- **The Impact of Adolescent Nutrition Support on Development Outcomes (TA51354)**
 - Executing Agency: Ministry of Health (MOH)
 - Japan Fund for Poverty Reduction (JFPR)
 - Approved: 6 August 2018 (closing November 2022 or could be extended to May 2023)
 - Fund: USD 2 million
 - MOU between MOH and ADB on 30 June 2020

3. Water, Sanitation, and Child Health Outcomes in Indonesia

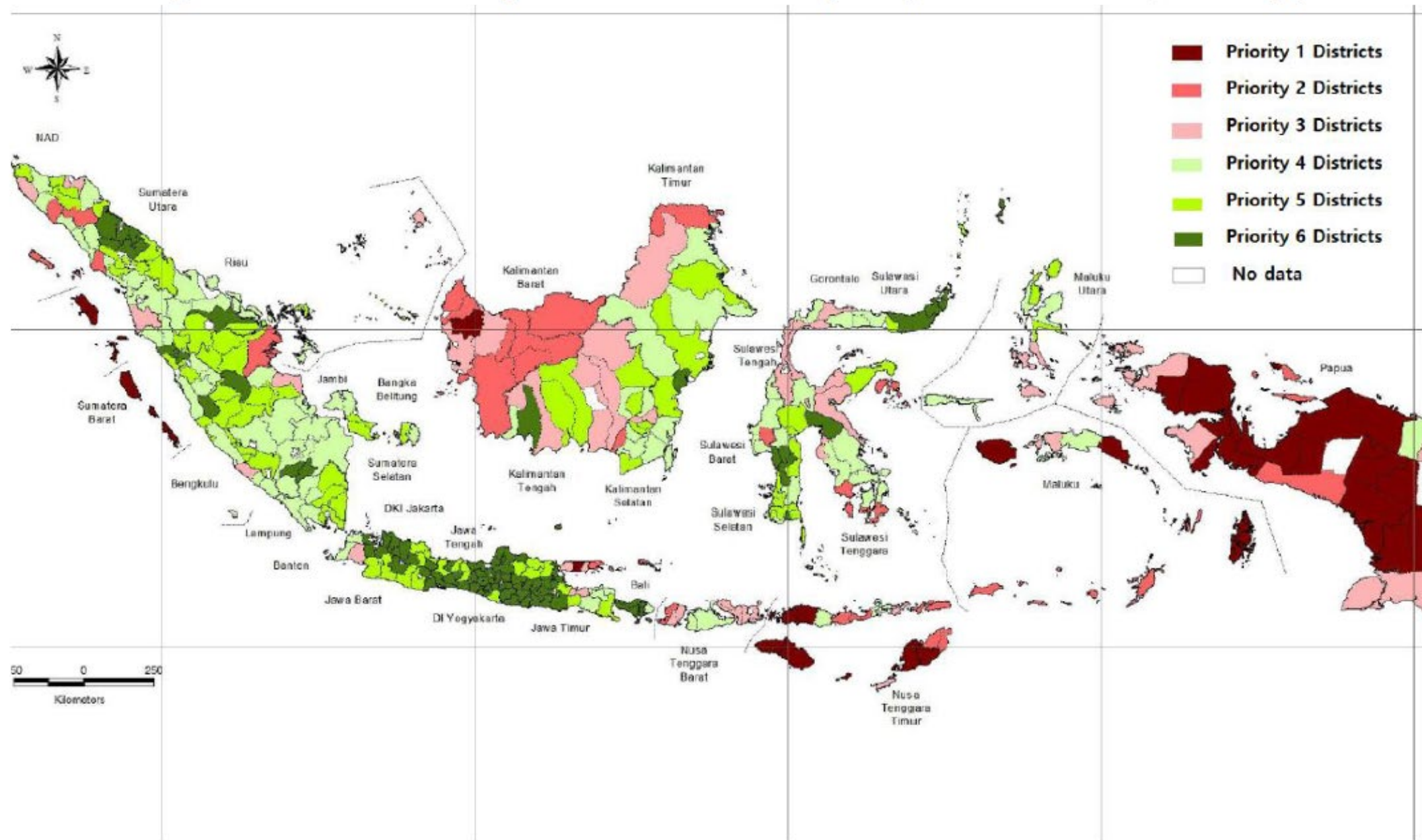
