*This is **not an evaluation** as CIF projects were not developed with a just transition framework in mind. It is creating **learning spaces**.*

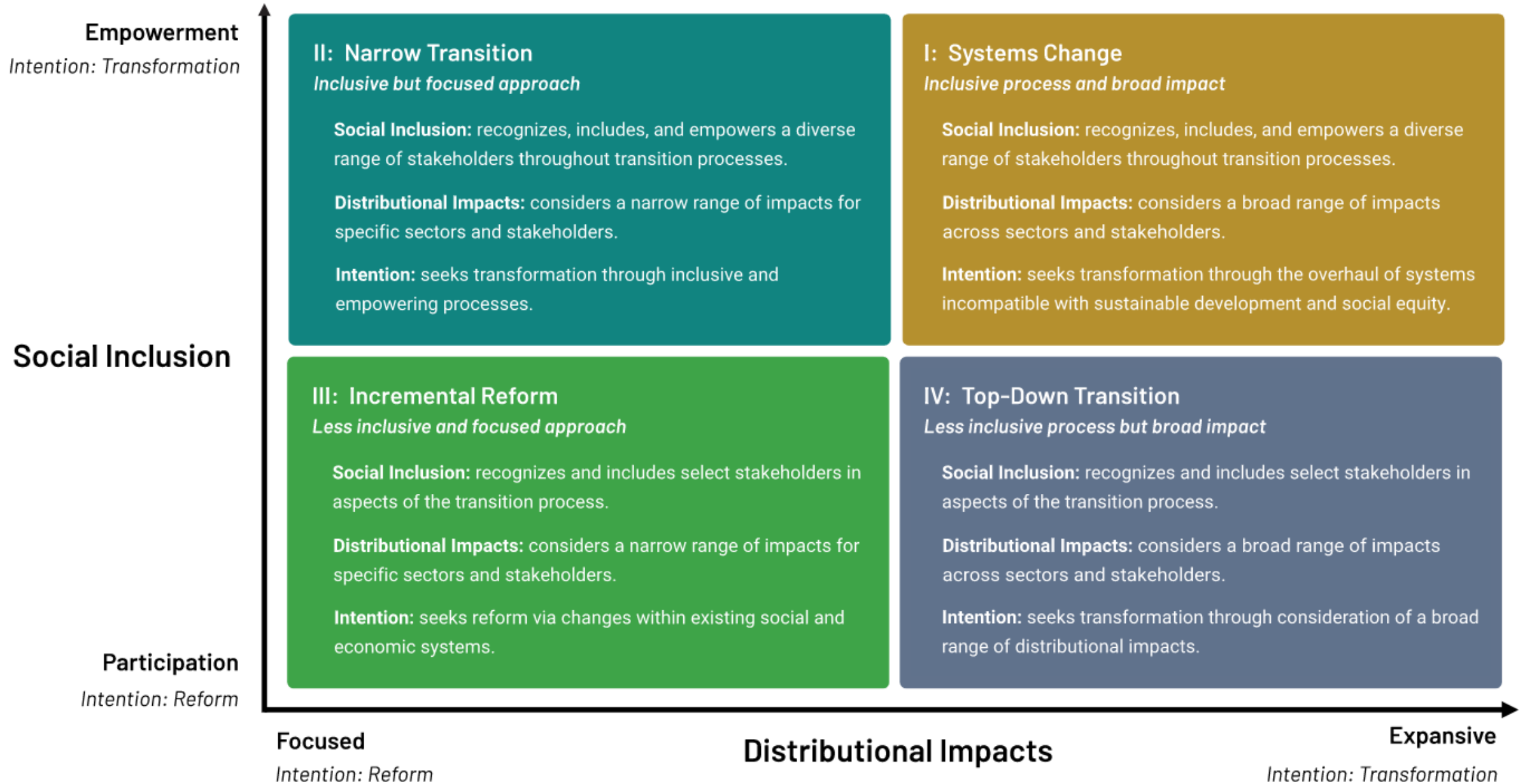
# JUST TRANSITIONS FRAMEWORK

- **Social Inclusion**
  - Recognition
  - Participation
  - Governance
- **Distributional impacts**
  - Present Distribution
  - Access
  - Restorative justice
- **Depth of Transformational Intent**
- **Across geographic space and extended time horizons**
