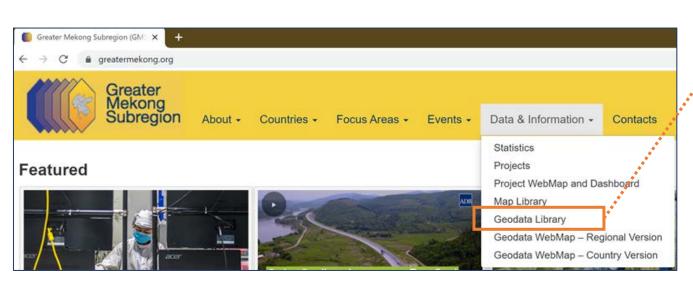


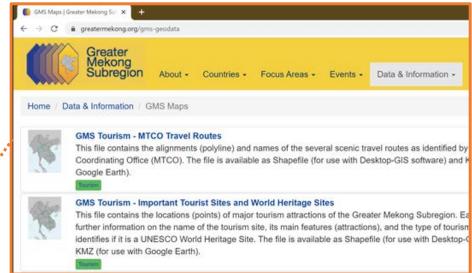
Why Use a GIS Mapping Service

- Geodata library contains "raw" geodata for use with Google Earth or even GIS software.



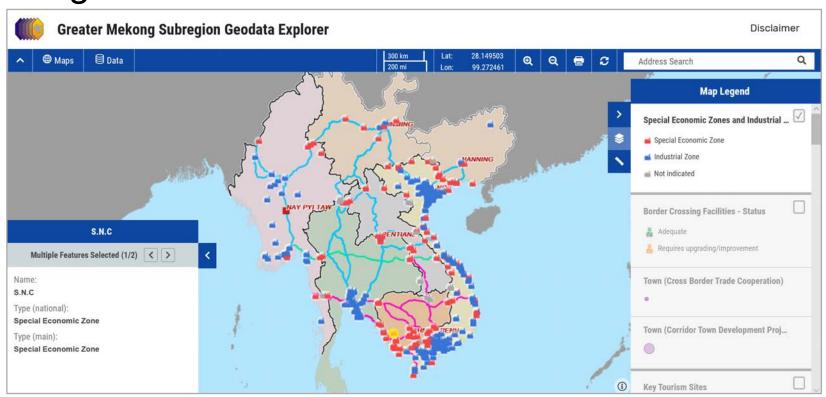


Filling the Gap

The map includes 25 Filters:

