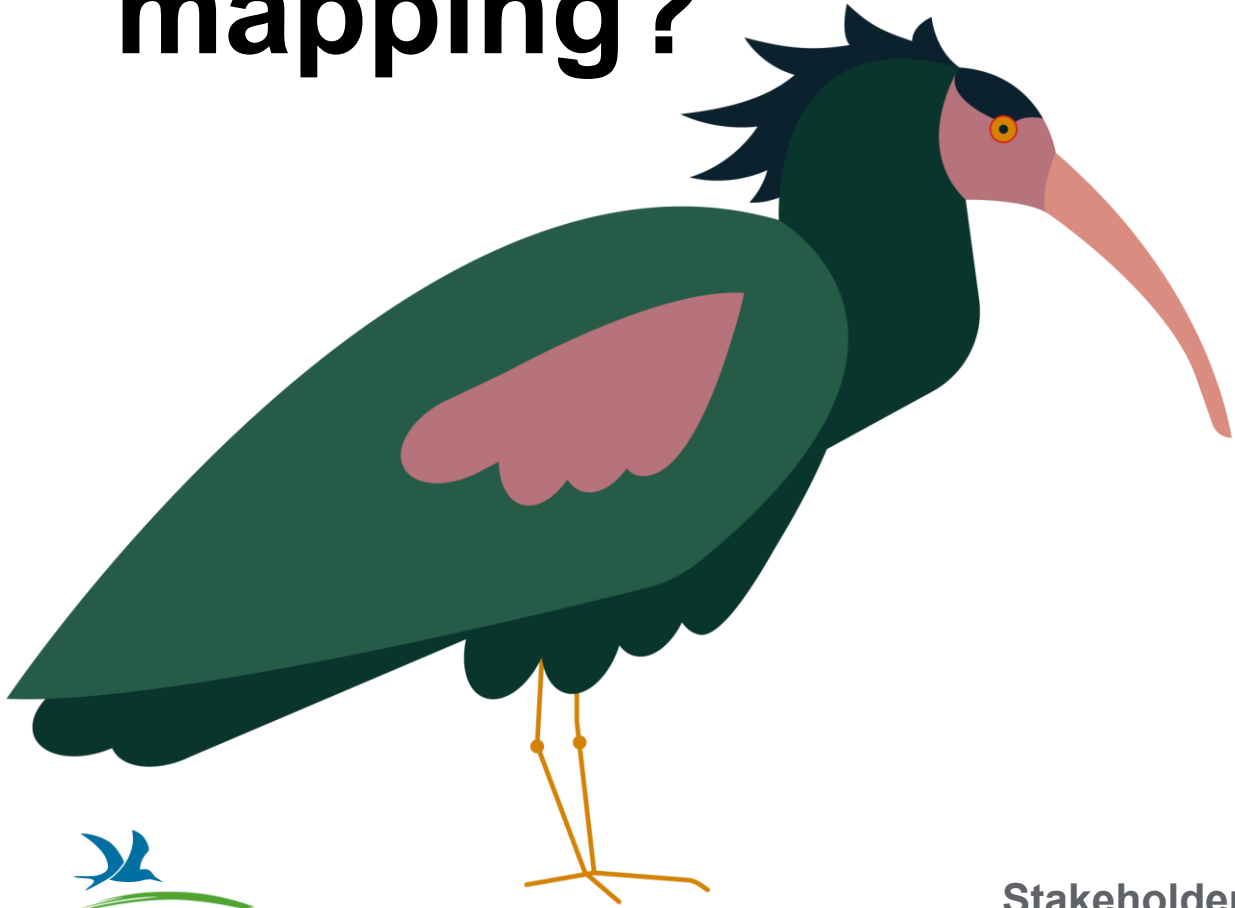


# Plan for this afternoon

# Why undertake stakeholder mapping?



- RFI projects should identify and understand interests, needs and tradeoffs between different stakeholders at priority wetlands
- Supporting participation of diverse stakeholders in projects can lead to innovative solutions to conservation/development problems, leading to more sustainable, equitable outcomes for wetland conservation
