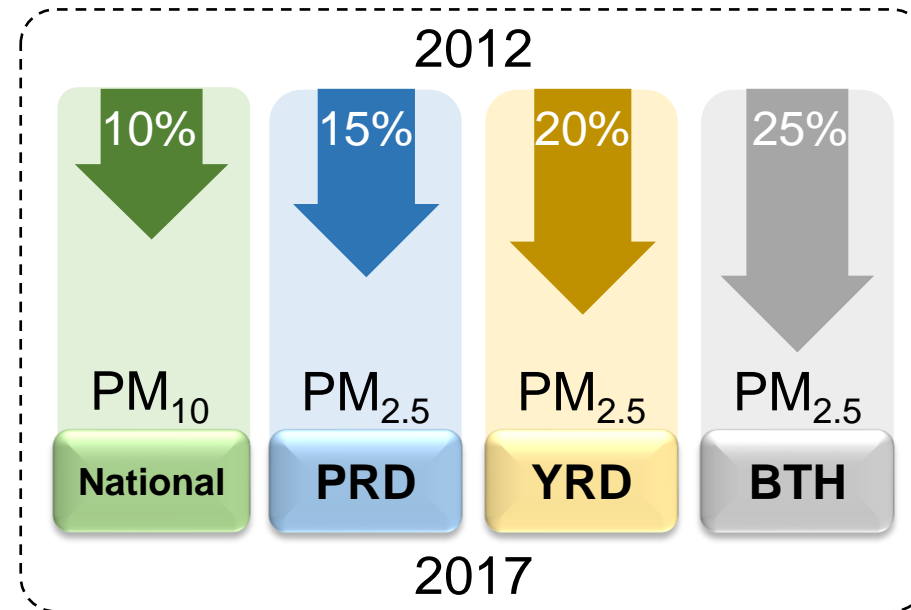

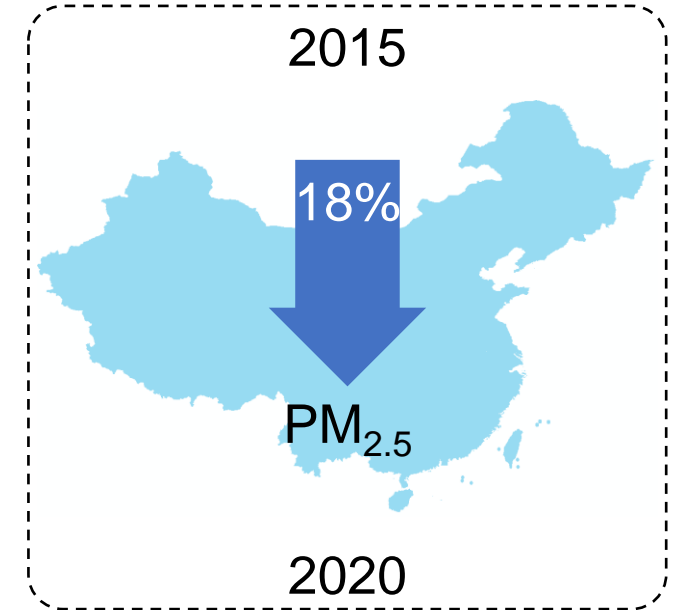
Emission amount

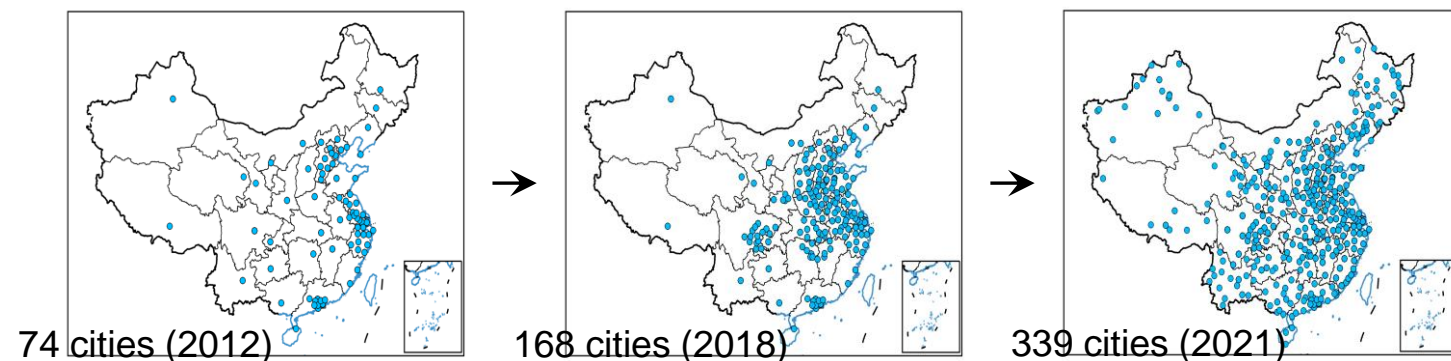

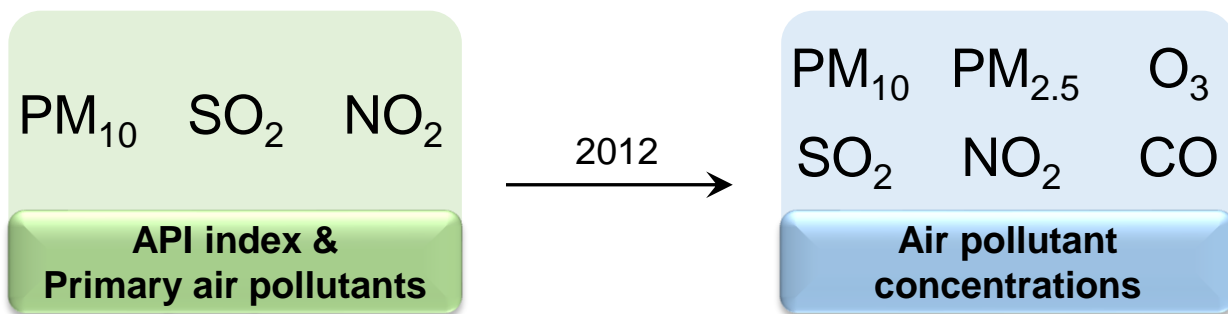
