

- By Youth, With Youth and For Youth
- Objective: provide a framework to guide GWP and its Network in engaging with young people, youth organisations, and young water professionals and to empower them to become agents of change
- The Strategy supports both youth participation in traditional water programmes and processes, and youth-led approaches for advancing water security
