use of</u> personal information about them that is held by governments and private bodies.

RIGHTS DEFINED



"The right of access to information held by government bodies (RTI) provides that individuals have a basic human right to demand information held by government bodies. It derives from the right of freedom of expression to 'seek and receive information', and is recognized worldwide as a human right. RIGHTS DEFINED



- The Republic Act No. 10173, also known as **The Data Privacy Act of 2012**
- 1. Protects the privacy of individuals while ensuring free flow of information to promote innovation and growth
- 2. Regulates the collection, recording, organization, storage, updating or modification, retrieval, consultation, use, consolidation, blocking, erasure or destruction of personal data.
- 3. Ensures that the Philippines complies with international standards set for data protection through National Privacy Commission (NPC).

"Although it (right to privacy) is often summarized as 'the right to be left alone,' it encompasses a wide range of rights including protection from intrusions into family and home life, control of sexual and reproductive rights, and communications secrecy. It is commonly recognized as а core right that underpins human




