

### **Elderly caregiving in Hong Kong**

37.3% Children as major caregivers 26.3% Spouses as major caregivers



- **280,500** older adults need assistance from others in their daily living (such as helping with eating, dressing, and toileting)
- **47.6%** had caregivers



# 375,848 caregivers in Hong Kong






#### **Diversified in AGE and GENDER**

# Caregiver Recognition

 The 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of October as "Carer Day" to promote recognition and support for caregivers.

Policies and programmes to increase recognition of the central role caregivers play in the well-being of the person they are caring for, in community capacity, in society and in economic prosperity.







## **Financial Support**

Measures to support caregivers' financial security and alleviate the pressure on personal finances from caring.



#### **Direct financial support**

- Dependent Parent and Dependent Grandparent allowance
- Disabled Dependent Allowance
- Hong Kong Mandatory Provident Fund
- Pilot Scheme on Living Allowance for Carers of Elderly Persons from Lowincome Families
- Pilot Scheme on Residential Care Service Voucher for the Elderly

#### **Indirect financial support**

- The Housing Authority provides two main types of housing for older adults in public rental estates: Housing for Senior Citizens Units and Self-Contained Small Flats
- Elderly Health Care Voucher Scheme was launched in 2009 to offer an annual voucher amount of HK\$2,000 to older adults aged 65 or above to use for private healthcare services





#### **Work and Education**

- Family Status Discrimination Ordinance (FSDO) expressly prohibits discrimination toward a person on the basis of family status.
- The Equal Opportunities Commission (EOC) has issued a Code of Practice in accordance with the ESDO.
- The Labour and Welfare Bureau encourages employers (there is no legislative requirement) to adopt family-friendly employment practices
- Employ foreign domestic helpers

Practices to create supportive workplaces and educational environments so caregivers have equal opportunities to remain in and return to work/school.


Supports to uphold caregivers' physical and mental health, facilitate social connections and enable caregivers to pursue interests outside of their caring responsibilities.



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
