

# Historical ADB support for flood risk management








Riverine flood management and drainage infrastructure since 1970s \$1.8 billion floodrelated projects since 2000... ...70% of which for flood response and reconstruction







### 2022 floods forced a rethink

- Reconstruction costs cannibalizing development financing









Figure 1-2: Chachar Hill Torrent Location Map

#### National Disaster Risk Management Fund Project (2015, financial intermediation)

- \$200 million ADB financing + bilateral and WB
- Not-for-profit company
- Investments in disaster risk reduction

#### Proposed Climate and Disaster Resilience Enhancement Program (2024, policy-based loan)

- Reform areas in institutional capacity, DRR frameworks, disaster risk financing
- Contingent disaster financing option
