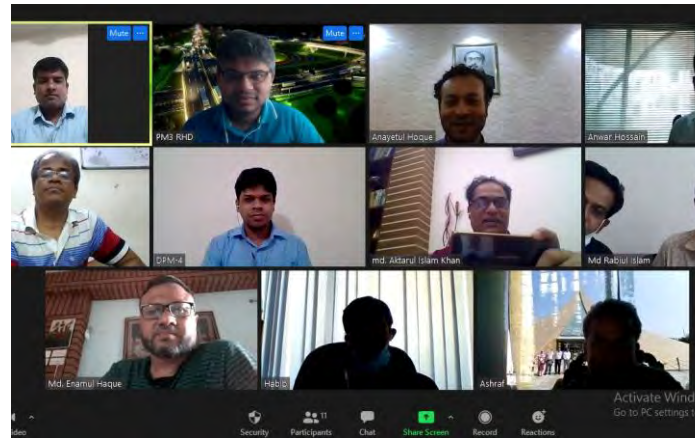


- Conduct surveys safely
- Hand-held android devices
- Health and safety protocols
- Clearances, COVID tests for the survey team
- Temperature monitoring, masks and hand sanitizers
- Special arrangements for logistics and stay
- Survey supervisors sensitizing the affected families
- Health insurance
- Post-survey protocols



CONSULTATIONS: BANGLADESH

- Government restriction on field mobilization = virtual meetings
- 2 physical and 2 online workshops conducted
- Rapid assessment survey carried out through mobile phones supplemented by field conduct of FGDs
- Community-level consultation re-started, safety awareness is nominal in communities

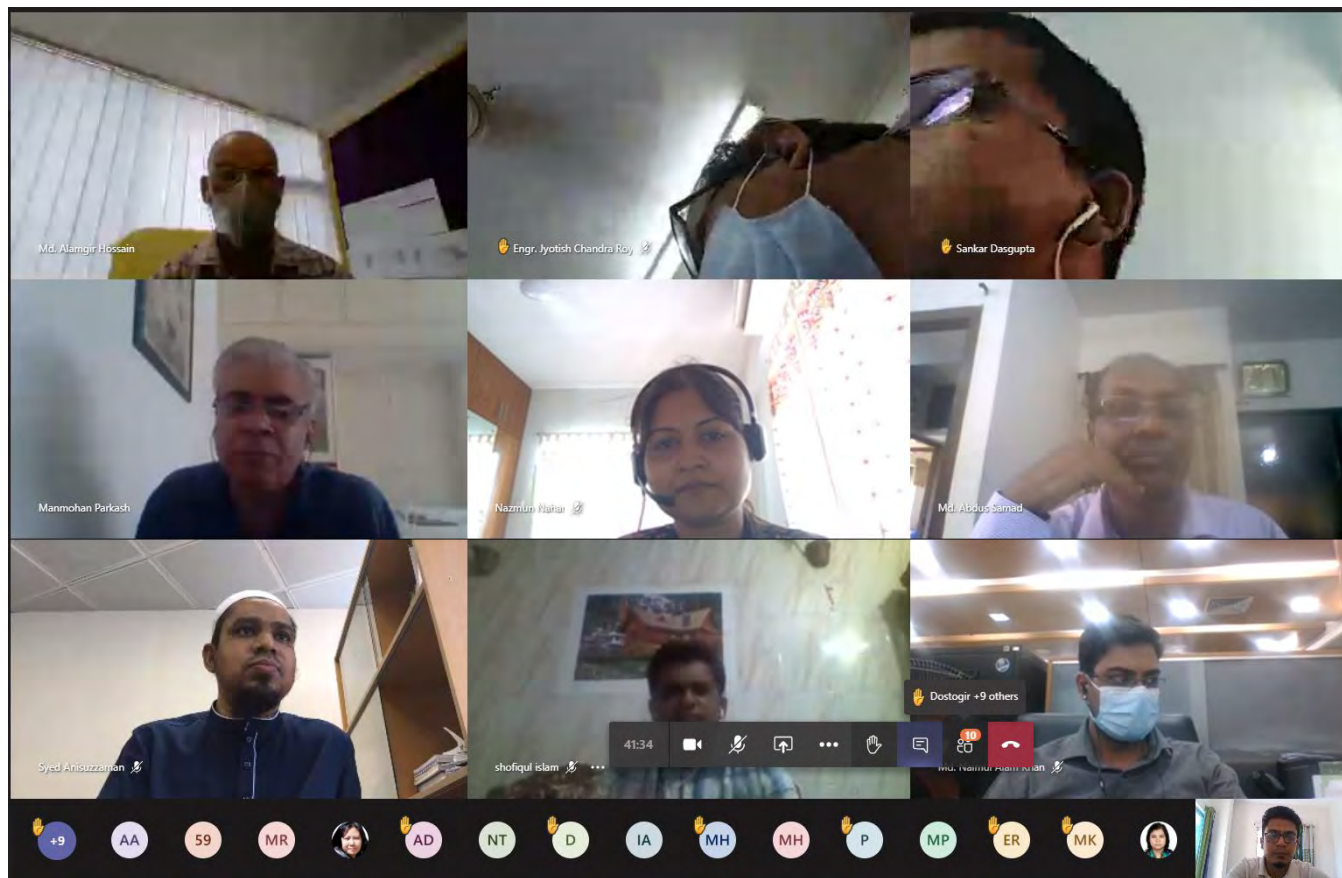


GRIEVANCE REDRESS: SRI LANKA

REVIEW MISSIONS: BANGLADESH



- 19 virtual review missions for cat A/B projects since March 2020
- Review includes: (i) safeguards implementation progress, (ii) monitoring reports, (iii) due diligence, (iv) external monitoring assessments and site visits
- Virtual field visits/trips
- Safeguards discussions are prioritized
