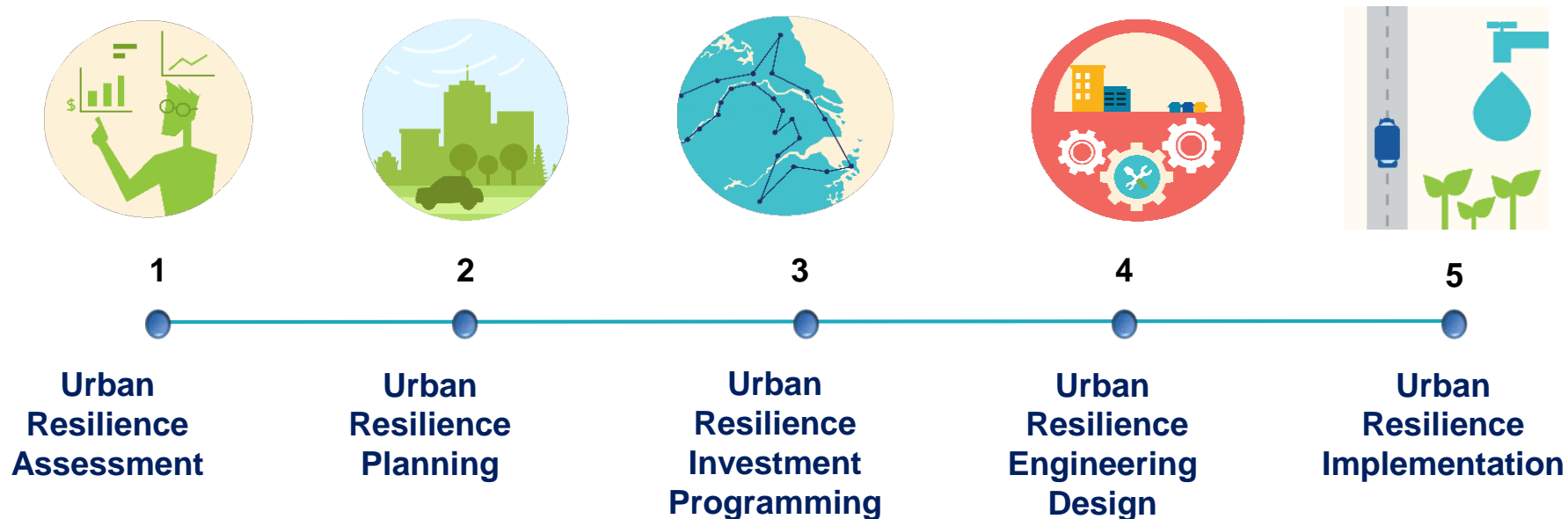

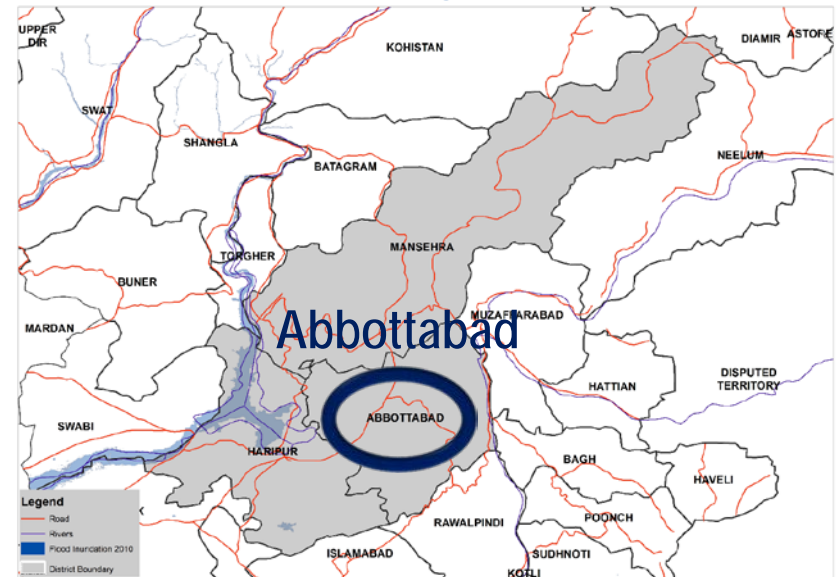

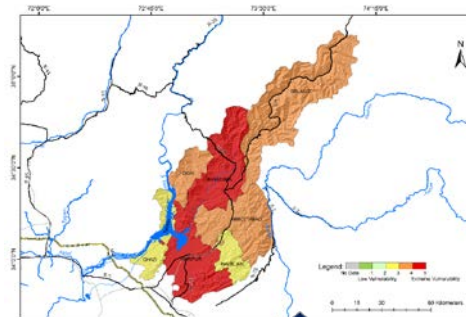

Top-down

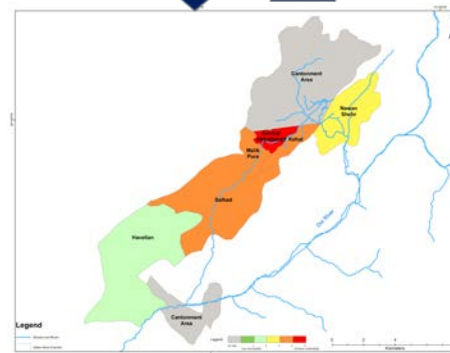
Regional level URAs are assessments on regional level based on climate projections and return periods using global models and data sets from weather stations