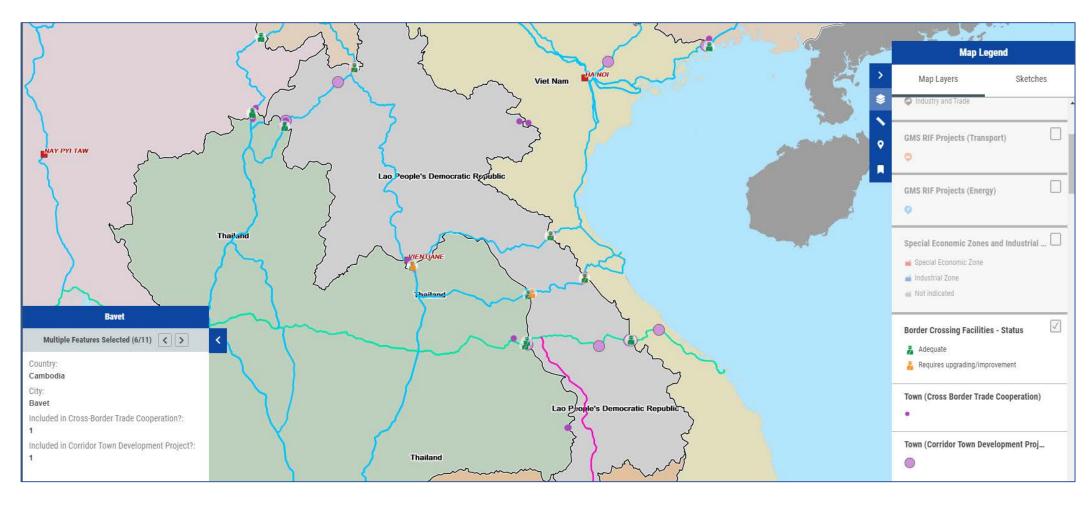
- Projects by sectors

Border Towns, Border Posts, and Economic Corridors

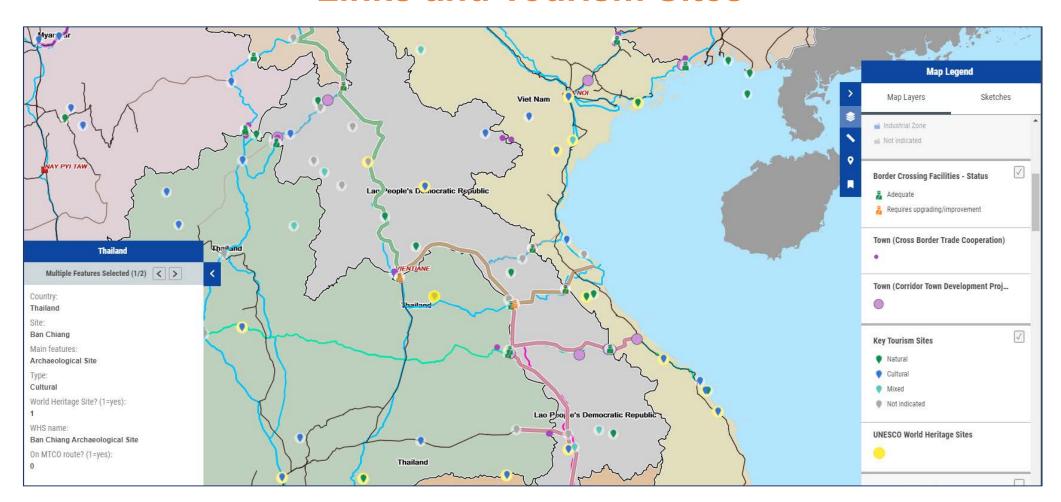

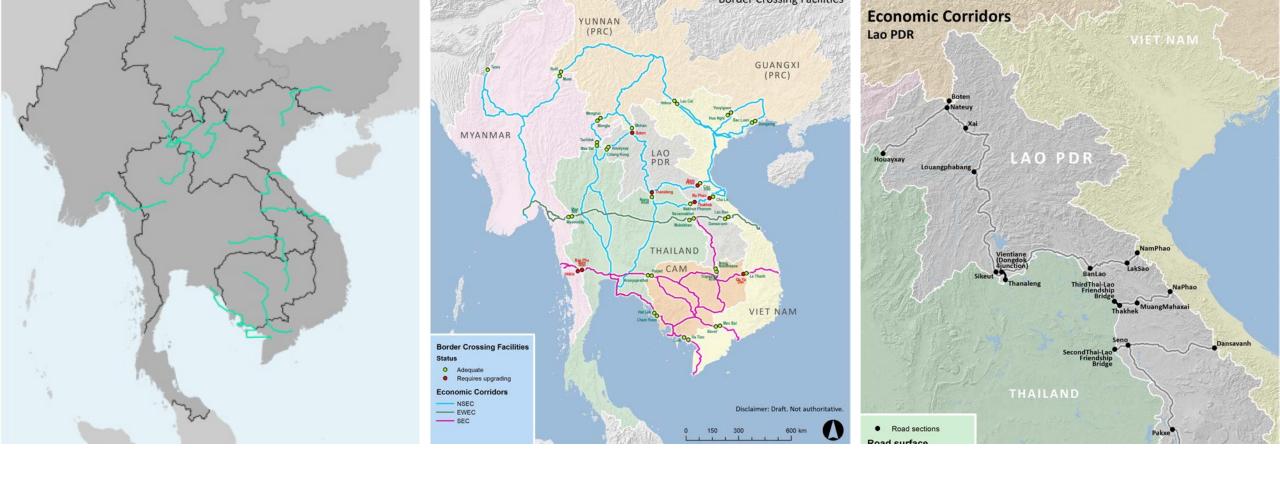
