


Fellowship in Korea: Optimization



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Who are coming?

- Asian countries: China, Mongolia, Thailand, India, Taiwan, Vietnam,
 etc
- Junior specialist, Experienced specialist, Managers, etc
- Surgery, Radiology, Plastic Surgery, Internal Medicine, Dermatology,
 Orthopedic surgery, etc
- Self-, government-, Society-, NGO-funded, etc
- Weeks ~ Months

Why do they come?

- Learning advanced medical skills and knowledge
 - Intensive training of a specific skill: Hair implantation, Davinci, etc
 - Advanced skill by specialties and subspecialties: congenital vascular malformation, etc
 - General training by specialties: OBGY, Radiology, etc.
- Observing advanced medical institutes: SMC, AMC, etc.
- Carrier of the training abroad
 - Short-term fellowship, Presentation in congress, etc
- Networking with experts in advanced institutes.
- Taking a chance to visit abroad
 - Seoul project, Medical Korea Academy, etc
- Meeting friends in parallel

How can they come?

- Korean government-supported projects
 - Medical Korea Academy, etc
 - Apply to local partner organization or society to be selected
 - Financial support by Korean government
- NGO (society)-supported projects
 - Fellowship program by specialty societies (Korean Society of Radiology, Korean Cardiology Society, etc)
 - Financial support by Korean NGO
- Institute-supported programs
 - AMC Interventional Fellowship, etc
 - 개인별 지원

How can they come?

- Vendor-supported program
 - Guerbet fellowship, etc
 - Invited by local agency
- Individual invitation
 - by personal bonding w Korean tutors
 - Different financial support

What do they expect?

- Clinical observation: Surgery, Procedures, OPD clinic, etc.
- Structured Hands-on training
- International academic events: Congress, Seminar, etc
- Involving clinical practice
- Domestic academic events in Korea or institutes
- Networking with tutor: personal difference
- Medical system observation
- Experiencing Korean culture

How do they stay?

- Reserving accommodation
 - Institute: Guest house, Dormitory, Hotels in contract
 - Trainee: Through internet or Korean friends
- Conflicts
 - Religion: Prayer room, Diet restriction, Different religion, etc
 - Multi-bed room
 - Quality & accessibility

How do they enjoy?

- Social relationship with tutor
- Relationship w colleagues
- Relationship w relevant civilians
- Sightseeing
- Leisure w Korean friends
- Academic travel
- Relationship w experts in the same specialty

What will happen after their return?

- Better understanding Korean medical care system
- Either friendly or unfriendly to Korea: by their satisfaction
- Consistent collaboration with tutor: patient consultation
- Referring patients to Korean hospital
- Inviting tutor to own country
- Cowork for research
- Inter-institute networking & collaboration
- Revisit for further training
- Promote training programs in Korea: by their satisfaction
- Enthusiastic to improve medical care in own country
- Revisit for sightseeing & meeting friends
