Important Reforms Needed

Following have been identified as important reforms: K to 12 curriculum review and update

- Streamlining the curriculum (Reducing and contextualizing) Improving the learning environment
- Reintroduction of f2f learning and implementation of blended learning
- Keep TVI and RBI alive
- Preparing for the reintroduction of limited F2F
- Aggressive conversion of schools to integrated schools.
- Digital learning environment
- Effective use of technology
- School autonomy
- Independent learning leading to life-long learning
- Strengthening Portfolio assessment
- Boosting human capital (standards of professional practice)





Important Reforms Needed

Following have been identified as important reforms:

Teachers' upskilling and reskilling

 Make the system of teacher professional development adaptive to fast-changing requirement of the education system and society as a whole

Engagement of stakeholders for support and Collaboration
