# Handwashing with Soap

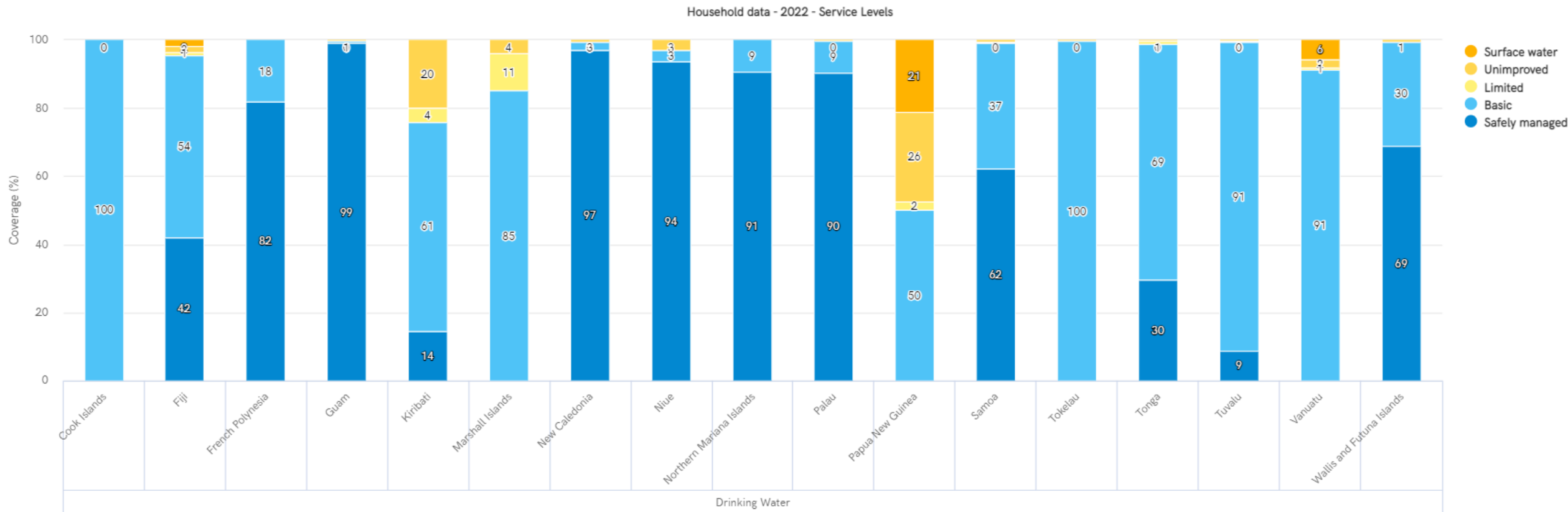




# Basic Hygiene Services

SERVICE LEVEL	DEFINITION
BASIC	Availability of a handwashing facility with soap and water at home
LIMITED	Availability of a handwashing facility lacking soap and/or water at home
NO FACILITY	No handwashing facility at home

