




Gender Gap Index 2022 Score- 0.637 Rank- 126th out of 146 countries

Gender Gap Index 2021 Score- 0.639 Rank- 130th out of 156 countries












Prevalence of Violence against women and girls








Perception on gender equality


Twopronged approach:

Dedicated National Key Result Area 10, "Gender Equality"




