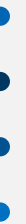

Pacific Infrastructure Opportunities

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Australian Infrastructure Financing Facility for the Pacific (AIFFP)

- Loans & Grant funds for projects across the Pacific and Timor-Leste
- Includes AUD350 million under the Pacific Climate Infrastructure Financing Partnership (PCIFP)
- AUD1.8 billion in financing for 20 approved projects in 10 countries to date



Australia's Department of Defence

- Defence is partnering with Papua New Guinea (PNG), Fiji, Malaysia, Vanuatu, Solomon Islands, Timor Leste, Cook Islands, Palau, Kiribati, Samoa, Tonga, Tuvalu, and Republic of Marshall Islands
- Supporting significant infrastructure projects that are enhancing security capability



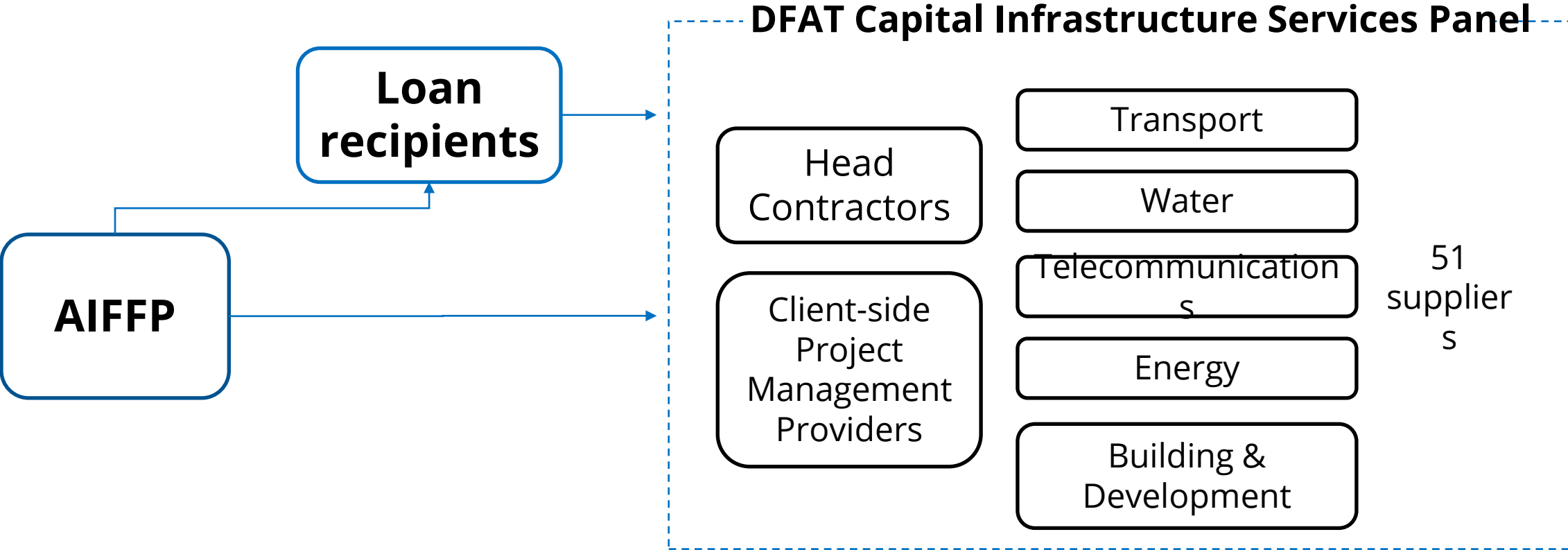