# Status on safe drinking water varies by countries

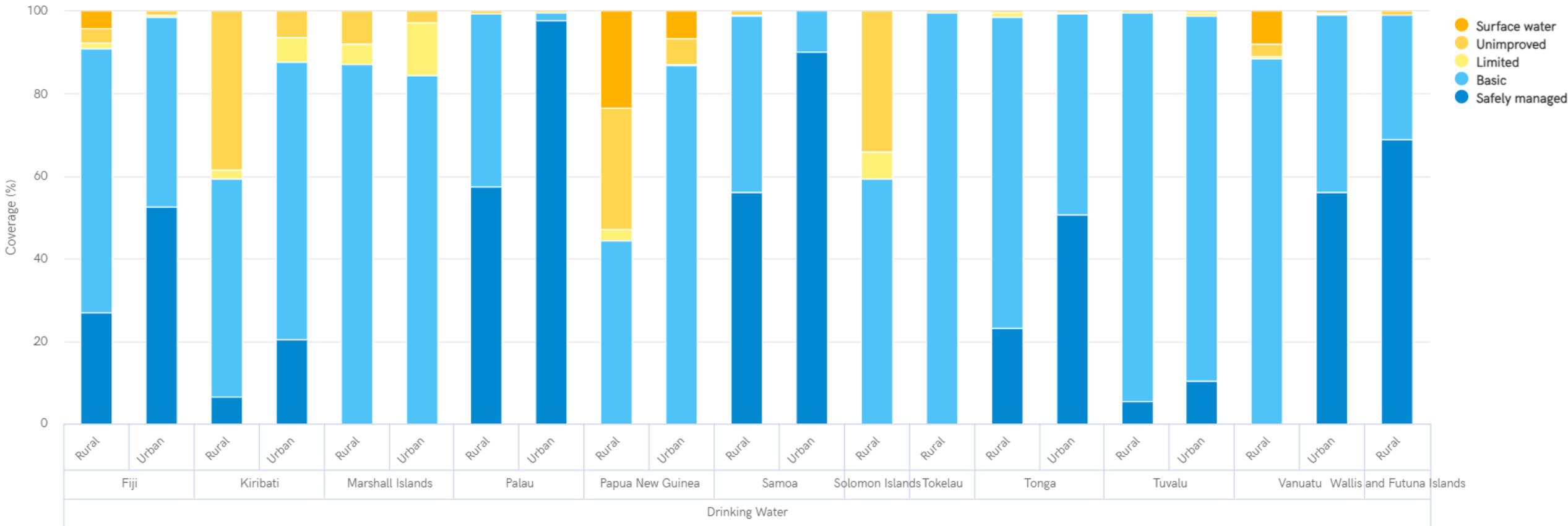

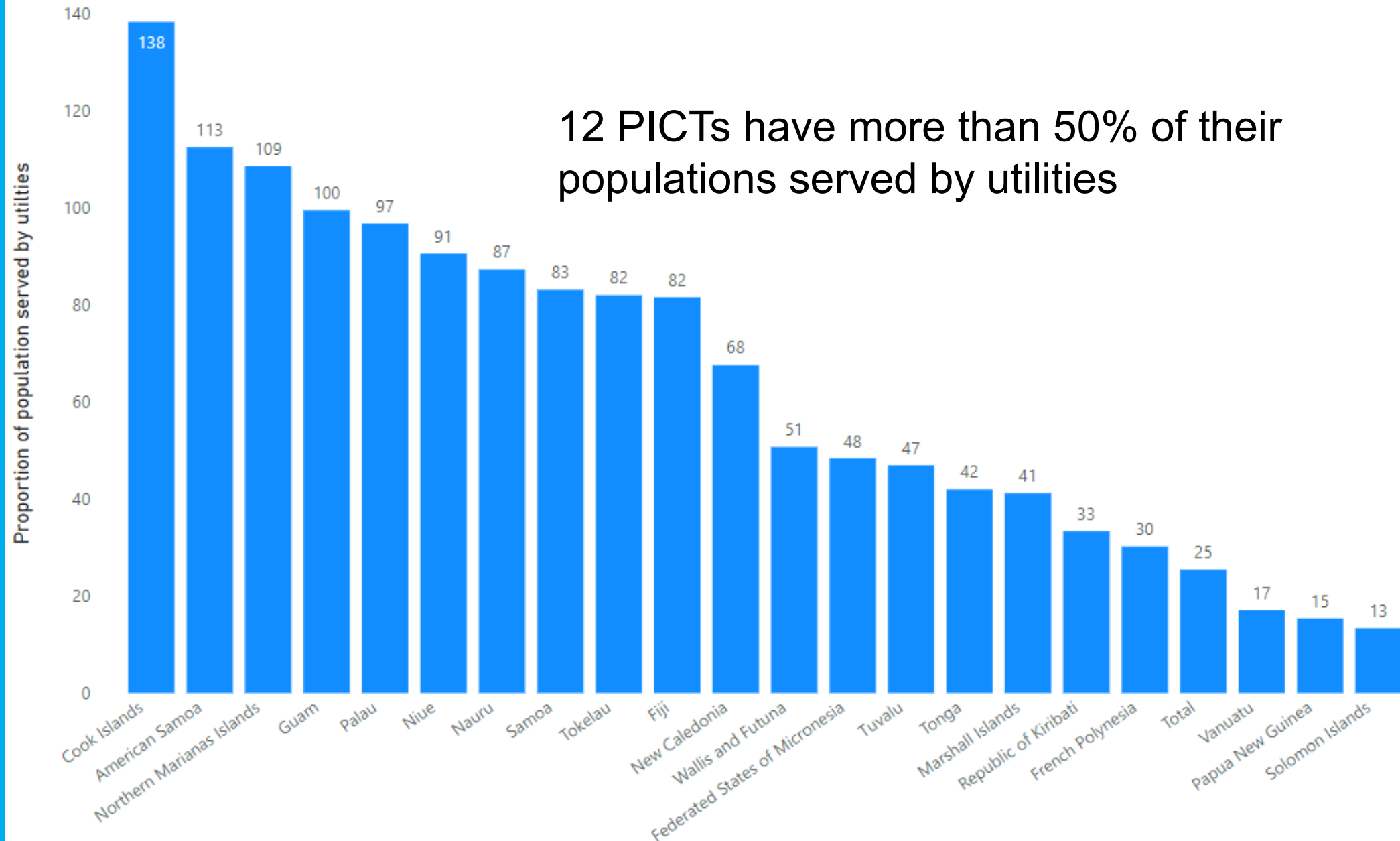

Household data - 2022 - Service Levels



