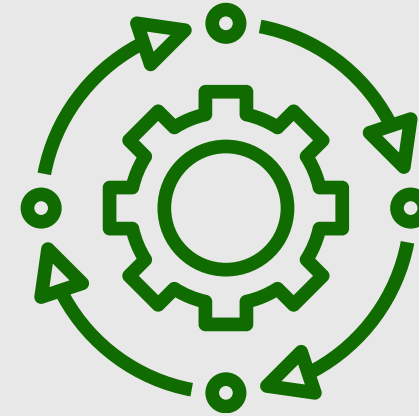




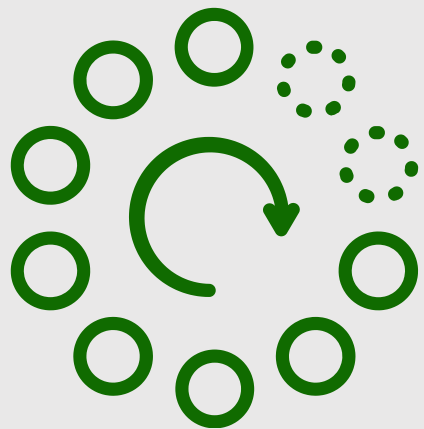
# The Philippine Approach Towards GPP



Inspired by the logic that governments have to **lead by example** in transforming the market



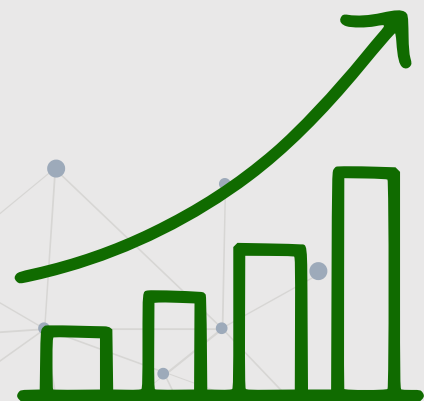
Based on **well-established public procurement processes**



A **circumspect** approach (issues and concerns, capacities, best practices)



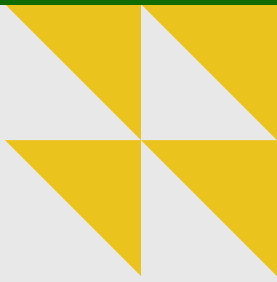
Market **readiness**

The **best deal** for the government (value for money) and industry (getting a potent buyer for green products)



