



Bangladesh and ADB

- Bangladesh became ADB member in 1973
- Bangladesh Resident Mission established in 1982
 - first field office of ADB



Since 1973, ADB committed:

- \$27.7 billion for 328 loans,
- \$298.3 million for 507 TAs,
- \$958.1 million for 54 grants.

Bangladesh is a major recipient of ADB concessional resources.






Growing ADB Sovereign Operations

Addition = \$22.9 billion, Closure = \$18.8 billion; Cancellation = \$1.5 billion; Net Addition = \$2.6 billion








Bangladesh Portfolio as of 22 Apr'2022




Member Countries by Volume








Growth of ADB Portfolio in Bangladesh (2011-2021)
