




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- By 2060 the number of people 65 or older is expected to double to 98 million (APA)














- Vision Loss Globally 1.1 billion people. (IAPB, 2022)
 - Vision Blind 43 million. (IAPB, 2022)
 - Vision Moderate-to-severe 295 million. (IAPB, 2022)

- Consideration in every geographical region ADB serves.