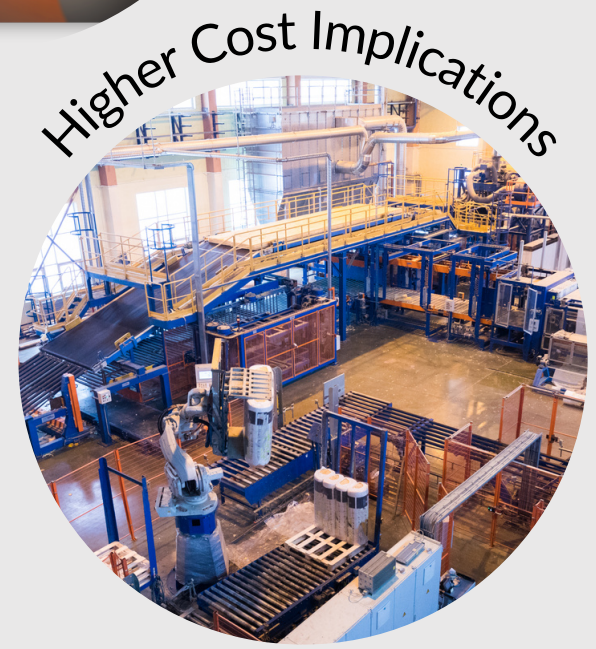

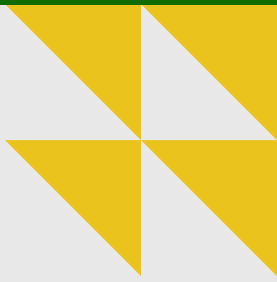

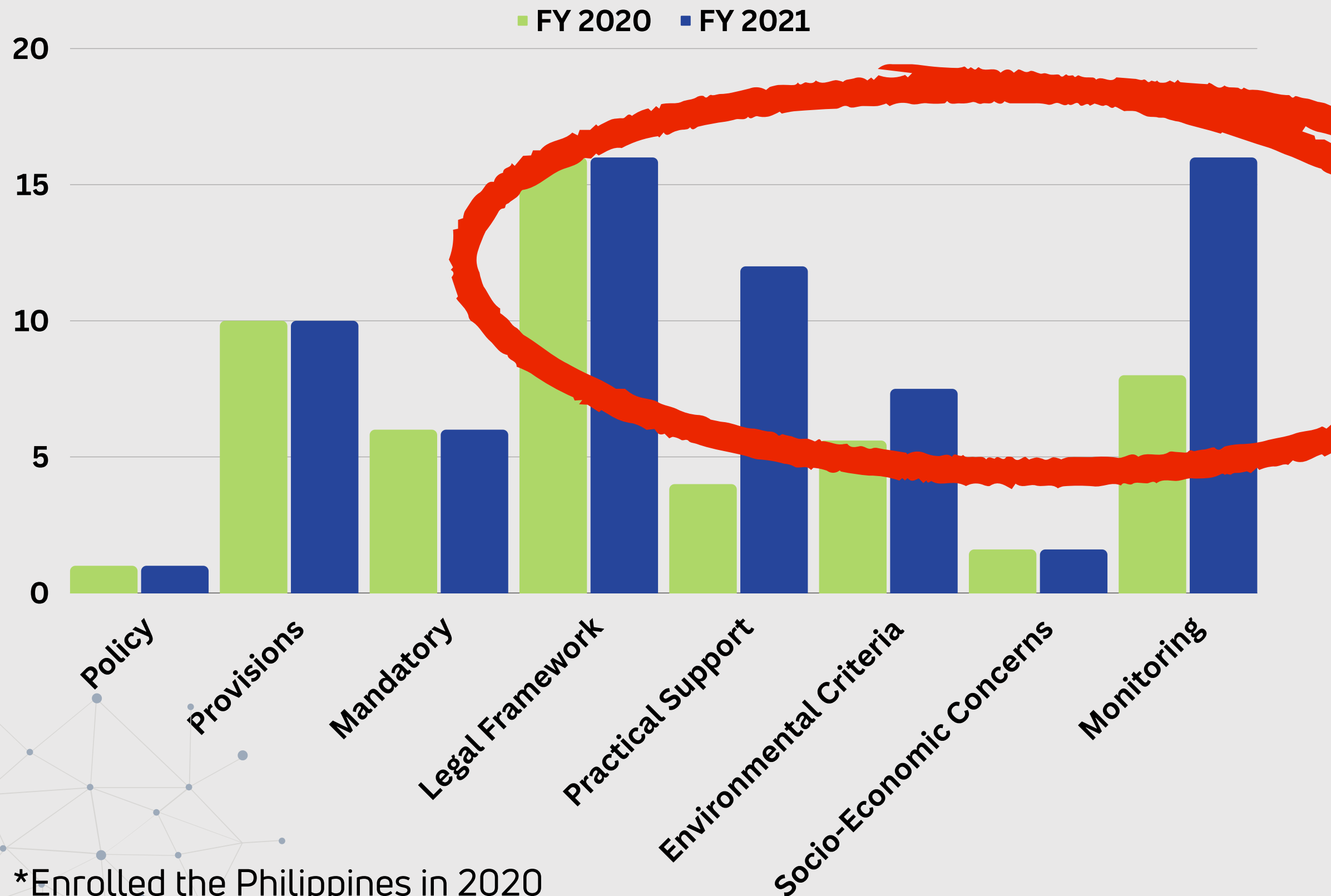
