Public Procurement System in Türkiye

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GDP

• 906 billion \$, GDP of Türkiye, 2022 (~1,1 trillion \$, 2023)

PP

- 32,8 billion \$, total amount of public procurement, 2023 (in the first six months)
- 29,3 billion \$, PP within the scope of PPL N. 4734, 2023 (the first six months)

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- 49.124, the number of public procurements, 2023 (in the first six months)
- 114.366, the number of contracts signed, 2023 (in the first six months)



E-tender

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99.99% of the procurements within the scope of the PP Law (100 thousand procurements)





Public procurement process with EPPP modules

- Registration of tenders into the system, preparation of tender documents
- Preparation and publication of tender notices and bulletin
- Participation in tenders
- Evaluating of the tenders and determining the qualifications of the tenderers
- Carrying out contract transactions

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Natural person: Foreigner identification number Ministry of Interior, General Directorate of Population and Citizenship Affairs

Participation

Legal person: Potential tax number
Ministry of Treasury and Finance, Revenue Administration

Submission of documents regulated by their own national legislation that prove that they operate in the field in which they are tendering

Submission of documents showing that the person is authorized to sign the EPPP protocol and submit a tender
