





Bid Notices Posted with Results per Month






### Distribution of Bid Notices Posted by Classification and by Procurement Mode

Majority of the notices posted as of August 31, 2019 are for procument of goods. 84.86% of the civil works projects are procured through public bidding.








### **ABC of Bid Notices by Funding Instrument and by Procurement Mode**






## **Top 10 Suppliers for Civil Works**








## **Top 10 Suppliers for Goods**





## **Top 10 Suppliers Goods – General Support Services**












Growth of Registered Suppliers per

Number of Blue and Platinum Memberships per Year


10 Business Categories with the Most Number of Registered Supplier

Top 5 System Activities of Registered Suppliers





#### **CHALLENGES**

## Philippine Experience in Contracting

- 1. The contracting cycle is most transparent only during the bid, award and contract stages.
- Some planning and procurement documents are in the procuring entities' websites, making it difficult to track contracts from planning to implementation or cancellation



#### **CHALLENGES**

- 3. Low compliance on award publication, only approximately 39% of all Invitations to Bid (ITBs) were updated with corresponding award publication
- 4. Low compliance on Annual Procurement Plan (APP) publication
- 5. If and when more documents and data are available in the agencies' website, these do not often come in machine- readable formats, mostly PDFs making it difficult to analyze or connect with other information.
- 6. Data not yet fully aligned with Open Contracting Data Standard (OCDS). Only 75% of the publication available at once






#### **MOVING FORWARD**