City/Community level URAs are assessments on city and community level based on Focus Group Discussions (FGDs)



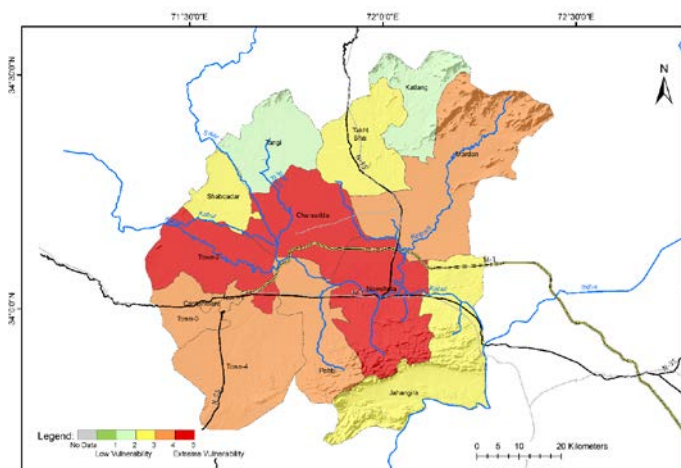

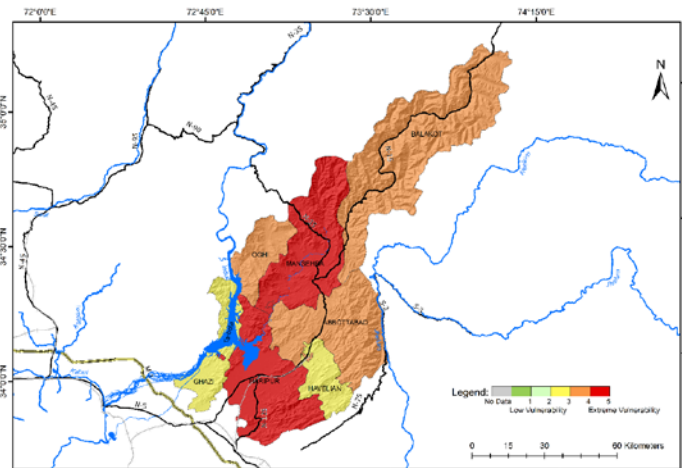

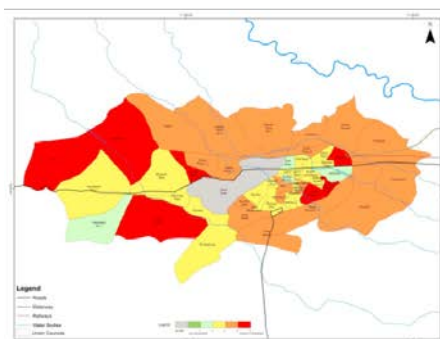
Vulnerability Maps on regional and city/community level



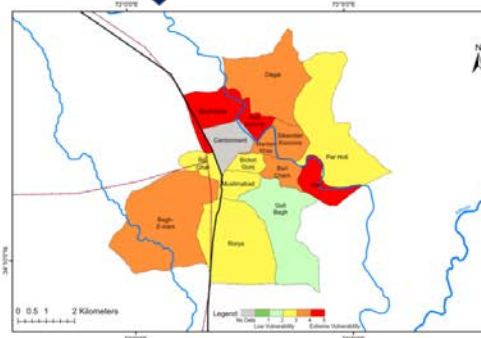

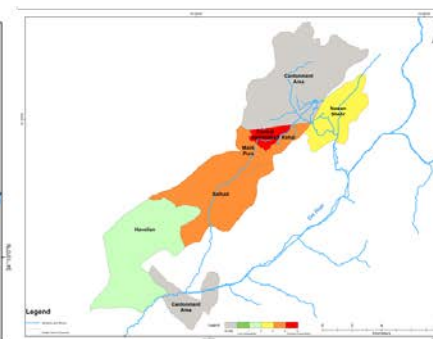