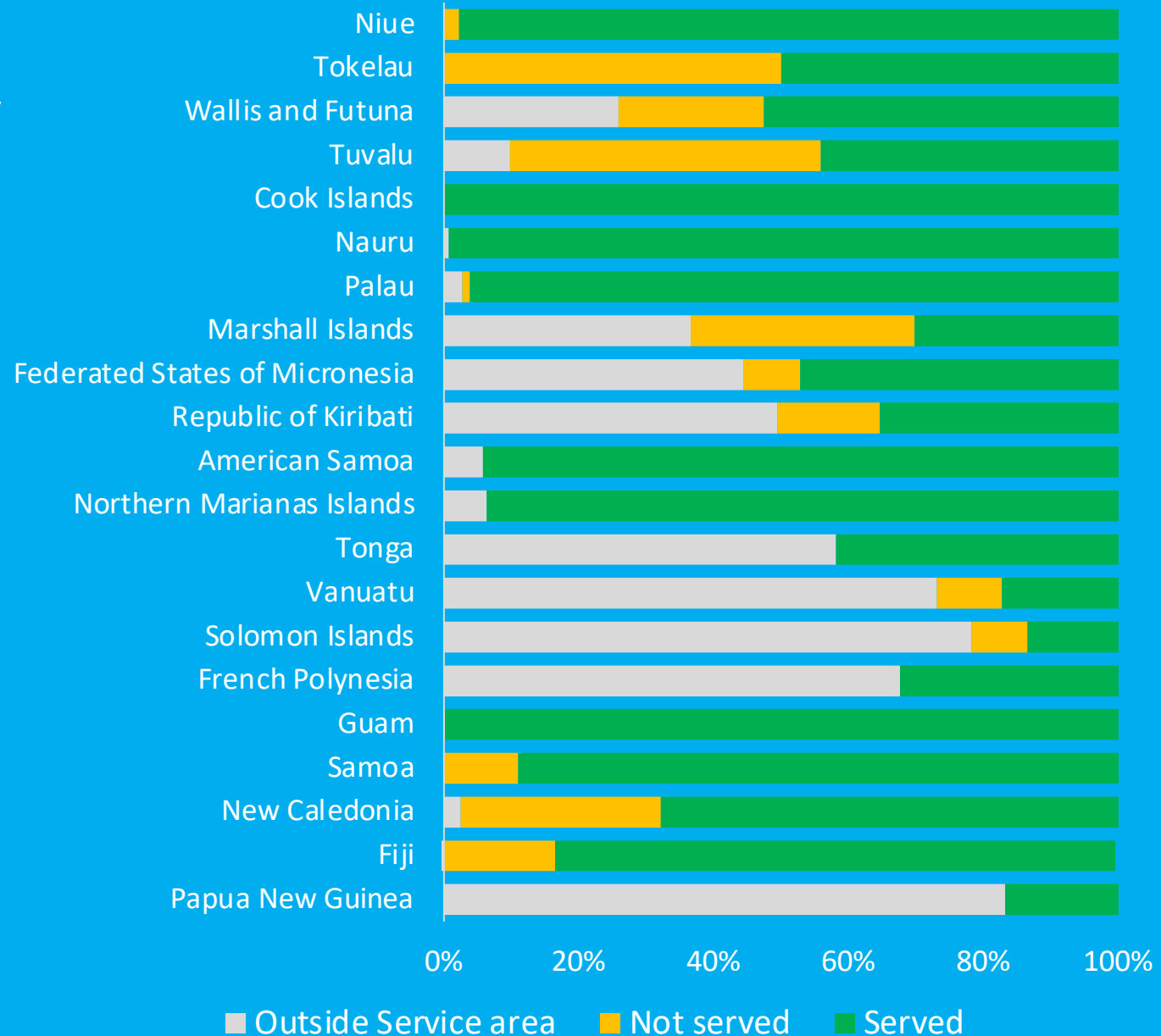
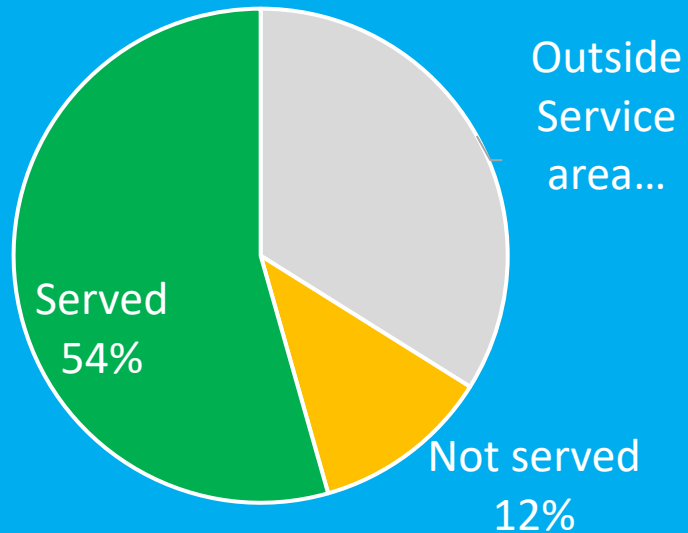
## Proportion Served by Utilities by Country, Area or Territory



