



Strategy Framework to Ensure Ecological Integrity, Clean & Healthy Environment



Subsector Outcome 1: Biodiversity and functioning of



ecosystem services sustained







Intensifying sustainable management of natural resources

- Complete delineation of final forest limits and enforce delimitation and zoning of municipal waters
- Strengthen law enforcement against illegal trade of wildlife species and management of coastal and marine
- Improve land administration and management

Expanding development of sustainable resource-based industries

- Promote sustainable forest-based, agroforestry and sustainable fisheries and marine-based industries
- Develop system for ABS of wealth from genetic resources
- Promote and develop ecotourism and cultural sites

Mainstreaming ecosystem values into development planning

- Institutionalize ecosystem valuation and natural resource monitoring system
- Develop a policy for Payments for Ecosystem Services

 Strengthen mechanism to conduct a post or rapid disaster needs assessment




Strengthen M&E of the effectiveness of CC and DRRM actions