# Pacific populations covered by Utilities

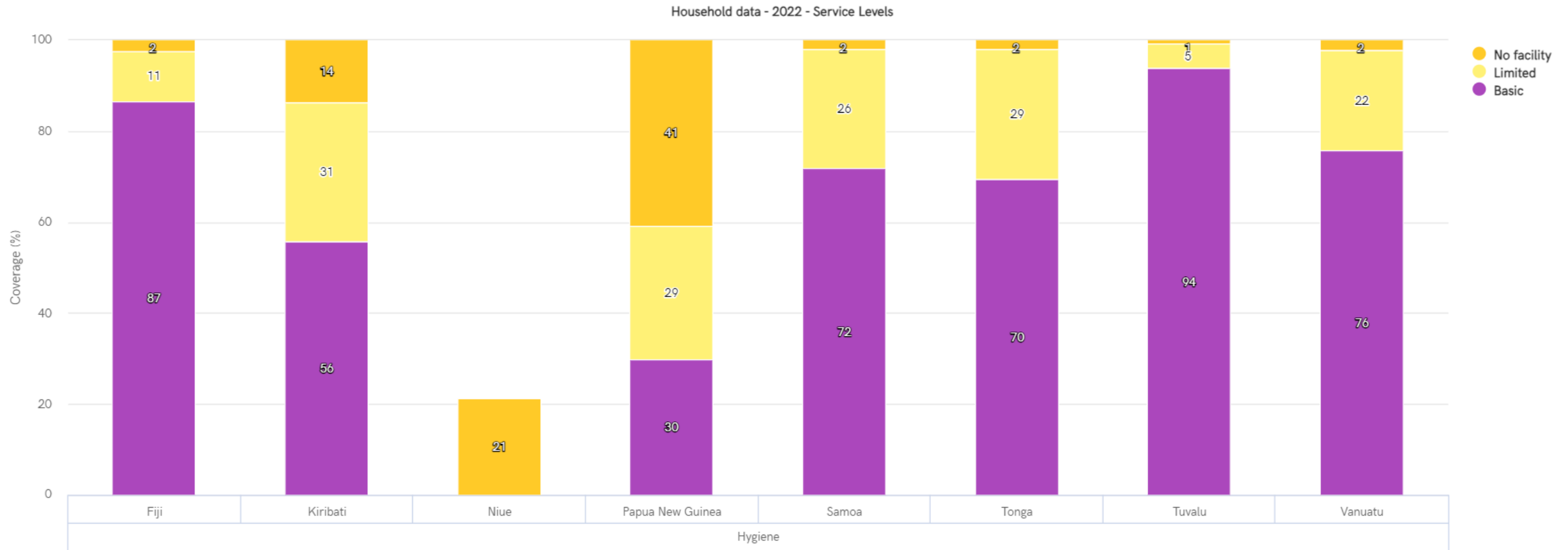
12 PICTs have more than 50% of their populations served by utilities

# Access to handwashing facility at home

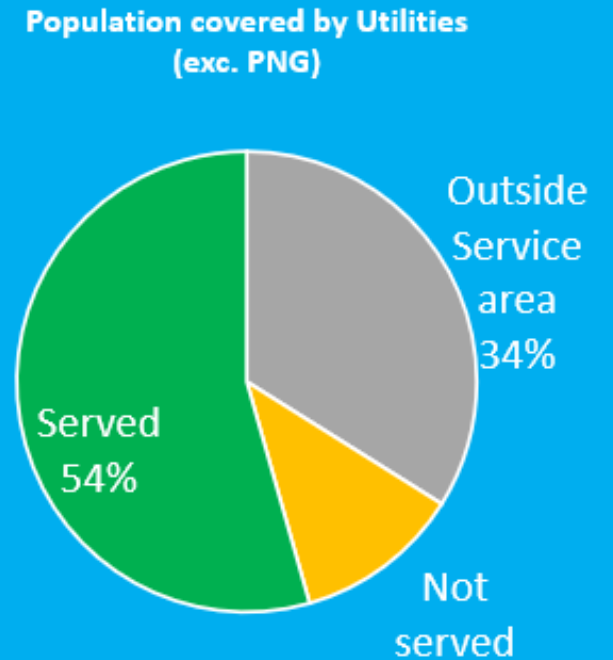


# WASH in schools - *Hygiene promotion*



# Summary/Key takeaways

1. Utilities play an important role in promotion of handwashing services

4. Clean hands are within reach but need more and sustained effort for all settings (home, communities, workplaces, schools, health centers)

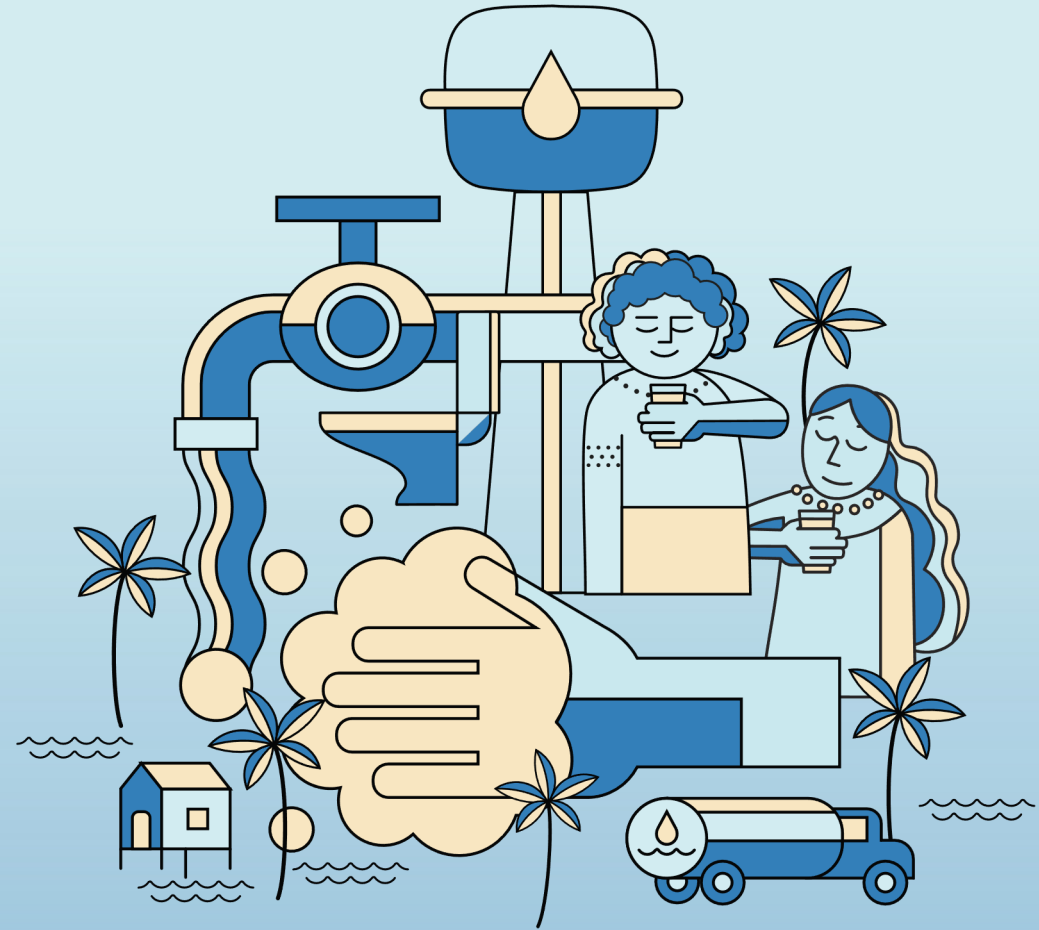

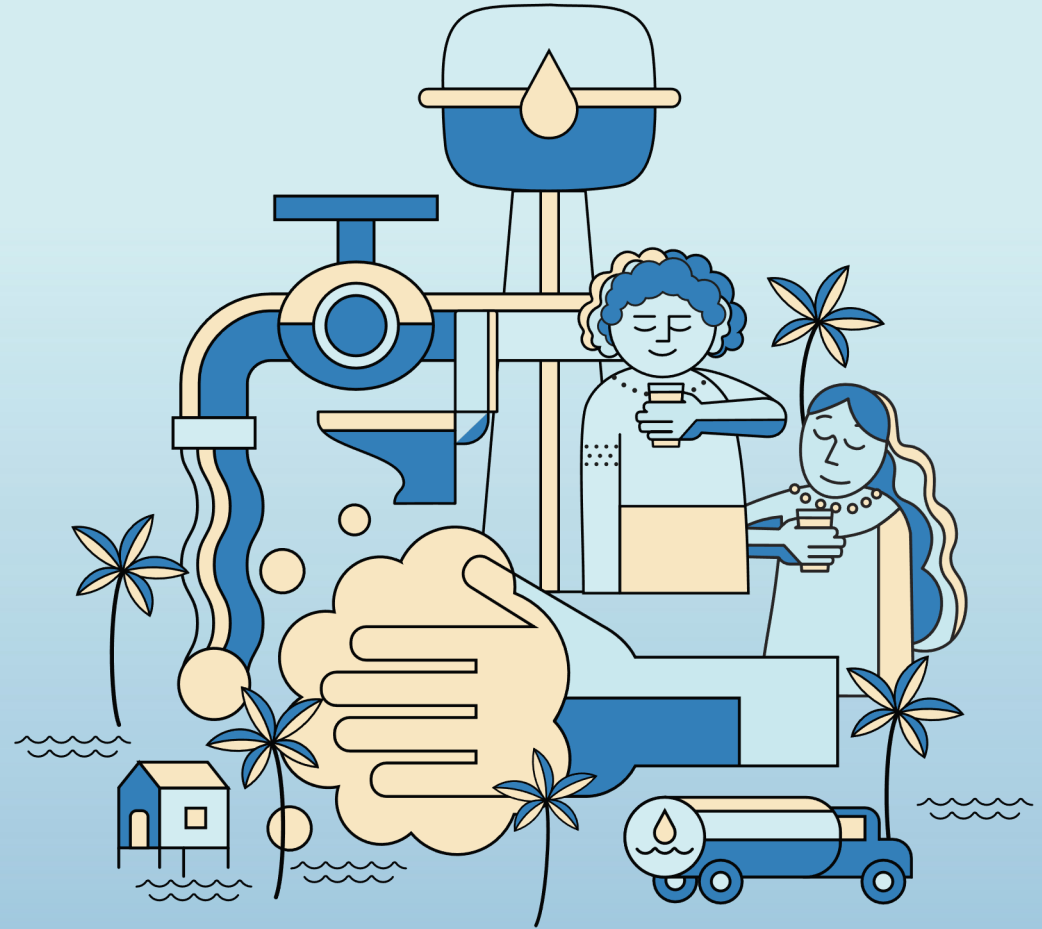

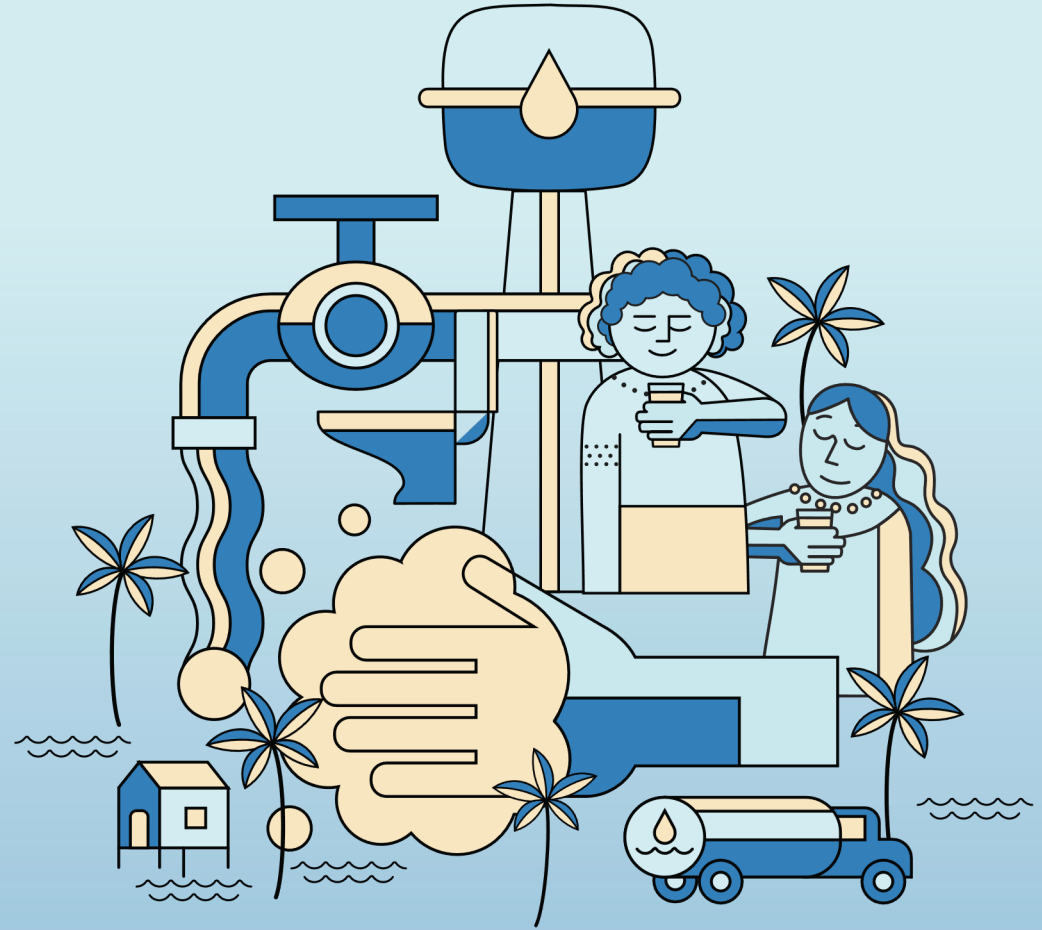
